

SUPPLY LIST-Mystery Quilt-Michele Ripplinger

Finished Size: approximately 19" x 57"

Pattern Fee: \$8.00 payable to the instructor

The most important thing to remember when selecting fabrics for a mystery quilt is contrast. The fabrics should have good contrast among them in order for the pattern to emerge. Use color and/or value to achieve this contrast. Avoid directional fabrics unless you are prepared to ignore their prints.

Fabric # 1 – Light	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard
Fabric # 2 – Medium	fat quarter or $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Fabric # 3 – Dark	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Border	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard *
Backing	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard *
Binding	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Batting

*if you use the same fabric for both the border and the backing, 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards will be enough for both. You do not need the extra $\frac{1}{2}$ yard piece for the border.

Other Supplies: sewing machine, thread, basic, Basic Sewing Kit and Rotary Rotary Cutter Equipment
