Jean-Claude Boisset Bourgogne Pinot Noir (Les Ursulines 2023)

Jean-Claude Boisset is one of Burgundy's most compelling maisons, founded in 1961 in Nuits-Saint-Georges and known for its refined, contemporary approach to winemaking. Under the direction of Jean-Charles Boisset and winemaker Grégory Patriat, the house focuses on terroir-driven wines crafted with precision and minimal intervention. Working with carefully selected, often hand-harvested fruit from across Burgundy, Jean-Claude Boisset produces wines that emphasize purity, balance, and a clear sense of place. This Bourgogne Pinot Noir reflects that contemporary philosophy, offering a fresh and expressive interpretation of the region with clarity, balance, and finesse.

Vineyard and Terroir

- **Location:** Burgundy, primarily Côte de Nuits and Côte de Beaune.
- **Soil Type:** Clay-limestone soils typical of Burgundy.
- **Viticulture Practices:** Fruit sourced from selected vineyard parcels with vines averaging 35–40 years old, supporting concentration and balance.



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Winemaking

- **Harvest:** Handpicked between 9 and 23 September 2023, with sorting in the vineyard and again at the winery.
- **Vinification:** Grapes are fully destemmed but not crushed and transferred by gravity into tanks. Maceration lasts around 20 days with gentle extraction through punch-downs and pump-overs to preserve fruit purity and structure.



Tasting Notes

- **Appearance:** Bright garnet red colour.
- **Aroma:** Elegant aromas of red berries and blackcurrant with subtle peppery notes.
- **Palate:** Fresh and balanced, with silky tannins, vibrant fruit, and a refined structure.
- **Finish:** Smooth and persistent, combining freshness with gentle spice.
- **Aging potential:** 3 to 5 years under good storage conditions.



Food Pairing

- **Recommended Pairings:** Ideal with poultry, charcuterie, light red meat dishes, and soft cheeses.



Sustainable Practices and Certifications

- **Sustainable Winemaking:** part of the Boisset Collection, which promotes wines produced in harmony with the land and a long-term commitment to terroir and environmental responsibility.
