Come to our flagship Diversity Training Institute in Yakima, or bring our training to you!

In Yakima, WA

Our annual 5-day professional learning event in Yakima is designed for teams of educators with the goal of creating a Diversity Action Plan. Other organizations and individuals are also welcome to attend.

PARTICIPANTS	PER PERSON	NOTES
Individuals	\$1,500	Individuals may receive the team discount if they belong to a UnityWorks team with a current paid membership.
Teams	\$1,250	Site teams or groups of 4+ registering together. Minimum team size = 4; no maximum.
Superintendent/CEO	Free	If attending with their team, and if minimum class size has already been met.
Minimum class size = 25. Maximum = 40, including high school and college students.

Notes

What's Included: Training fee includes a resource-packed workbook for each participant, plus one Teaching Unity book and one Multicultural Conference Planning Guide per school or team. The fee for Yakima also includes a light breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack. Additional meals, lodging and travel not included.

Minimum Number: For trainings on location, the minimum number of participants may be reached by a single district or organization, or by a consortium of groups combined. For example, several smaller districts may partner to obtain the large group discount. UnityWorks will provide electronic promotional materials (brochures, fliers, introductory PPT) to assist with recruitment.

Planning Checklist: For trainings on location, the host organization is responsible for practical matters such as securing a venue, reserving AV equipment, and arranging for catering and clock hours if desired. An easy planning checklist will be sent with the contract so you have everything needed to organize a successful training event.

School Program: Following the training, site teams are invited to join the UnityWorks School Program (see below) which offers ongoing support to the teams as they implement their Diversity Action Plans.

In addition to participating in the Summer Training Institute, site teams are invited to join the [UnityWorks School Program](#) which offers ongoing support to the teams as they implement their Diversity Action Plans. Membership term is Sept. 1 – Aug. 31. Each school or university is also encouraged to provide a small budget (\$1,000) to support their site team’s Diversity Action Plan throughout the year.

If two or more teams from the same school district or university wish to join the Program, that organization is asked to identify a local Coordinator who will supervise their participating teams and serve as a liaison to UnityWorks.
