

FORMER PIGEON PASTOR DIES IN PINCONNING

Rev. Joseph K. Dibden, 60, died of a heart attack Tuesday morning at his home in Pinconning. Rev. Dibden was born in Lyburn Park, England, May 9, 1884. He was married at Melvin, Mich.,

He was pastor of the Pigeon Methodist church 1936 to 1940. Other charges he held were Shabbona, Bay Port, Kingston, Utica, Sandusky, Port Huron, Fairgrove and Chesaning previous to going to Pinconning two years ago.

Surviving besides his widow, Ada M., is a son, Arthur J. Dibden; a student at the Chicago Theological Seminary; a daughter, Miss Josephine G. Dibden, a student at Adrian College; and two brothers, Edward Dibden, of Bournemouth, and Alfred Dibden of Potton, England.

The funeral services will be held today, conducted by Rev. Frank M. Field, district superintendent. Burial will be in Elsie.
