Philip K. Walker, 89 of Caro, formerly of Elton, died suddenly Friday, June 2 at Caro Community Hospital.

He was born Nov. 10, 1905 in Hubbardston, MI, going to Detroit to live as a young boy. He moved to Elton in 1946 from Bertley, Mich., and lived there until moving to Caro in 1991.

While in Elton, he operated a gas station for many years and had been an active member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church, and with the Senior Citizens Group. Currently, he was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church of Caro.

On July 31, 1928, he married Kathleen V. McDonough in Birmingham. She survives him.

Surviving besides his wife are six children and their spouses: Philip J. and Nancy Walker of Harbor Springs; James B. and Dolores Walker of Almont, Michael A. and Jacquelyn Walker of Frankenmuth; Margaret Linda LaFave of Auburn Hills, Kathryn L. and James Eisengruber of Sebawaing; Mary and Bernard Nelson of Caro; 25 grandchildren and 33 great-grandchildren; two sisters, Louise Walker of Bradenton, Fla., and Agnes Micks of Millford; and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and five brothers.
