NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE COMBINATION TAX AND SURPLUS REVENUE  
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION  
TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of New Summerfield, Texas, at its meeting to commence at 6:30 P.M. on September 10, 2024, at the City Hall, 13280 State Hwy 110 North, New Summerfield, Texas, tentatively proposes to adopt an ordinance authorizing the issuance of interest bearing certificates of obligation, in one or more series, in an amount not to exceed \$3,915,000 for paying all or a portion of the City's contractual obligations incurred in connection with (i) acquiring, constructing, and installing additions, improvements, extensions, and equipment for the City's waterworks system, including water storage facilities, water lines, pumps, valves, fittings, water wells and related infrastructure improvements; and (ii) legal, fiscal and engineering fees in connection with such projects. The maximum interest rate for the certificates may not exceed the maximum legal interest rate. The maximum maturity date for the certificates is September 30, 2054 and the estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the certificates to be authorized on time and in full is \$6,272,229. The City currently has no outstanding debt obligations. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such certificates of obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law and from a pledge of certain surplus revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system, remaining after payment of all operation and maintenance expenses thereof, and all debt service, reserve, and other requirements in connection with all of the City's revenue bonds or other obligations (now or hereafter outstanding), which are payable from all or any part of the net revenues of the City's waterworks and sewer system. The certificates of obligation are to be issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of V.T.C.A., Local Government Code, Subchapter C of Chapter 271.
