Super Bowl Thoughts and Season Recap

The Super Bowl year in and year out is the most watched, hyped, analyzed, scrutinized and wagered event in the world. It's the game where gambling goes from being a sort of "taboo" among the general public to something tens of millions will partake in.

Because everyone wants to have a little "extra" something on the big game whether it be Super Bowl squares, side or total or the more than 500 Super Bowl prop plays, demand is at an all-time high for handicappers to deliver their customers winners on the big game. Fair or unfair it's also the game customers usually judge whether or not to sign back up with a particular service for the next season.

As for us, we think betting the Super Bowl side and/or total is mainly a "sucker's bet" as there is so much more value on a weekly basis during the regular season when there is 60+ games to choose from in college and the NFL combined. If you disagree with us and think there is a lot of value on the Super Bowl, look no further than the graph on the bottom right of this page. The Vegas books have shown a profit in 28 of the last 30 Super Bowls (93%).

We don't know about you, but we don't like losing and going up against a 93% profitable system is something we're not going to step in front of and it's why we don't usually have our biggest play of the year on the Super Bowl side or total unlike many public bettors who tend to save their biggest bet of the year on the biggest game.

We feel there is much more value in the props market in the Super Bowl and that's why we give out 10 prop bets or so every year to VIP customers. While we lean with Kansas City -3, our favorite bet for this year's Super Bowl is UNDER 10.5 penalties.

Win or lose, we would rather you judge us on the entire season where the star-rated picks on these pages (including bowls and playoffs) have gone 59-57-3 (not a good season). Add in the last five years and you're 522-426-19 (55%) betting every single star-rated pick on these pages the last 6 years. In an industry where so many tout advertise guaranteed winners and 70-90% records, the reality is 55% is the best record by far out of any newsletter the last 6 years (see page 4) and the most successful bettors (ex: Billy Walters) of all time have hit only 57% over the long haul.

Obviously we couldn't have had a successful last six years without your support and patronage. Again, we can't thank you enough that you took a chance on us in this season of BP Sports and for that we'll be forever grateful.

Many of you have already mailed us suggestions and comments on how we can improve this newsletter. **One of your main criticisms this season was we didn't have many strong picks (3-stars or higher). Keep in mind, that was intentional! This was a very unique year where you didn't know exactly who was playing until gameday because of COVID.** What good would a bunch of higher-rated picks released on Wednesday do you when a position group would test positive late in the week? Another major suggestion is you want more picks and more info particularly later in the week. That is what VIP service is for! We used to sell all-year VIP memberships for \$999, that price is now \$499. Quite simply, if you bet \$50 or less on each game, stay with the newsletter. If you're betting hundreds of dollars on each game, maybe try out VIP.

Super Bowl Betting Notes (Reported By ESPN)

-Last year, \$154.7 million was bet on the Super Bowl at Nevada sports books. The books won a record \$18.8 million when the Chiefs beat the 49ers.

-The books have posted a profit in 28 of the past 30 Super Bowls (see below).

-Since Nevada Gaming Control began tracking betting action on the Super Bowl in 1991, the books are up \$205.2 million. Their only losses came in 2008, when the New York Giants upset the Patriots, and in 1995, when the San Francisco 49ers routed the San Diego Chargers (see chart below).

-According to an estimate released by the American Gaming Association, Americans will bet \$4.3 billion on Super Bowl 55. That's a drop from last year and it is almost entirely caused by pandemic-led restrictions, with the largest declines anticipated for retail sportsbooks and casual bets, like pools or squares, that are made in social settings.

-The early action on the Super Bowl has not seen much movement on side or total. Sharper bettors are taking Tampa Bay at +3.5 and the total has dropped a point.

- \$2.3 Million on Buccaneers +3.5 (-115) at BetMGM in Nevada (Thu., Jan. 28).
- \$520,000 on the Chiefs -3 (-120) at the William Hill sportsbook at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas (Mon., Feb. 1).
- \$200,000 on Chiefs -3 (-116) at Draft Kings (Mon., Feb. 1).
- \$180,000 on the Chiefs moneyline (-180) at BetMGM (Sun., Jan. 24).
- \$139,883 on Chiefs -3.5 (even) at the Red Rock Casino and Resort in Las Vegas (Sat., Jan. 30).

Kansas City 30 TAMPA BAY 26. The Chiefs are making back-to-back Super Bowl appearances after beating the 49ers last year while the Bucs are playing in their first Super Bowl since the 2002 season. This is the first time that a team will play a home game in the Super Bowl but with only 25,000 fans allowed, it won't be the typical homefield advantage for the Bucs.

The Chiefs did beat the Bucs 27-24 here earlier this season as KC led 27-10 entering the 4Q. QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 462 yards, including touchdowns of 75, 44 and 20 yards to WR Tyreek Hill, who finished with 13 catches for 269 yards. Hill had seven catches for 203 yards in the first quarter alone! KC outgained TB 377-131 by halftime but three KC drives inside the Bucs 20, however, only netted a pair of short field goals. It could've been worse.

While Kansas City had a stretch this season where they went 0-8-1 ATS, they were usually laying huge point-spreads. KC did go a perfect 7-0 SU vs winning teams this year with a +155 ypg advantage. We bring up vs winning teams because at times it has looked like KC has been disinterested this season. However, look at some of their stat margins vs the best teams in the NFL: +289 yards at Baltimore, +260 at Buffalo, +126 at Tampa Bay, +81 at Miami, +126 at New Orleans, +130 vs Cleveland and +76 vs Buffalo in the AFC Championship. Meanwhile, Tampa Bay was only 3-4 SU vs winning teams this year getting outgained by 51 ypg. However, they are clearly playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight playoff wins all on the road and have looked like a different team after the late-season bye (7-0 SU).

This is only the 2nd time Tom Brady has been an underdog in the Super Bowl going back to his first appearance after the 2001 season when the Pats upset the Rams 20-17 as 14-point underdogs and we're not sure we want to fade him as an underdog (see ATS to the left). Originally, we thought we would be strong on KC here. However, going over the check-list (see left), these two teams are much closer than we anticipated. We also worry about a KC team playing without both starting offensive tackles. Therefore, we only lean with the Chiefs.

Our favorite bet of this year's Super Bowl is UNDER 10.5 penalties (good up to -150). Accepted offensive penalties were the lowest this season in the modern era! There were just six penalties in the NFC Championship game and seven in the AFC championship game. Officials are not going to interfere with the biggest game of the year by throwing a bunch of flags.
