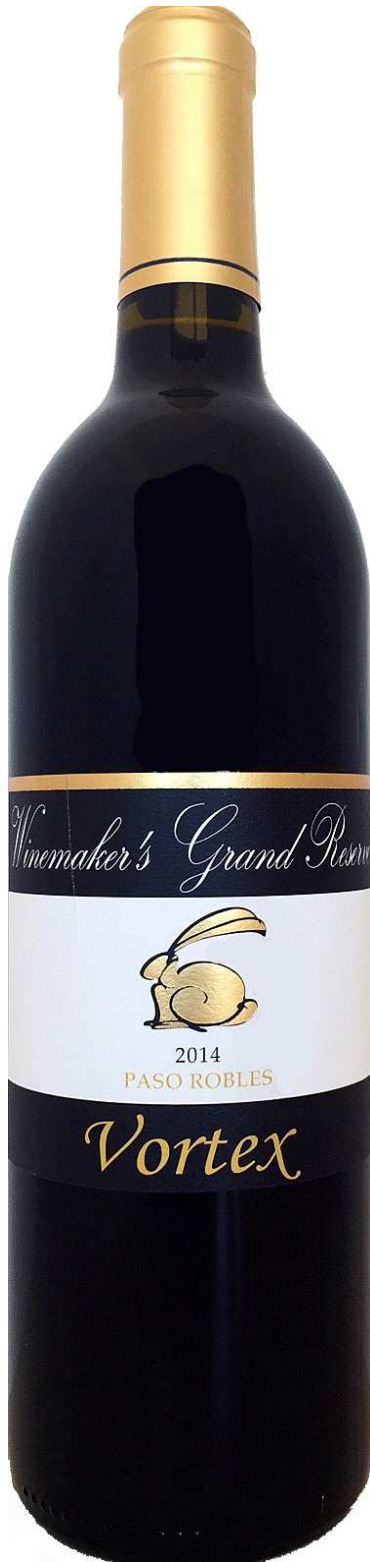

APPELLATION Paso Robles

GRAPE VARIETIES Zinfandel, Grenache

ALCOHOL 15.8%

CASES PRODUCED 145

VINIFICATION Produced entirely from west side fruit grown on our Texas Road vineyard in Paso Robles. Hand picked into half ton bins. Cold soaked at 40 degrees for seven days. Extended skin contact for three to five weeks. Pumped over five to six times per day. Pressed and pumped to barrels. Aged 10 months in 100% new American oak.

TASTING Rich and dark with loads of blackberry, blueberry and spice all framed by roasted vanilla bean notes. Polished and elegant through the finish. Two of our best grape varietals combined to make a most memorable wine. A great combination of power and finesse. Vortex was named for the hurricanes in Florida where Joanne Russell grew up.
