Richard R. Meyers, 65, passed away at his home in Caseville on Sunday morning after a two-weeks illness.

He was born in Caseville on November 21, 1887, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Charles Meyers, and had lived there all his life with the exception of about two years spent in military service during World War I, including overseas service. He was married to Mrs. Emma Farver on July 19, 1927, in Saginaw.

Surviving besides his widow are one daughter, Viola, at home; two stepsons, Frank Farver, of Algonac, and Thomas Farver, of Caseville; two sisters, Mrs. Flossie Hartman and Mrs. Merle Mapley, both of Caseville; one brother, Charles Meyers, of Harbor Springs; 12 grandchildren, and six great grandchildren.

He was an active member of the Jean American Legion Post, of Caseville, and for a number of years was a member of the Stamitz-Lindeman Post, of Sebewaing.

Military funeral rites were set for 2 p. m. Thursday under auspices of the Jean American Legion Post at the R. L. D. S. Church, with Elder Archie Harder, of Bay Port, officiating. Burial was to be in the Caseville Cemetery.
