

Executive works to facilitate foreign trade

The Minister of Commerce, Fiel Constantino, said on Thursday the 3rd in Luanda, that in terms of exports the Angolan Executive is setting up institutional support mechanisms and seek solutions to overcome the technical barriers, with a view to facilitating international trade.

Fiel Constantino made this statement at the opening of the second forum "To Internationalize is To Grow", organized by the Community of Exporting and Internationalized Companies of Angola (CEEIA), in the context of its third anniversary.

According to the Minister, current times require the existing of companies, in the country, with productive capacity, know-how, and acquired sensitivity and with innovative ways to extend opportunities, advantages as well as the will to internationalize and to export services and products.

He added that such, would position Angola in front of international ranks, being the community of exporting and internationalized companies of Angola, one of the guardians in the process.

The Minister stated that in view of the current course of the economy, the Executive approved the strategy to address the crisis in the form of increased domestic production and exports, creating jobs and reducing hunger and poverty.

CEEIA's second forum has as its main focus, challenges, opportunities and prospects that the diversification of Angola's economy and the dynamics of globalization offer as space of participation and intervention for national entrepreneurs.
