COMPLEXITY broke in and a step slow, moved up near the inside to take the lead, controlled the action in the two path through the turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, drew away under the whip into the final sixteenth then was placed under a hand ride to the wire while much the best. HARVEY WALLBANGER showed good speed then chased the pace while rubbing saddles with BINARY, had STOCK CHAIN clip his hind right heel at the seven-sixteenths, pursued the winner in the five path on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and proved no match but safely secured the place. KING FOR A DAY broke a half-step slow, was urged along on the outside, jostled with STOCK CHAIN leaving the backstretch then steadied briefly when that foal clipped heels, raced in the seven path early on the turn, dropped to the six then five path while dropping well behind the leader and lacked the needed response but narrowly earned the show. AZRAEL dropped off the pace then angled in outside the half-mile pole, saved ground under urging on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch under the whip and came up empty. SOUTHERN PHANTOM was sluggish from the start and slow into stride, dropped well behind the rest of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, turned into the stretch under the whip, had the rider lose the whip inside the furlong marker and was no factor. BINARY showed speed then pressed the pace while rubbing saddles with HARVEY WALLBANGER, tracked the winner in the four path on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch and tired. STOCK CHAIN chased the pace under vigorous urging, jostled with KING FOR A DAY leaving the backstretch then clipped the heels of HARVEY WALLBANGER, stumbled very badly then swerved out severely while nearly losing the rider, had the rider show an amazing feat of balance and skill to hang on to his neck and remain aboard then was pulled up but walked off. Following a stewards' inquiry into the incident leaving the backstretch, no change was made to the order of finish.
