Rules:

No residence restrictions.

Entry forms, along with all entry fees, will be received up to 15 minutes prior to the event beginning.

Give the name of your partner for all doubles events, partner must also enter separately.

Contestants may only compete once during any event

Adult entry fee per event is \$10.00 (non-refundable)

Youth entry fee is \$5.00 (non-refundable)

Payouts will be issued at the end of each event.

Double-Hand Bucking:

Jack & Jack Bucking, Jack & Jill Bucking, Jill & Jill Bucking and Adult & Youth Bucking

- Pants and close-toe shoes are required
- Timed event

Chainsaw Events: 0-80cc, 80-95cc and 95cc & up

- Only standard, commercially available chainsaws may be used
- Maximum sprocket size allowed: 8-tooth sprocket
- Saws must use gasoline powered single cylinder engines
- No nitro, alcohol, or alternative fuel engines
- All competitors must start their saw with no assistance
- Saws are subject to inspection prior to competition
- Staff reserve the right to disqualify any chainsaw deemed unsafe or outside the permitted specifications
- Final approval of saw eligibility rests in the competition judge or event official
- Pants, chaps, and close-toe shoes are required
- Contestants cutting more than a 2" round will be disqualified
- Contestants who do not saw off a complete round will be disqualified
- Timed event

Axe Throw: Men, Women and Youth

- Only the leading edge of the axe will score
- Neither contestant nor judge may touch an axe in the target until the contestant and judge agree on the score. A third party may be called if the agreement cannot be reached.
- Scoring is as follows: beer can 6 points, colored ring closest to beer can 5 points, next ring 4 points, next ring 3 points, next ring 2 points, and outside ring 1 point
- Best three out of four throws

Choker Set: Men , Women and Youth

- Pants and close-toe shoes required
- First to the finish line wins

Nail Pounding: Women and Youth

- Ladies and youth only
- Only nails pounded completely into the log will count
- Bent over nails do not count
- Minors must wear eye protection
- Most fully pounded in nails in 1-minute wins

Log Roll

- No caulk or spiked boots
- The first person to hit the water is out
- Single elimination bracket

Pole climb

- Climbing gear with boots required
- Prior experience required
- Timed event

Pole Fall

- Competition will be between the two top male point scorers
- Closest pole to the beer can wins

High Point Man, Woman and Youth

- Points will be awarded as follows: First: 3 points, Second: 2 points, Third: 1 point
- The top 2 high point men will qualify to compete in the Pole Fall
- The Pole Fall is worth 50 points
- The high point man will be named Bull of the Woods
- The high point woman will be named Chick of the Sticks
- The high point youth will be named Teen of the Timber
- Trophies will be awarded to the people who are the overall high point winners
