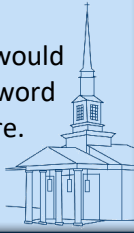

## Operation Christmas Child

Operation Christmas Child organizers are currently looking to hire around 500 people for a 3 ½ to 4-week project with Operation Christmas Child. There are many jobs available for warehouse workers, certified forklift operators, Class A drivers, team coaches, data entry and mail processing on both first and second shifts. The processing work season begins mid-November and runs through December. These positions are temporary, full-time paid opportunities, Monday through Saturday, and require a solid commitment for the duration of the project. The ideal candidates for these positions have a relationship with Christ, align with the mission of Samaritan's Purse, are customer service oriented, flexible and able to function well in a fast-paced environment. God is so amazing, last year in a pandemic they packed around 9 million shoeboxes and each shoebox impacts around 10 people for Jesus. That's 90 million people who are impacted by this project a year.
