

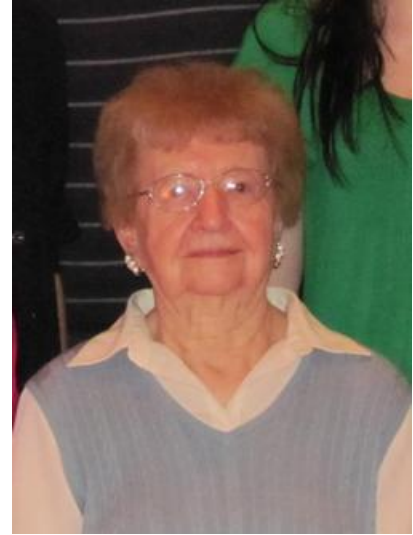
Aldine R Ewald
