



Greetings from Branson, Missouri, a city full of music amidst a great Midwest landscape. Spend the day fishing or golfing and the evening taking in Branson's famous musical theater, or stay in and relax at our beautiful WorldMark Branson resort.

The resort consists of 81 one-, two- and three-bedroom units, as well as two- or three-bedroom penthouse units with fully equipped kitchens and balconies or decks. All units are air-conditioned.

WorldMark Branson consists of a variety of multi-story buildings that do not have elevators. However, you will not have to go up or down more than one level. If you or one of your guests are unable to navigate stairs, please request a unit on the second floor, which is at the parking lot level, during the reservation process.

The resort is happy to provide a seasonal outdoor pool and children's pool and are closed for the winter from Nov. 1 to Apr. 1. The main hot tub and a remote hot tub are open year round. ResortNet 2, WorldMark's wireless Internet service, is available in all units for a small fee.

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## Things to See and Do in Branson

<B>W</B>ith 40-plus theaters, 60,000 seats, and about 90 productions, Branson is known as the "Live Entertainment Capital of the World." Branson features the likes of Mickey Gilley, The Gatlin Brothers, the Oak Ridge Boys and Pam Tillis. Gospel, Broadway show tunes, as well as Motown and Classic Rock & Roll are also big draws here with names such as Andy Williams, Bobby Vinton and the Platters performing on a regular basis. Many of Branson's main shows tend to shut down for the winter, so plan your trip accordingly.

After entertainment, Branson is known for its lakes, trout streams and hills. (Actually, the town has a longstanding reputation as a summer place for fishermen and outdoor enthusiasts.) Ringed by the legendary **Ozark Mountains**, Branson gives vacationers hiking trails, nine golf courses and three lakes within an eight-mile-square area. Giant cedars and deciduous trees such as hickories and oaks offer green shade to those seeking a respite from bustling Branson. Waves of cicada calls and the flash of fireflies in the evening greet those who step outside, giving the experience a decidedly Midwest feel. **Lakes Taneycomo**, **Bull Shoals** and **Table Rock** provide swimming, fishing, water-skiing, cruising and other watersport opportunities—all popular diversions for families. Boats, jet skis and fishing equipment are available at very fair rates.

Back in town, those same fair rates grab the attention of shoppers. In addition to the **factory outlet centers**, Branson shopping includes stores that favor the out-of-the-ordinary. Downtown has not one but two quilt stores: **Brier Rose and Ivy Rose**. Straight from the '40s, **Dick's** is an old-fashioned five-and-dime specializing in vintage keepsakes and traditional dimestore goods. If the merchandise doesn't grab you, there's always the jukebox to keep you entertained while your family and friends finish shopping.

Branson also has several theme parks. **Silver Dollar City** is set in the Ozarks of the 1880s, so in addition to rides such as Thunderation and Buzz Saw Falls, you'll find employees in period costume, old-fashioned eats and craftspeople demonstrating their techniques. **Shepherd of the Hills** is similarly themed. In addition to artisan shops, restaurants, horse-drawn wagon rides and jeep tours, the site features an 1,800-seat outdoor amphitheater with performances of the Ozark drama Shepherd of the Hills. Complete with a roaring bonfire, guns and snorting horses, Shepherd is performed nightly Spring through Fall. **White Water's** 12 acres attract kids with a wave pool, waterslides, rapids riding and a 200-foot drop on the Paradise Plunge.

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## Driving Directions

### From Kansas City, MO:

Take Hwy 71 S to Clinton  
Take exit 7 S toward Clinton and turn on MO 7 S for 39 miles  
Continue on MO 7 as it turns into MO 13 for 84 miles  
Merge onto I-44 E via the ramp on the left toward I-44 E/ROLLA  
Continue for 4 miles, then merge onto exit 82 A S toward Branson for 43 miles  
**Take Hwy 76/Country Blvd exit**  
**Go west on Hwy 76 for 1 mile**  
**Turn left at traffic light onto Fall Creek Rd and continue for 2.5 miles**  
**The resort entrance is on the right**  
**The check-in office is the second building on the left**

### From Little Rock, AR:

Go north on Hwy 65 for 170 miles to Branson  
Follow directions in **bold** above

### From St. Louis, MO:

Take I-44 W for 215 miles to Springfield  
Take Hwy 65 S for 40 miles to Branson  
Follow directions in **bold** above

### From Springfield, MO

Drive south on Airport Blvd from the Airport to Hwy 266  
Turn left at the light and continue for about one mile to I-44 E  
Take I-44 E for 8.8 miles to exit 82A/US-65 S to Branson and continue for 43 miles  
Follow directions in **bold** above
