

BYLAW NO. 140
SUMMER VILLAGE OF SOUTH VIEW

Being a Bylaw of the Summer Village of South View to Amend Bylaw 128, Control and Regulation of Disposal of Sewage

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of South View passed a bylaw to control and regulate the disposal of sewage and wastewater in the municipality; and

WHEREAS Council wishes to amend that bylaw to acknowledge effectively working systems that do not meet the criteria outlined in the bylaw in place; and

WHEREAS Council wishes to allow fully functioning septic systems to be “grandfathered” until such time as there is a system breakdown;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of South View, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

The following addition will be made to the Requirements Section-

REQUIREMENTS

4. Where a residential property has a septic field system that is working effectively and meets the requirements of the Alberta Private Sewage Systems Standard of Practice, the property owner may continue the use of the system with the provision that the field is inspected between the date of the passing of this Bylaw and August 31, 2004, and further, that the inspection report must be filed with the administration office.

5. Once a system breakdown or failure of any kind occurs or there is any infraction to the Alberta Private Sewage Systems Standard of Practice, the system must be brought into compliance with the regulations of Bylaw 128 within 60 days.

The penalties for contravention of these bylaws are:

- a) first offence – fine of \$500.00
- b) second offence, - fine of \$1,000.00
- c) third and subsequent offence, - fine of \$2,500.00
- d)

Bylaw 137 – Sewage Amendment Bylaw, is rescinded at the passing of this bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on its final passing.

READ a first time this 2nd day of April 2004.

READ a second time this 2nd day of April 2004.

READ a third and final time this 22nd day of June 2004.
