## Wool Testing

Wool fabrics & fibers used in Junior, Senior and Adult/Professional divisions MUST be at least 60% wool. All divisions are encouraged to meet this same criteria.

Entry forms, fees & fabric samples are due at least 2 weeks prior to your district contest. Fabric samples (5-inch square of each fabric & 36 inches of each yarn used) may be sent in for testing earlier. Send all info to:
