Piecing the Blocks

1. Sew a light triangle to each dark triangle to make a triangle square. Make . Press the seams toward the dark triangles. Trim the dogears. The triangle squares should measure 2½" x 2½".

2. Sew a triangle square to each dark 2½" square as shown. Make 16. Press the seam toward the dark square.

3. Sew the remaining triangle squares to each light 2½" square as shown. Make 16. Press the seam toward the light square.



Make 16 H

4. Join the units from steps 2 and 3 as shown to make 16 outer-star-point units. Press the seams toward the dark-square units. The units should measure 4½" x 4½".

 Use a sharp pencil or fabric marking pen to draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the light and accent 1½" squares.

8-1.5" squares

6. Place a light 1½" square on one corner of an accent 2½" square as shown, right sides together. Stitch on the marked line. Trim ¼" from the stitching line. Press the seam toward the triangle. Repeat on the opposite corner to complete an inner-star-point unit. Make 16. 4

7. Repeat step 6 with the accent 1½" squares and the light 2½" squares to make the middle-starpoint units.










