Ezekiel 47:1a "The man brought me back to the entrance of the temple, and I saw water coming out from under the threshold of the temple..."

On Saturday June 22nd I returned home from a family vacation. I was glad to be home as well as tired from the day's travel. While I lay in bed that evening, I had no way of anticipating what was waiting for me at the church the next morning. I arrived at the church early as is my Sunday routine. As I entered the usually quite building I heard the faint sound of rushing water, like a stream that was bursting forth from somewhere under the building. I followed the sound and lifted the hatch door to the access panel where the water main enters the building. As I lifted the hatch about two inches my leg up to my knee became soaked with spraying water. A pipe had broken and the shutoff valve was missing! The rest of the morning before worship was filled with frantic calls to our Building and Grounds Committee, the borough, the water authority, even the police in an effort to solve the problem of unrelenting rushing water. We were fortunate that the leak was in a cubby under the floor and that no real property damage occurred from the flowing river. Our Building and Grounds Committee responded quickly in addressing the issue and I am pleased to say the water problem has been fixed; Building and Grounds committee deserves your thanks!

Now that things have calmed down, I appreciate the irony of the river coming from "under the threshold of the temple" as depicted in Ezekiel chapter 47. Ezekiel talks about a trickle of water that originates from under the temple. As Ezekiel's guide leads him along this water, it keeps getting deep-

er, first being ankle deep (v3), then knee deep and waist deep (v4), then becoming a full river (v5). At this point Ezekiel is told how the river continues to grow as it flows toward the sea, and not only that, but is bringing fresh water and abundant life to the shores it flows through until it reaches the dead sea. There the fresh water grows trees and many kinds of fish and vegetation, a depiction easily likened to the Garden of Eden. It is a river of life, bringing life to a dessert and a sea long thought to be uninhabitable.

What is most striking about this river is the manner in which in grows. The river builds and deepens along the way without any additional tributaries. It just keeps getting bigger and more powerful as it flows from its source. This is an image of the power of our faith. Jesus uses the parable of the mustard seed (Matt. 13) in a similar way to describe the expansion of the Kingdom of God. "Though it is the smallest of all your seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree".

Friends, I know that sometimes we feel like the world is becoming spiritually dead. That the landscape around us is more like the dead sea than a lush garden. But a single trickle of faith can bring forth a flowing river that brings life and faith to an entire region. The world is not dead nor is it dying, it just needs watered! Jesus said in John 7:38, "whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within them." As Christians we have a spring of life inside us, waiting for us to allow it to burst forth to be the encouragers of hope, life, and love. Let the waters of God flow forth!

We want to reach 100 kids this year with the messages that God is a friend who is real, who loves them, who they can trust, who will be their forever friend and is a friend to everyone!




