A. Consider and Discuss Rescheduling Regularly Scheduled Meetings that Fall on City Holidays, Including Memorial Day on May 25, 2026.

Mayor Forester said that a meeting that falls on a holiday is normally moved to the following business day.

B. Consider and Discuss Appointing a Member to the Cisco Development Corporation and Cisco 4A Development Corporation Boards.

Mr. Bailey indicated that the CDC did not currently have a recommendation to fill these positions, but said he would like to review any nominated parties and take to his boards for recommendation before the Council appoints.

C. Consider and Discuss Approval Amendment of Council Rules of Procedure, Specifically Article 2, Section K, Regarding Citizen/Visitor Comments.

Ms. Adams explained that the procedures for citizen/visitor comments had been changed by the state legislature and the policy needs to be updated to comply with current state law. Councilmember Johnson asked for clarification on whether the five minutes was cumulative or once a commenter has spoken they have up to five minutes and cannot comment again. He indicated that he would not be in favor of limiting the citizens/visitors ability to address the Council.

Motion was made by Councilmember Boles to approve the amendment as presented, second was made by Councilmember Bruner. Motion prevailed by the following vote:
