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Trump's latest visa restrictions could hold back economic recoveries

President Donald Trump recently signed an executive order temporarily freezing all new immigrant visas from being used, including the H-1B, L-1, and most J-1 visas. The White House argued that 525,000 American jobs will be saved or created by the move.

But some experts argue that the move is misguided. And research from 2014 also reveals that the last time the U.S. restricted H1-B visas, the economy paid a price.

"If we're talking about a visa ban between now and January and then it gets relaxed, it doesn't have major, long-term effects on the economy," Wells Fargo Acting Chief Economist Jay Bryson told Yahoo Finance's The Final Round. "But if we're having this conversation three or four years from now and we will have a visa ban... that will have some long-term competitiveness negative effects on the U.S. economy."

2007, 2008 visa denials inflicted 'huge cost to the economy'

In his executive order, President Trump stated that foreign workers pose an "unusual threat" to American workers during this recession.



"American workers compete against foreign nationals for jobs in every sector of our economy, including against millions of aliens who enter the United States to perform temporary work," he stated. "Under ordinary circumstances, properly administered temporary worker programs can provide benefits to the economy. But under the extraordinary circumstances of the economic contraction resulting from the COVID-19 outbreak, certain nonimmigrant visa programs authorizing such employment pose an unusual threat to the employment of American workers."

However, a 2014 study by the New American Economy found that H-1B visa denials in 2007 and 2008, amid the last recession, actually hurt American-born tech workers and levied a "huge cost to our economy." The main reason why H1-B visas support job creation was attributed to the fact that high-skilled engineers and programmers need valuable support services from less-educated tech workers, the authors stated.

"To grow out of this recession, the U.S. needs to create more jobs, and economists overwhelmingly agree that immigrants — particular those in the innovative-rich, high-skilled professions that H1B holders work in — do just that," New American Economy Executive Director Jeremy Robbins told Yahoo Finance. "Cutting off access to talented immigrant workers ... hurts their American-born coworkers far more than it helps them."

The denial of 178,000 H-1B visa applications in computer-related fields during those two years resulted in an estimated loss of more than 230,000 tech jobs for American-born workers and cost U.S.-born, college-educated workers in computer-related fields as much as \$3 billion in aggregate annual earn

State of the Muslim Umma

What have we learned from history? Quran shows clear guidelines for solution. What is happening to Muslims worldwide is a matter of grave concern for every advocate of human rights. Uyghur Muslims are in concentration camps for believing in their faith. Hundreds and thousands of Rohingya Muslim refugees from Myanmar are seeking shelter in neighboring Bangladesh, which cannot support them. In Kashmir, Indian forces have brutalized Muslims for standing up for their rights. In India, the extremists killed thousands of Muslims and destroyed properties worth millions for opposing discrimination against them. Under the new extremists' regime in India, Muslims live like second class citizens. Most of them are poor, illiterate, and face violence and terror daily. Palestinians 70 years struggle for freedom and an independent state after losing almost 70 percent of their land is a never-ending story of oppression in our world. The Jewish state is forcing them out of their homes and is building new settlements, forcing the natives to live an extremely miserable life. Muslims in Europe and the United States face Islamophobes every day.

The fate of Muslims in their homeland is not particularly rosier. From one end of the Muslim world to the next, Muslims - in Iran, Syria, Egypt, and Saudi Arabia - live under brutal regimes, ruthless kings and dictators, with limited civil liberties and Human rights.

Two major factors contribute to the prevailing pathetic dismal condition of Muslims worldwide: Lack of education and lack of unity.

The Gulf Countries have trillions of dollars from oil revenues, a financial bonanza, a great gift, and a blessing from God. Proper utilization of this wealth can create educational institutions and industries all over the Muslim world that may help eliminate illiteracy and poverty and make the Muslim Umma, once again, a vibrant community in the world.

Unfortunately, the Muslim Umma has divisions in the name of sects, such as Shia, Sunni, Ismaili, Bhoras, Ahmadiyya, Deobandi, Barelvi, Salafi, Wahabis, Ahle Sunnat, Ahl Quran, and Sufis just to name a few.

The scholars are busy declaring anyone who does not agree with their interpretation of Islam as a deviant. Some go to the extent of saying their opponents as Blasphemers.

They tell the world that Islam is a religion of peace and tolerance; however, they do not practice what they teach. The nobility of a human being depends on one's actions, and Allah is the only one who can judge the loyalty and nobility of a human being. According to the Quran, all human beings are from the same soul, but they have differences. The Quran says: "O humankind, we (God) have created you male and female, and made you into communities and tribes so that you may know one another. Surely, the noblest among you in the sight of God is the most God-fearing of you; God is all-knowing and all-aware" (49:13).

Unfortunately, not many Muslims follow these Quranic commandments.

During the last 30-40 years, we have seen a marked increase in sectarian violence. It is common to hear that Muslims (Shias and Sunnis) planting the bombs in Masjids on Fridays, the most sacred day for Muslims, and or planting bombs in shrines killing scores of innocent people. It confirms extremist behavior, and if this behavior continues, this will cause serious damage to Muslim Umma. We must stop the massacre of Muslims by Muslims so that Muslims can be united to face the biggest terror from Islamophobes and anti-Muslim organizations which are trying to annihilate Muslims. There is no doubt that the Christians Jews, Hindus, and others are committing the atrocities against Muslims. However, we can cope and find better ways to deal with these issues if we stand united.

The atrocities committed by Muslim groups are harrowing and intolerable. By blaming each other or blaming a conspiracy or foreign influences are not going to alleviate the problems. It is our responsibility to avert this situation before it escalates any further. Allah says in the Quran: "As to those who split up their religion and become sects, have you nothing to do with them; their affair is with God. Hereafter shall He tell them what they have been?" (6:159)

"Yet they divided themselves into factions, each rejecting in what they had. So, leave them in their bewilderment for a while." (23:53-54)

The majority of Muslims condemn violence, but unfortunately, but not many are willing to challenge the fanatics who are promoting these behaviors. It requires a lot of courage and stamina to get out and face this challenge.

In the nineteenth century, as the Ottoman Empire was losing its power, Muslim countries were colonized by Western powers: Algeria and Tunisia by France, Libya by Italy, and Oman, Kuwait, Egypt, Sudan, and Yemen by Britain. The Sykes-Picot agreement of 1916 divided the remaining parts of the Empire. At the end of World War I, with the defeat of Germany, and the Ottoman Empire, France took over Lebanon and Syria, and Britain took control of Iraq, Kuwait, Jordan, and Palestine. Most of the Muslim world from the Middle East to the Far East was under European control. In 1932, the kingdom of Saudi Arabia came into existence with the help of the British government. In 1943, the Saudis signed a defense contract with the United States, which established its first military base at Dhahran in 1945. Saudi Arabia depends on the U.S. for its defenses. However, after the Second World War in 2 decades, most of the Muslim countries threw off the yoke of colonialism. The discovery of oil improved the financial status of the Gulf countries. A complex sequence of events revolved around that time and Muslim countries experienced political and social transformation and turmoil. Some key factors shaped the Middle East as we know it today.

The decline in the status and power of Muslim Umma is a global phenomenon. At the instigation of the U.S. and Saudis, Saddam started the war with Iran, result-

ing in the loss of life of a couple of millions of people and billions of dollars in 2 rich Muslim countries, making U.S. and Russia richer for sales of their arms. The entire Muslim world watched the destruction where both countries achieved nothing. In the 1990s, a few years after the end of the Iran-Iraq War, neoconservative politicians developed plans for the U.S. to regain access to the oil reserves in several Middle Eastern countries, including Iraq and Libya and to make them powerless. With the 9/11 attack on the Twin Towers as justification, a US-led coalition invaded Iraq in 2003. According to the Chicot report published in Britain in July 2016, the illegal Iraq War got off on false information that Iraq had hidden weapons of mass destruction. Saddam Hussein did not pose a threat to British interests, the report concluded. Unfortunately, the prolonged Iraq War resulted in giving birth to the terrorist organization ISIS, which declared sovereignty in part of Iraq and Syria (that ended in 2017).

The war brought more death and mayhem in the Muslim world than have all the terrorists (including ISIS) and militant groups combined. Hundreds of thousands of innocent Iraqi men, women, and children lost their lives. Today, American oil companies, once again, have control of Iraqi oil.

Saudi Arabia and the U.S. succeeded in isolating Saddam Hussein while the entire Muslim world watched the destruction of Iraq silently. They also encouraged sectarian violence that has yet to cease. More than a million Iraqis lost their lives with only a few thousand U.S. casualties and now sectarian hatred and violence rule of the country. Libya, one of the progressive countries, was the next target. The Muslim world watched its destruction quietly. Now there is anarchy in Libya. Where is the Muslim power? It is lost not by conspiracy but sheer foolishness and self-interest.

Once again, Syria is experiencing the same scenario. Now the western powers know that they do not have to waste their soldier's lives and do not have to spend their wealth. They spend minimum resources to promote sectarian violence, sell arms to Saudis, who supply the weapons to terrorist groups to fight against Syrian Govt. forces. Bashar al-Assad (and his Russian and Iranian backers) is responsible for the slaughter of thousands of Syrians. The result was the destruction of a stable country, with millions of Muslim refugees (the worst humanitarian crises in human history), and the loss of hundreds of thousands of Muslim lives. Turkey's war with the Kurds amounts to even more Muslims murdering Muslims. Egypt and Iran, too, continue to maim and kill their citizens in prisons or the streets. According to United Nations, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, and seven other Arab states in their coalition, the government, and the rebel forces in Yemen—may have committed war crimes in the bloody Yemeni civil war. Since the beginning of the conflict in Yemen, an estimated 85,000 children under five have died from extreme hunger and diseases, 14 million people are at risk of famine, 3 million are refugees, and 15 million men, women, and children have

no access to health care.

Iran is next in line, and the U.S. and Israel are already preparing to destroy Iran with the support of Saudis and Gulf countries. Saudi Arabia does not realize that after the destruction of Iran, the Gulf will have no option but to surrender its sovereignty to others.

In Pakistan, religious seminaries are everywhere. They recruit thousands of young children from poor families and provide them with free boarding and lodging (a good humanitarian work). They indoctrinate them with fanatic ideas, promoting the khilafat all over the world and killing people with a creed different from them, calling them (Kafir and Mushrik). Many in these seminaries learn that killings of kafir and mushrik will purify the land.

It is time that we must acknowledge the presence of fanatic behavior among Muslims. These violent practices are contrary to the actual teachings of Islam. Publicly it is impossible to equate Islam with peace when the very countries that are supposedly practicing Islam have this level of violence.

The majority of the Muslims (over 90%) do not subscribe to the sectarian violence. But, by keeping quiet, we are silently supporting the activities of those who indulge in violence. After each Terrorist attack, Muslim organizations and groups issue press releases condemning it and even claiming that the perpetrators are not Muslims. But there is no effect of these press releases except showing that we are against it. Two major international conferences took place in Jordan and Dubai attended by Ulemas of Shia and Sunni sects. They also ended in issuing big press releases with no significant influence on governments or ordinary people. Global Terrorism and sectarian violence by Muslims continues.

Today Islam is portrayed not as a religion of peace but as a religion of violence and Terrorism.

Boko Haram abducted 300 girls, Pakistani Taliban killed 140 children in addition to 70 more in Lahore. Al Shahab, Jaish Muhammad, and Lashkar Taiba, through their activities, bring ill fame to Islam. Quran Says, "If a man kills a believer intentionally, his recompense is Hell, to abide therein (for ever): And the wrath and the curse of Allah are upon him, and a dreadful penalty waits for him." (4:93) The rising of Islam phobia and its effect on minority Muslims in Western countries are serious issues. We need to remember that if we do not take care of Minorities in Muslim Majority countries, why anyone should care for Muslim Minorities in the Western countries. There is a saying that "Treat Others how you want others to treat you."

Young Muslims today are confused by the different "brands" of Islam practiced today. In Islam, the essential building blocks of faith or Aqidah, comprise of belief in one omnipotent God who is a sustainer of life and also in angels, revealed books, prophets, and Day of Judgment.

Beyond this essential foundation, the practice of religion has many variations in Shia, Sunni, and schools of thought (Hanafi, Maliki, Shafi'i, and Hanbali). Practicing any one sect or religious school of thought or none should be acceptable. Getting into intricacies must be considered divisive and, therefore, counter-productive to harmonious Intra-faith relationship. If you have strong faith, diversity in religious practice must be accepted as based on human understanding and should not be the cause of anger, hatred, and violence.

It is impossible to have an entire community of 1.6 billion to think alike on all issues, but it is possible to coexist with the people of different beliefs. The major challenge is to pursue people to stop killing one another because they have different interpretations of the Quran or events in history that took place 1,500 years ago. Today, young Muslims are learning more about Islam from Media, and unfortunately, our Imams and Muslim scholars are not addressing the issue of sectarianism and violence. The silence of community leaders on the dangers of bigotry and resulting death and destruction, as in our back-homes, should be our common cause of concern.

We should not wait until our youth become fanatics. We must ignore political events, which led to conflicts. We must teach our children to follow the teachings of the Quran and Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) by showing respect and dignity towards everybody and avoiding hatred and anger humiliation towards followers of any faith or creed, which may lead to discrimination suffering or killing of innocent people. It becomes complicated

for the many Muslims to reach out to the illiterate and superstitious Muslims in the Muslim majority countries especially when the well-organized Madrasas ingrained the young mind for 10-15 years with orthodox teachings with primary emphasis on rituals and with unshakeable beliefs in creeds which cannot be subjected to logical thinking. Many Muslims who wanted to bring this knowledge are not well organized and do not have a central leadership.

In North Texas, a group of Muslim community leaders developed an organization, the Institute of Quranic Knowledge and Religious Acceptance (IQRA).

We started dialogues with community leaders of the Islamic faith, irrespective of their being Sunni or Shia or any other minority sect. The purpose of these dialogues is not theological debate; instead, it is a discussion of how, as leaders, we can tell our followers that violence between the sects is counter-productive for all involved. We plan to protect future American Muslim generations from the scourge of sectarianism by practicing Islamic teachings of peace and tolerance of all faiths.

IQRA is the first organization of its kind in the Dallas-Fort Worth area and perhaps in the entire country. It has the vision to promote unity at the grassroots level among all peace-loving Muslims.

We reached out to all the imams (Muslim religious leaders) in the Dallas-Fort Worth community. We invited them to come together to discuss the ideas to develop a harmonious relationship. Some imams didn't respond, others weren't interested, but many more attended and supported the concept for the Institute to promote nonsectarian, religious feelings among our

children so they wouldn't grow up filled with hate and anger. We have since held many intra-faith events.

The purpose of these community interactions is to share concerns and develop proactive strategies for building bonds of trust and positive partnership to safeguard peace and tranquility. IQRA follows Quranic guidelines. Quran says "And We have revealed to you, [O Muhammad], the Book in truth, confirming that which preceded it of the Scripture and as a criterion over it. So, judge between them by what Allah has revealed and do not follow their inclinations away from what has come to you of the truth. To each of you We prescribed a law and a method. Had Allah willed, He would have made you one nation [united in religion], but [He intended] to test you in what He has given you; so race to [all that is] good. To Allah is your return all together, and He will [then] inform you concerning that over which you used to differ" (Quran 5:48).

God has sent down the Book Qur'an as a truth, confirming the Scriptures that came before it. These Books confirm and do not contradict one another and show that they are all different versions of one and the same message. Allah prescribed different regulations to suit different communities in different times. No doubt Allah could have prescribed one and the same Law for all human beings, but He did not do so to test people whether they obey or not what is given to them by Allah. As the real object of all the laws is the cultivation of virtues, Allah has commanded the people to excel one another in virtues, without paying heed to the apparent differences in different rituals, rulings and interpretations. As regards the differences, they

cannot be resolved by arguments or war. Allah will decide the truth on the day of Judgment.

Although the verse discussed the books revealed to previous generations which has created conflicts. Same thing happened to Muslims who developed conflicts due to different interpretations and different understandings of Quran.

If you believe your faith and Aqidas is correct. Follow it with full trust and Iman on it. Remember everybody believes in their Faith and Aqidas as you do. When we return to God, He will decide who is right or wrong. You do not humiliate, insult, denigrate any faith or Aqidas. It needs to be pointed here that 75% of people of the world do not agree with Islamic faith and Aqidas, while we Muslims strongly believe that this the only feelings towards people whose faith or Aqidas are different than yours. The decision about salvation will be made by God based on your virtuous behavior. Those who choose good behaviors of kindness, morality, and serving humanity will be rewarded. Therefore, we need to compete in doing good behavior to achieve God's Favor. Allah (swt) purposely created a diverse community in the world and gave intelligence and power to each one of us to choose the righteous behavior not to be preoccupied in proving who is right or wrong.

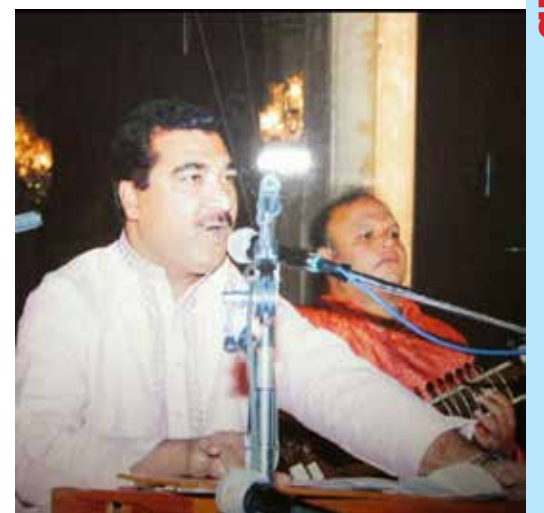

Story of Chota Veer (Little Brother) Gurtej Singh

Story of Chota Veer (Little Brother) Gurtej Singh just 23 years of age, whose boyish looks concealed a steely soldier, who never shyed away from an unequal fight.



On the evening of June 15 2020, the 16th Bihar regiment posted in the Galwan valley, were in a violent face-off with China along the disputed border in Ladakh. 3 Punjab's Ghatak Platoon was called upon to reinforce the outnumbered and outmanoeuvred fighters. The Medium Arty regiment's gunners also rushed out to help, carrying their customary kirpan and an assortment of sticks, rods and sharp knives only.

In the fight was SEPOY GURTEJ SINGH, who was attacked by 4 PLA soldiers. Shouting 'Bole So Nihal, Sat Sri Akal' war cry in a thunderous roar, he swung round two of them, and as two others tried to pin him down, he dragged all four of them towards the cliff and flung them over. He lost his balance though and slipped. But he got stuck in a boulder that stopped his free fall.

Though Sep Gurtej was injured severely in the neck and head, he rewrapped his turban and pulled himself back to the fight. He used his kirpan to fight more soldiers until he could snatch a sharp weapon from a Chinese soldier. He further took down 7 PLA soldiers, taking the tally to 11 before one stabbed him from behind. But before going down, he killed his final 12th enemy with his kirpan too.

At the end of the bloody fight, Gurtej lay dead but so were 12 Chinese soldiers. 'Ik Ik Sikh sawa lakh de barabar' (Sikh is as good as 125,000). Sep Gurtej's mortal remains were carried back by the surviving 'Ghataks'. The young warrior reached home on June 19, 2020 where the final farewell was conducted amidst full military honours.

Sep Gurtej was the youngest of 3 siblings. In his last call home, he said "will come home soon". He did come home but wrapped in the tricolours. Incidentally he was to attend his brother's wedding a fortnight back but decided to stay back at his post as the situation in Galwan valley was tense. Rest well young warrior- Jai Hind.

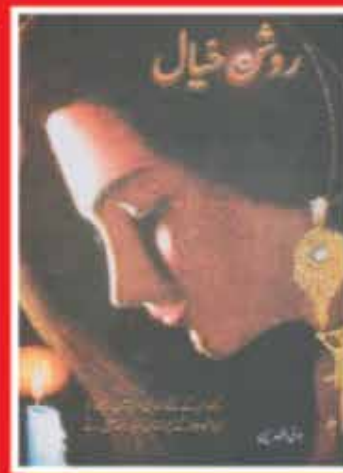

We will live with Covid19 for months. Let's not deny it or panic: Dr. Faheem Younus

Dr. Faheem Younus from the University of Maryland in America, head of the Infectious Disease Clinic, tweets facts about Covid-19, He Tweets We will live with Covid19 for months. Let's not deny it or panic. Let's not make life unnecessarily difficult. Let us learn to be happy and live with that fact.

The virus will not reduce its effect in the summer. It's summer in Brazil and Argentina, but the virus is spreading rapidly. You cannot destroy Covid19 viruses that have penetrated the cells by drinking too much water, you will just go to the toilet often.

Washing hands and keeping a distance of 1,8 meters is the best method of protecting against the virus. If you don't have a Covid19 patient at home, there is no need to disinfect the surfaces in the house.

Cargo packages, petrol pumps, shopping carts or ATMs do not cause infection. Wash your hands, live your life as usual. Covid19 is not a food infection. This is associated with drops of infection like flu. There is no documented risk of Covid19 being transmitted by ordering food.

Entering the sauna does not kill Covid19 viruses that have penetrated the cell. You can lose your smell with many allergies and viral infections. This is a non-specific symptom for Covid19.

Once we get home, we don't need to change clothes and shower urgently. Purity is a virtue, not paranoia. Covid19 virus does not hang in the air. This is a drip infection that requires close contact. The air is clean, you can walk around the gardens (keeping the distance) in the parks.

Covid19 does not separate race or religion, it is passed on to all people. It is enough to use normal soap against Covid19 by not necessarily using anti-bacterial soap. The virus is not a bacteria anyway.

You don't have to worry about your food orders. But if you want you can heat it up a bit in the microwave. The chance to bring Covid19 home with your shoes and getting sick is the same as getting hit by lightning twice a day. I've been working against viruses for 20 years, drip infections don't spread like this.

You cannot be protected from the virus by drink-



ing / eating vinegar, sumac, soda and ginger. Wearing gloves is a bad idea, the virus can accumulate on the glove, it can easily be transmitted if you touch your face. It's best to wash your hands.

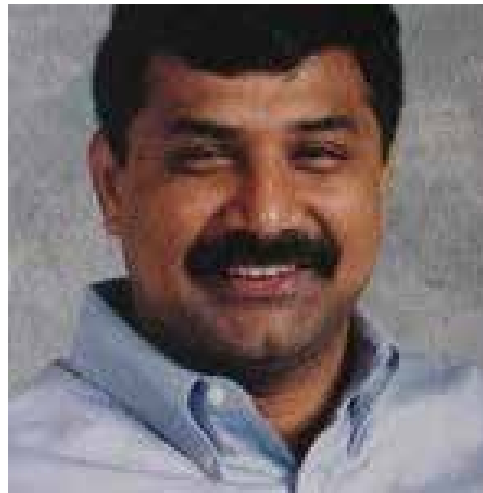

2020 Census Naperville Complete Count Committee

2020 Census Naperville Complete Count Committee
June 25, 2020 Panel Discussion
Press Release

On Thursday, June 25, a Panel Discussion was held with representatives from the Local, State and Federal Government, US Census Bureau and Naperville Area Community Organizations to discuss the role that residents and organizations play in assuring that all residents are counted in the 2020 US Census.

The Panel Discussion was hosted by Naperville Complete Count Committee under the leadership of Mayor Steve Chirico, City of Naperville and Mark Rice, Liaison, Naperville Complete Count Committee on Facebook Live. Over 300 people logged in and viewed the panel discussion.

Mark Rice, Panel Discussion moderator, announced that Naperville Complete Count Committee includes representatives from 135 Naperville Area Groups and is currently tracking #1 in the US at 79.8% US Census Self Response for cities over 140,000 residents.

Mayor Chirico, in his Opening Remarks, said that the Census will be of great help in understanding the profile of different sections of the community, allocating resources and taking innovative initiatives in order to ensure that Naperville further consolidates its position as a great City for the people to have successful careers, raise families, and retire peacefully.

Congressman Bill Foster, Illinois Senate, 11th District, underscored the importance of counting every person residing in the City. He noted that a community gains \$1,800 a year and \$18,000 over the 10 years before the next census for each resident counted.

Congresswomen Lauren Underwood, Illinois, 14th District, advised people to answer the Census questions without fear as these are confidential, protected by federal law, and cannot be used against them in any way. "Even though Naperville is leading the country in terms of overall response rate, many children are still at a higher risk of going uncounted. Each and every resident of a household need to be

counted."

Congressman Sean Casten, Illinois, 6th District, stated that answering the questions on the 2020 Census by spending a few minutes will go a long way in ensuring that Naperville remains a leading community with great facilities for education, health, entrepreneurship, etc. "Make sure everybody gets counted because everybody counts", he added.

Senator Laura Ellman, Illinois Senate 21st District, noted, with a sense of pride, that Naperville, with the highest percentage of participation in the Census, should be a role model for other cities from across the US. She called upon the local groups to serve as messengers and enhance the participation of people in the Census.

Kashif Fakruddin, President, ICN, Naperville said that his organization would collaborate with other institutions in order to ensure that people from all walks of life participate in the Census, in huge numbers. "A broad-based and coordinated effort will raise the bar much higher and make Naperville the Number One City in terms of the highest participation of people in Census", he added.

Bill Liu, Chairman of Chinese Community Outreach, Naperville, said that as leader of the Xilin Association Naperville, he would use the Chinese School, Adult Day Care, and Meal Delivery Program in order to deliver the message about the importance of Census and participation of his community in it, in a big way.

Vasavi Chakka, Board Member, Indian Community Outreach noted that Indian Americans comprise a significant portion of Naperville's population and her organization is proactively supporting the Census outreach efforts.

Marilyn A Sanders, Chicago Regional Director, US Census Bureau said that her agency will continue to hire and train workers to start door-to-door counts in Mid August.

Special thanks were extended to Ashfaq Syed for coordinating the Panel Discussion, developing the 2020 Census Naperville Complete Count Committee Facebook page and for taking an active role in its many activities.

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Burundian president may be first world leader to die of Covid-19, opposition sources say

Pierre Nkurunziza, Burundi's strongman president, may have become the world's first leader to die of Covid-19, according to opposition sources.

The Burundian government, which insisted for months that its country had been spared from the coronavirus pandemic because of its faith in God, announced that Mr Nkurunziza had died of a heart attack. He was 55.

The government announced "with great sadness the unexpected death of His Excellency Pierre Nkurunziza, President of the Republic of Burundi, at the Karusi Fiftieth Anniversary Hospital following a cardiac arrest on June 8, 2020," the government said on its official Twitter account on Tuesday.

However, opposition sources and journalists living in exile claimed that Mr Nkurunziza had been undergoing treatment for Covid-19 at a hospital in Karuzi in the centre of the country after he fell ill over the weekend.

His widow Denise had been admitted to a private hospital in the Kenyan capital Nairobi late last month after suffering similar symptoms, according to Kenyan officials.

She was flown into Nairobi by Kenyan flying doctors on an air ambulance equipped with a portable isolation chamber.

An opposition source said that one of the country's few ventilators had been flown by helicopter to Karuzi in a desperate bid to save the president's life.

"It arrived too late," he said. "He deteriorated very quickly."

An entire block of the hospital was reportedly evacuated, and the late president was placed under the personal care of Burundi's health minister, Thadée Ndikumana.

The source said Mr Nkurunziza died on Monday afternoon, although his death - as is often the case with sitting presidents in Africa - was kept quiet for more than 24 hours.

Burundi officially only has 83 confirmed cases of Covid-19 and one death. The low infection rate, although always quietly questioned by Burundi's cowed opposition, was hailed as an example of divine favour.

"Burundi is an exception because it is a country that has put God first," Mr Nkurunziza's spokesman said in late March.



Mr Nkurunziza had ruled the central African state since 2005. His government attracted international and domestic criticism for pressing ahead with an election last month, amid concerns that it could cause the virus to spread.

The government ignored criticism from the World Health Organisation staff and expelled its top official in the country as well as his coronavirus team.

Mr Nkurunziza was due to step down

from power in August but retain the title of "Supreme Guide of Patriotism," a position which would see him retain significant influence over defence and national security issues.

Evariste Ndayishimiye, the ruling party's candidate in last month's election, won 68% of the vote and was set to take over from Mr Nkurunziza.

Iranian judge accused of corruption found dead in Romanian hotel

BUCHAREST (Reuters) - An Iranian cleric and judge accused of corruption in Tehran and also of human rights violations by activists was found dead on Friday at a hotel in Romania's capital Bucharest, police said.

Gholamreza Mansouri, who fled Iran last year, is among several judges accused of graft during a high-profile trial of a former senior judiciary official that began in Tehran on June 7.

Romanian police detained Mansouri earlier this month and a Bucharest court had been expected to rule next month on whether to extradite him.

Bucharest police said a hotel had found one of its guests dead in the lobby after he appeared to have fallen from a higher floor.

"It was established that the man was a 52-year-old foreign citizen under judicial control for crimes committed in another country," the police said in a statement, adding that an investigation into his death was underway.

Iran's Foreign Ministry confirmed Mansouri's death and said it was awaiting a report from Romania. Ministry spokesman Abbas Mousavi told Iranian media Mansouri had gone to the Iranian embassy to discuss a potential return and was arrested by Romanian police because he was wanted in Tehran.

Mansouri had been placed under a 30-day judicial control period and was being kept under surveillance. A July 10 deadline had been set for Tehran to file extradition documents.

Last week the Paris-based media freedom watchdog Reporters Without Borders (RSF) filed a complaint against Mansouri in Germany, where he was believed to have resided before travelling to Romania, accusing him of being responsible for the "arrest and torture" of at least 20 journalists in 2013.

A fugitive Iranian judge wanted by Iran on corruption charges and by rights groups for jailing and torturing journalists was found dead of apparent suicide Friday at a hotel in Romania where he had been staying, according to Iranian officials.

The judge, Gholamreza Mansouri, was a co-defendant in a major financial corruption trial involving several senior judges accused of embezzlement and bribery. Mr. Mansouri fled Iran, with Iranian prosecutors saying he absconded with a half-million euros he had obtained

through bribery.

Iran's chief of international policing, Hadi Shirzad, said on Friday that according to information Iran had received from Interpol in Bucharest, Mr. Mansouri had jumped out of a hotel window to his death.

"We have asked Romanian authorities to give us an official statement explaining the exact reasons this incident had happened," said Iran's Foreign Ministry spokesman, Seyed Abbas Mousavi.

Democrats Have Plan to Limit Trump's Ability to Use Insurrection Act

Democrats have proposed a bill to limit the President's ability to deploy U.S. military forces at home under the Insurrection Act to a two week period.

Sen. Richard Blumenthal (D-Conn.) and several Democrats in the House of Representatives had promised to curb the President's powers after President Donald Trump threatened to deploy the U.S. military in response to nationwide protests.

Trump and Sen. Tom Cotton (R-Ark.) had said that military force may be necessary to stop rioting during protests against the police killing of African-American citizen George Floyd. The possibility of the military clashing with American protesters alarmed Democrats as well as top military leaders.

U.S. military forces—except for the National Guard—are currently banned from domestic law enforcement unless the President invokes the Insurrection Act.

Democrats are now proposing a bill that would force the President to consult with Congress when deploying military force against domestic unrest under the Insurrection Act. Congress would have two weeks to extend the President's authority, or else it would automatically expire.

The bill would also allow Americans to

take the military to court over its action during civil unrest.

"President Trump's threats to 'dominate' protestors with military might are a clear and present danger to our most fundamental constitutional rights," Blumenthal said in a statement. "If the President uses military force against Americans at home, Congress should demand at least the same checks that apply to his use of force against adversaries abroad."

Rep Ilhan Omar (D-Minn) added in her own statement that "this President has repeatedly compromised our democracy by threatening an escalation of violence on protestors across the country."

Blumenthal and Omar both referred to the Insurrection Act's legacy in putting down slave rebellions.

Several high-profile members of the Democratic Party's progressive wing joined the legislative effort.

Freshman representatives Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (D-N.Y.) and Rashida Tlaib (D-Mich.) cosponsored the bill. Ocasio-Cortez, Tlaib, and Omar have all been identified as members of "The Squad," a group of freshman progressive firebrands.

Rep. Pramila Jayapal (D-Wash.), who has



been floated as a progressive candidate for House leadership, also signed on.

But the bill also had support outside the progressive wing, including from Blumenthal himself and Kennedy heir Rep. Joe Kennedy III (D-Mass.).

Republicans have not supported a bill to restrict the President's power, but have pushed back against using the Insurrection Act.

"I think that these tasks ought to be relegated as much as possible to the state

and local authorities, the law enforcement and police," Senate Majority Whip John Thune (R-S.D.) told reporters last week. "I know there are instances in the past where they've had to call up active-duty personnel, but I think the goal always is to de-escalate, not escalate."

"I think the Defense Department by and large ought to stay out of the political fray," he added.

Fox News poll sees Trump's popularity drop to new low as Biden increases lead

Donald Trump's popularity has dropped to another low, as Fox News' latest poll shows 12 percentage points between the US president and Democratic candidate Joe Biden.

The poll, which was carried out between 13-16 June and published on Thursday, shows Trump trailing Mr Biden by the widest margin to date.

Some 50 per cent would support Mr Biden at November's presidential election, compared to 38 per cent who said Mr Trump would have their vote.

The poll indicates some movement amongst voters, who last month backed Mr Biden with 48 per cent and Mr Trump with 40 per cent.

American voters have now seen weeks-long protests against institutionalised racism and police violence, in which Mr Trump threatened to "dominate the streets" to stop demonstrations.

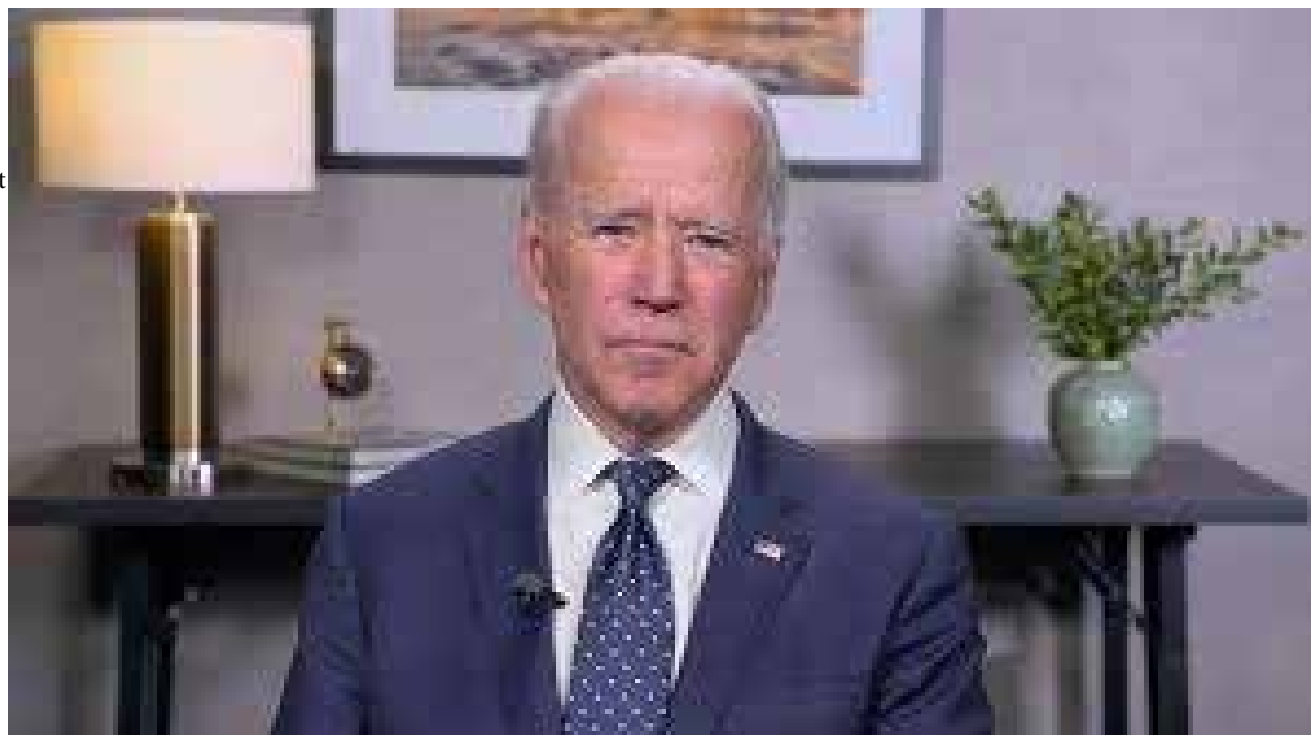
An increase in Covid-19 infections across 21 states where leaders have ceded to White House demands to ease pandemic measures have also caused alarm among some voters.

Those polled named coronavirus, racism, and unemployment as the three key

threats facing the country, with 64 per cent, 67 per cent and 67 per cent respectively listing them as the "major" danger.

On race relations, some 61 per cent disapproved of Mr Trump's actions, whilst 32 per cent approved. In comparison, 56 per cent and 37 per cent gave the same responses last month.

Whilst less than 20 per cent said they or someone from their household had protested against the death of George Floyd, who died after a white police officer knelt on his neck for nearly nine minutes, some 57 per cent backed the protests, compared to 35 per cent who disapproved.



Biden, however, does create an opening for Trump to define him as out of touch and not up to the task."

The latest poll comes after Mr Trump demanded that CNN apologise for publishing a poll last week which showed him losing to Mr Biden by 14 percentage points.

The poll also showed that almost two thirds of Democratic voters were backing Mr Biden because they feared Mr Trump would be re-elected in November, with 31 per cent identifying their enthusiasm for Mr Biden as the main factor.

Azim Premji

24 July 1945 (age 74)

Azim Hashim Premji (born 24 July 1945) is an Indian business tycoon, investor, engineer, and philanthropist, who is the chairman of Wipro Limited. He is informally known as the Czar of the Indian IT Industry. He was responsible for guiding Wipro through four decades of diversification and growth to finally emerge as one of the global leaders in the software industry. In 2010, he was voted among the 20 most powerful men in the world by Asiaweek. He has twice been listed among the 100 most influential people by TIME Magazine, once in 2004 and more recently in 2011. For years, he has been regularly listed one among the 500 Most Influential Muslims of the world.

He is currently the tenth richest person in India with an estimated net worth of US\$7.2 billion as of October 2019. In 2013, he agreed to give away at least half of his wealth by signing The Giving Pledge. Premji started with a \$2.2 billion donation to the Azim Premji Foundation, focused on education in India.

Early life and education

Premji was born in Bombay, India in a Muslim family. His father was a noted businessman and was known as Rice King of Burma. Muhammad Ali Jinnah, founder of Pakistan, invited his father Muhammed Hashem Premji to come to Pakistan, he turned down the request and chose to remain in India.

Premji has a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering degree from Stanford University. He is married to Yasmeen. The couple have two children, Rishad and Tariq. Rishad is currently the Chief Strategy Officer of IT Business, Wipro.

Career

In 1945, Muhammed Hashim Premji incorporated Western Indian Vegetable Products Ltd, based at Amalner, a small town in the Jalgaon district of Maharashtra. It used to manufacture cooking oil under the brand name Sunflower Vanaspati, and a laundry soap called 787, a byproduct of oil manufacture. In 1966, on the news of his father's death, the then 21-year-old Azim Premji returned home from Stanford University, where he was studying engineering, to take charge of Wipro. The company, which was called Western Indian Vegetable Products at the time, dealt in hydrogenated oil manufacturing but Azim Premji later diversified the company to bakery fats, ethnic ingredient based toiletries, hair care soaps, baby toiletries, lighting products, and hydraulic cylinders.



In the 1980s, the young entrepreneur, recognising the importance of the emerging IT field, took advantage of the vacuum left behind by the expulsion of IBM from India, changed the company name to Wipro and entered the high-technology sector by manufacturing minicomputers under technological collaboration with an American company Sentinel Computer Corporation. Thereafter Premji made a focused shift from soaps to software.

Recognition

Premji has been recognised by Business Week as one of the Greatest Entrepreneurs for being responsible for Wipro emerging as one of the world's fastest growing companies.

In 2000, he was conferred an honorary doctorate by the Manipal Academy of Higher Education. In 2006, Azim Premji was awarded Lakshya Business Visionary by National Institute of Industrial Engineering, Mumbai. In 2009, he was awarded an honorary doctorate from Wesleyan University in Middletown, Connecticut for his outstanding philanthropic work. In 2015, Mysore University conferred an honorary doctorate on him.

In 2005, the Government of India honoured him with the title of Padma Bhushan for his outstanding work in trade and commerce.

In 2011, he has been awarded Padma Vibhushan, the second highest civilian

award by the Government of India. In April 2017, India Today magazine ranked him 9th in India's 50 Most powerful people of 2017 list. In 2018, Premji was conferred with Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur (Knight of the Legion of Honour) – the highest French civilian distinction by the French Government.

In December 2019, Premji was cited by Forbes magazine as one of the 'Heroes of Philanthropy list of 30 altruists' in the Asia-Pacific region.

Philanthropy

Azim Premji Foundation
In 2001, he founded Azim Premji Foundation, a non-profit organization

In December 2010, he pledged to donate US\$2 billion for improving school education in India. This has been done by transferring 213 million equity shares of Wipro Ltd, held by a few entities controlled by him, to the Azim Premji Trust. This donation is the largest of its kind in India. In March 2019, Premji pledged an additional 34% of Wipro stock held by him to the foundation. At a current value of about US\$7.5 billion, this allocation will bring the total endowment from him to the foundation to US\$21 billion. In May 2020, the Azim Premji Foundation collaborated with the National Centre for Biological Sciences, and the Institute for Stem Cell Science and Regenerative Medicine for augmenting

testing infrastructure to deal with the coronavirus pandemic. The foundation has warned against scam emails which claim to be from the foundation and falsely request donations.

The Giving Pledge

Premji has said that being rich "did not thrill" him. He became the first Indian to sign up for The Giving Pledge, a campaign led by Warren Buffett and Bill Gates, to encourage the wealthiest people to make a commitment to give most of their wealth to philanthropic causes. He is the third non-American after Richard Branson and David Sainsbury to join this philanthropy club. "I strongly believe that those of us, who are privileged to have wealth, should contribute significantly to try and create a better world for the millions who are far less privileged" --- Azim Premji (AP)

In April 2013 he said that he has already given more than 25 per cent of his personal wealth to charity. In July 2015, he gave away an additional 18% of his stake in Wipro, taking his total contribution so far to 39%.

The first Indian to sign the Giving Pledge, his lifetime giving now stands at US\$21 billion. In April 2019, Azim Premji became the main Indian philanthropist.

Democratic Presidential nominee Joe Biden demands the 'restoration of people's rights' in Kashmir; expresses his disapproval for CAA-NRC

Joe Biden, the 77-year-old former vice president of the United States and now the presumptive Democratic nominee for the forthcoming US Presidential elections, has kicked up a controversy by expressing his unsolicited views on Jammu and Kashmir, Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and the National Register of Citizens (NRC) in India.

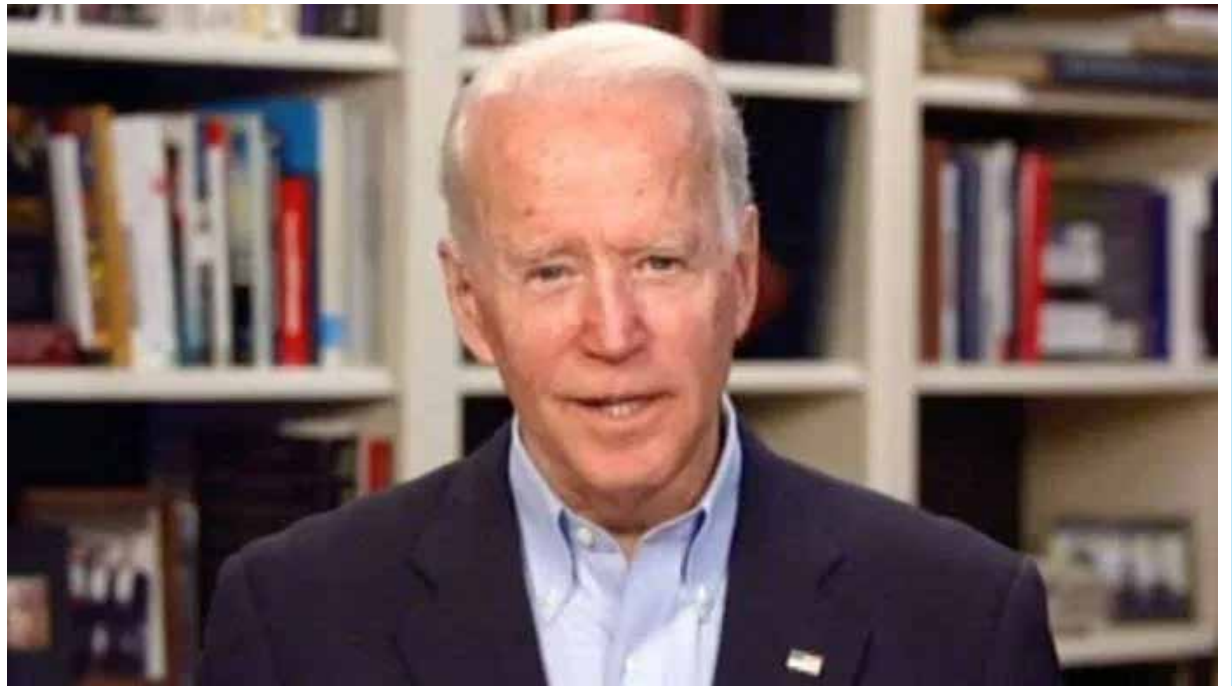
Democrat Biden who is challenging the 74-year-old Republican incumbent president Donald Trump in the November 3 presidential elections, wants India to take necessary steps to 'restore rights of all Kashmiris and has expressed disappointment over the Citizenship (Amendment) Act as well as the implementation of the National Register of Citizens in Assam.

A policy paper—'Joe Biden's agenda for Muslim American community' was posted recently on his campaign website, which said that the measures (the CAA and the National Register of Citizens) are irreconcilable with the country's long tradition of secularism and with sustaining a multi-ethnic and multi-religious democracy.

A group of Hindu Americans contacted Biden campaign to express their displeasure over the language used for India and urged it to reassess its views on India. The group has also sought a similar policy paper on Hindu Americans.

However, the Biden campaign did not respond questions in this regard.

In order to project that Biden comprehends the pains endured by Muslim-American with respect to what is happening in Muslim-majority nations and countries with sizeable Muslim populace, the policy paper categorised Kashmir and Assam in India with the forced detention of over a million Uyghur Muslims in China's Xinjiang province, and discrimination and brutalities faced by Burma's Rohingya Muslim minority.



"The Indian government should take all necessary steps to restore rights of all the people of Kashmir. Restrictions on dissent, such as preventing peaceful protests or shutting or slowing down the Internet, weakens democracy," said the policy paper on Muslim Americans.

The policy paper further added that the presumptive Democratic nominee, Joe Biden is disappointed by the measures that the government of India has taken with the implementation and aftermath of the National Register of Citizens in Assam and the enactment of the Citizenship Amendment Act.

In a bid to lure Indian-American voters, the policy paper hailed Joe Biden as one of the best friends of India and Indian-Americans, claiming the former vice-president, who served under President Barack Obama for eight years, played an instrumental role in the passage of the historic India-US civilian nuclear deal and strongly advocated increasing the bilateral trade between the two

countries to \$500 billion per annum. Well-acquainted with the Indian-Americans, Biden regularly hosted Diwali at his vice-presidential residence, it said.

However, Rishi Bhutada, a board member of Hindu American Political Action Committee, said that the Biden campaign is missing the much-needed context about "Pakistan-sponsored cross border terrorism in regards to Kashmir". Defending the CAA, Bhutada added that the former vice president's election campaign is also missing how the new citizenship amendment act is a good-faith effort by the government to alleviate the pains of approximately 30,000 persecuted religious minorities from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who continue to live in India and are deprived of their basic human rights because of lack of citizenship.

Pakistan to ground 150 pilots for cheating to get licenses

Pakistan's state-run airline said Thursday it will ground 150 pilots, accusing them of obtaining licenses by having others take exams for them, an accusation that followed a probe into last month's crash that killed 97 people in Karachi.

Abdullah Hafeez, a spokesman for Pakistan International Airlines, did not give additional details about the alleged cheating but said a process to fire the pilots had been initiated.

"We will make it sure that such unqualified pilots never fly aircraft again," he told The Associated Press. He said the safety of passengers was the airline's top priority.

Alarmed over the situation, the International Air Transport Association said it was following reports from Pakistan "regarding fake pilot licenses, which are concerning and represent a serious lapse in the licensing and safety oversight by the aviation regulator."

The global airline organization said it was seeking more information.

The move by PIA to ground the pilots comes a day after the country's aviation minister, Ghulam Sarqar Khan, said 262 out of 860 Pakistani pilots had "fake" licenses. He made the revelation while presenting preliminary

findings of a probe to parliament into the May 22 Airbus A320 crash.

The announcement stunned lawmakers present in the National Assembly and shocked family members of passengers who died last month when Flight PK8303 went down after departing from the eastern city of Lahore, crashing in a congested residential area in Karachi. The crash killed 97 people, including all the crew members. There were only two survivors on board and a girl died on the ground.

Neither Khan nor Hafeez released additional details about the alleged methods used by the pilots to wrongfully obtain licenses to fly commercial planes. Khan said only that they did not take examinations themselves to get the required certificates, which are issued by the civil aviation authority. But officials familiar with the process involved in issuing pilot's licenses said an unspecified number of people who had the skills to fly a plane but lacked technical knowledge had in the past bribed qualified persons to take exams for them. They didn't elaborate.

The officials, who spoke on condition of anonymity because they were not authorized to discuss the matter, said Pakistan International Airlines learned about the scandal two years ago and fired at least four pilots at the time on accusations of falsifying exams to obtain a

license from the civil aviation authority.

Hafeez said notices were being issued to all those pilots who he believed had tainted licenses.

Shortly after the May 22 crash, Pakistan announced it would investigate the incident and share its findings.

In presenting preliminary findings of the probe to parliament Wednesday, Khan said the pilot, before making his first failed landing attempt, did not pay attention to warnings from the air control tower when he was told the plane was too high to land. However, he said the pilot and co-pilot were medically fit and qualified to fly.

The crash took place when the plane attempted to land a second time. At that point, air traffic control told the pilot three times that the plane was too low to land but he refused to listen, saying he would manage, Khan said. The minister added that, for its part, air traffic control did not inform the pilots about damage caused to the engines after the plane's first failed landing attempt.

"The engines of the plane were damaged when they scraped the runway but the air traffic control did not inform the pilot," he said.

Sanjay Dutt

Sanjay Balraj Dutt is an Indian

actor, author and film producer who works in Hindi films. He is the recipient of several awards, including two Filmfare Awards and three Screen Awards. Dutt acted in 187 films, ranging from romance to comedy genres, but is usually typecast in action genres, and established himself as one of the most popular Hindi film actors of the later 1990s, 2000s & 2010s.

The son of actors Sunil Dutt and Nargis, Dutt made his acting debut in *Rocky* (1981), which was directed by his father. The crime thriller *Naam* (1985) proved to be a turning point in his career, which was followed by a series of commercially successful films in that decade, including *Jeete Hain Shaan Se* (1988), *Mardon Wali Baat* (1988), *Ilaaka* (1989), *Hum Bhi Insaan Hain* (1989) and *Kanoon Apna Apna* (1989). He earned nominations for the Filmfare Award for Best Actor for *Saajan* (1991) and *Khalnayak* (1993). Dutt earned his first Best Actor at the ceremony for playing a common man-turned-gangster in *Vaastav: The Reality* (1999). Along with *Vaastav: The Reality*, he also won accolades for playing an army officer in *Mission Kashmir* (2001), a soft-hearted goofy gangster in *Munna Bhai M.B.B.S.* (2003) and its sequel *Lage Raho Munna Bhai* (2006).

Dutt was arrested under the TADA and the Arms Act in April 1993 and was convicted for violation of Arms Act for possession of illegal weapons procured from other accused in the 1993 Bombay bombings. After serving his sentence, he was released in 2016. Dutt's life receives considerable media coverage in India, and in 2018, *Sanju*, a biopic based on his life (which also saw a special appearance by him), was released to positive reviews and emerged as one of the highest-grossers of Indian cinema.

Early life

Sanjay Balraj Dutt was born in a Punjabi family at Mumbai. His parents were noted cinema actors Sunil Dutt (born Balraj Dutt) and Nargis (born Fatima Rashid). He has two sisters, Priya Dutt and Namrata Dutt. His mother died in 1981, shortly before his debut film's premiere; her death is cited as the instigator of his drug abuse.[9] As a child actor, Dutt appeared briefly as a qawali singer in the 1972 film *Reshma Aur Shera*, which starred his father.

Career

1981–1997

Dutt made his Bollywood movie debut with the box-office super hit *Rocky* in 1981. Dutt then went on to star in *Vidhaata*, the highest-grossing Hindi film of 1982, along with film veterans Dilip Kumar, Shammi Kapoor and Sanjeev Kumar. He also starred in movies like *Main Awaraz Hoon* (1983). In 1985 he shot *Jaani Ki Baazi*, his first film in two years. The 1986 film *Naam* was a turning point in Dutt's career, it was a major commercial and critical success. Dutt appeared in successful films throughout the '80s such as *Imaan-daar*, *Inaam Dus Hazaar*, *Jeete Hain Shaan Se* (1988), *Mardon Wali Baat* (1988), *Ilaaka* (1989), *Hum Bhi Insaan Hain* (1989), *Kanoon Apna Apna* (1989) and *Taaqatwar*. His performances in both *Kabzaa* (1988) and *J. P. Dutta's 1989 Hathyar* were both well received by critics although both films only managed average collections at the box office. In the late 1980s he was seen in a number of multi-starrers alongside leading actors like Govinda, Mithun, Dharmendra, Jackie Shroff and Sunny Deol.

His successes continued in the 1990s, with films that include *Tejaa*, *Khatarnaak*, *Zahree-*



lay, *Thanedar*, *Khoon Ka Karz*, *Yalgaar*, *Gumrah*, *Sahibaan* and *Aatish: Feel the Fire*. He went on to star in some of the most era-defining Indian films of the early 1990s such as *Sadak*, *Saajan* (for which he was nominated for the Filmfare Best Actor Award) and *Khalnayak*, for which he earned his second Filmfare Best Actor Award nomination. The Hindu wrote that "Sanjay's earlier films (like *Naam* and *Sadak*) got him a lot of favourable attention." and "Saajan established Sanjay Dutt as the conventional soft hero." *Saajan* was the highest-grossing Bollywood film of 1991, and *Sadak* was the sixth highest grosser of 1991. *Khalnayak* was a box office success. The movie was the second-highest grosser of 1993. This was followed by another box office success *Gumrah*, this was Dutt's second consecutive hit of the year 1997–present

Dutt's first film after his 1993 arrest was *Daud* (1997). It did not do well at the box office. He followed this with the 1998 *Dushman* which did well at the box office. 1999 was an excellent year for Dutt and one that is regarded as his comeback, with all of his five releases being amongst the highest-grossing films of that year. He began it by starring in the Mahesh Bhatt-directed hit *Kartoons*, followed by *Khoobsurat*, *Haseena Maan Jaayegi*, *Daag: The Fire* and *Vaastav: The Reality*, for which he won many awards, including his first Filmfare Best Actor Award. His role in 2000's *Mission Kashmir* won him critical acclaim and a number of awards and nominations. Dutt was also invited by the President of India to *Rashtrapati Bhavan* for his performance in the movie. As the decade went on, he continued to play lead roles in popular and critical successes such as *Jodi No.1* (2001), *Pitaah* (2002), *Kaante* (2002) and the National Award-winning film *Munna Bhai M.B.B.S.* (2003), which garnered him several awards. At the box office *Munna Bhai M.B.B.S.* achieved a silver jubilee status (25-week run) being one of only eight films to have achieved this status since the year 2000. In its 26th week of release, the film could still be found playing on 257 screens throughout India. Later successes came with *Musafir* (2004), *Plan* (2004), *Parineeta* (2005) and *Dus* (2005). He won critical acclaim for his performances in *Shabd* (2005) and *Zinda*. The sequel of *Munna Bhai M.B.B.S.*, *Lage Raho Munna Bhai* was released in late 2006. Dutt received a number of awards for his performance in the film, along with an award from the Prime Minister Manmohan Singh for his work in the *Munna Bhai* series. NDTV In-

dia counted the character *Munna Bhai* as one of top 20 fictional characters in Bollywood. Later Dutt starred in movies like *Dhamaal* (2007), *Shootout at Lokhandwala* (2007), *All the Best* (2009), *Double Dhamaal* (2011), *Son of Sardaar* (2012), *Agneepath* (2012) and *PK*. In January 2008, the Indian film Institute Filmfare listed 12 films featuring Dutt in its list of top 100 highest-grossing movies of all time. In its May 2013 edition "100 years of Indian cinema" Filmfare listed three films featuring Dutt in its top 20 list of highest-grossing Hindi films of all time, adjusted for inflation these films were *Lage Raho Munna Bhai*, *Khalnayak* and *Saajan*.

Vidhu Vinod Chopra on 29 September 2016 announced that the third part of *Munna Bhai* series, starring Dutt in the title role, would begin soon. In 2017, Dutt appeared as the lead in *Bhoomi*, directed by Omung Kumar. In 2018, he starred in *Saheb, Biwi Aur Gangster In 2018*, it was also announced that Dutt would feature alongside Ranbir Kapoor and Vaani Kapoor in *Shamshera*, which will release on 31 July 2020. On 29 June 2018, his biopic *Sanju* released in which he made a special appearance. Dutt and Alia Bhatt are currently shooting for *Sadak*. In 2019, he joined the cast of historical film *Bhuj: The Pride of India*, which will feature an ensemble cast consisting of Ajay Devgn, Sonakshi Sinha and Parineeti Chopra. He will soon be seen in the film *Prasanthanam* on 20 September 2019.

Off-screen work

Dutt co-hosted the fifth season of the Indian reality show *Bigg Boss* along with Salman Khan. The show aired on Colors television from 2 October 2011 to 7 January 2012. Dutt later said it was Khan who persuaded him to co-host the show. Dutt and entrepreneur Indian Premier League cricket team owner Raj Kundra together launched India's first professionally organised mixed martial arts league—the *Super Fight League*—on 16 January 2012. Personal life and media image In the early 1980s, Dutt had a relationship with his co-star from his first film, Tina Munim. After this relationship ended, Dutt married actress Richa Sharma in 1987. She died of a brain tumour in 1996. The couple have a daughter, Trishala, born in 1988, who lives in the United States with her maternal grandparents. Dutt's second marriage was to air-hostess-turned-model Rhea Pillai in February 1998. The divorce finalised in 2008. Dutt married Manyata (born Dilnawaz Sheikh) first registered in Goa in 2008 and then, in a Hindu ceremony in Mumbai, after two years of dat-

ing. On 21 October 2010, he became a father to twins, a boy and a girl. He is a devout Shaiva Hindu who has read holy scriptures and theological works. Bombay (now Mumbai) suffered a series of serial bombings in 1993. Dutt was among several people associated with Bollywood who were accused of involvement. It was alleged that Dutt accepted a delivery of weapons at his house from Abu Salem and co-accused Riyaz Siddiqui, who had also been implicated in relation to the Mumbai blasts. It was claimed that the weapons formed a part of a large consignment of arms connected to the terrorists. Dutt, however, in his confession stated that he took only one Type-56 from the producers of his movie *Sanam*, for his own family protection. It has also been reported that Sanjay Dutt's father Sunil Dutt's political rivalry caused Sanjay Dutt's conviction. In April 1993, he was arrested under the provisions of the Terrorist and Disruptive Activities (Prevention) Act (TADA). Dutt was granted bail by the Supreme Court of India on 5 May 1993; however, on 4 July 1994 his bail was cancelled and he was re-arrested. On 16 October 1995 he was granted bail. Abdul Qayyum Abdul Karim Shaikh, who was thought to be a close aide of the terrorists' ringleader, Dawood Ibrahim, was arrested. Dutt had given Qayyum's name to the police when confessing to arms possession, saying that in September 1992 he had bought a pistol from Qayyum in Dubai. His arrest coincided with the release of his film, *Khalnayak*, in which he played a wanted criminal. The film's major success was in part due to Dutt's off-screen legal controversy. On 31 July 2007, Dutt was cleared of the charges relating to the Mumbai blast; however, the TADA court sentenced Dutt to six years' rigorous imprisonment under Arms act for illegal possession of weapons. According to *The Guardian*, "The actor claimed he feared for his life after the notorious 'Black Friday' bombings, which were allegedly staged by Mumbai's Muslim-dominated mafia in retaliation for deadly Hindu-Muslim clashes a few months earlier. But the judge rejected this defence and also refused bail." Dutt was returned to jail at Arthur Road and soon after moved to the Yerawada Central Jail in Pune. Dutt appealed against the sentence and was granted interim bail on 20 August 2007 until such time as the TADA court provided him with a copy of its judgement. On 22 October 2007 Dutt was back in jail but again applied for bail. On 27 November 2007, Dutt was granted bail by the Supreme Court. On 21 March 2013 the Supreme Court upheld the verdict but shortened the sentence to five years' imprisonment. Dutt was given a month to surrender before the authorities.

On 10 May, the Supreme Court rejected Dutt's review petition for the reconsideration of his conviction and asked him to surrender on the stipulated date. On 14 May, Dutt withdrew the mercy plea and surrendered to the Mumbai Police on 16 May 2013. Just before the surrender, the Mumbai jail authority got an anonymous letter threatening Dutt's life. Dutt filed an appeal to allow him to surrender before entering Yerwada Central Jail. Later, Dutt withdrew this request too. He was paroled from 21 December 2013. The parole was extended three times until March 2014, raising concern in Bombay High Court and a proposal from the Government of Maharashtra to amend the law of parole. He returned to Yerwada Central Jail after his parole ended. Dutt was out on a two weeks' furlough granted by the Yerwada Central Jail authorities on 24 December. He was subsequently incarcerated in Yerwada Central Jail, to complete his jail term. He was released from there on 25 February 2016 after serving his sentence.

READY TO COACH INDIAN CRICKET TEAM IF THERE IS AN OPPORTUNITY: MOHAMMAD AZHARUDDIN

Mohammad Azharuddin would not bat an eyelid and jump at it straight away if he is given the opportunity to coach the Indian cricket team in the future, the former India captain has said.

“Yes, I am ready to give it a shot. If I get an opportunity to work with the Indian team, I would jump at it without batting an eyelid,” Azharuddin told Gulf News in an interview.

Ravi Shastri is the current head coach of the Indian team and his contract runs till the T20 World Cup in 2021. Cricket is currently on hold due to the coronavirus outbreak and England is all set to host West Indies for a home Test series in July.

The three-Test series will mark the resumption of international cricket after the sport was suspended since March due to COVID-19 crisis.

Azharuddin wondered why too many ‘support staff’ travel with teams these days.

“I am amazed to see so many people accompanying the team these days. For example, my specialisation is in batting and fielding and hence if I coach any team, I don’t really need a batting coach. Isn’t it?” explained Azhar who is now the President of the Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA).

Azharuddin also said he is hopeful that

the Indian Premier League (IPL), which was also postponed due to the health crisis, will see the light of the day in a window provided later in the year. The BCCI is working on an October window if the T20 World Cup does not take place in Australia.

“I hope the league can eventually get a window where we get to host a minimum of seven matches. The league, whether one likes it or not, has given a lot to the sport in the last 10-12 years.



On his role as HCA President, Azharuddin said: “Yes, it’s quite a challenging job. There are 226 affiliated clubs and you have to run it with a completely neutral perspective. It’s much tougher than leading a side where you are handling 15 persons.”

Andhra CM launches ‘Jagananna Chedodu’ scheme for tailors, barbers and washermen

maravati (Andhra Pradesh) [India], June 10 (ANI): Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy launched the ‘Jagananna Chedodu’ scheme to provide financial assistance to tailors, barbers and washermen.

According to an official release, Rs 10,000 was provided to 2.47 lakh beneficiaries by transferring a total amount of Rs 247 crores directly into their bank accounts under the unencumbered mode, which does not allow the bankers to deduct this amount towards previous loans of the beneficiaries if any.

“We have seen how these sections have suffered during the lockdown. On August 3, when the schools reopen we are giving Vidya Deevena kit, which includes three pairs of uniform, shoes, socks, books, bags. Mukesh Ambani Becomes 11th Richest Globally After His Net Worth Scales To Rs. 4.58 lakh Cr

After the stock price of Reliance Industries made new high and has jumped 100% since the 52-week low price attained in March due to market rout, the real time wealth of the oil to telecom conglomerate’s MD and CEO Mukesh Ambani surged in real time to cross \$60 billion for the first time. And subsequently he became the 11th richest person globally.

As per the Bloomberg Billionaires Index, Mukesh Ambani’s net worth after today’s surge of close to 6% in share price of RIL has become \$60.3 billion or Rs. 4.58 lakh crore. On the NSE, the stock made a high of Rs. 1754.35 per share. Also, post the intra-day rally today, the company’s market capitalization stands at Rs. 11.50 lakh crore.

This surge in net worth has led the billionaire to rank ahead of Amancio Ortega, Zara’s (Spanish retail chain) founder and former chairman.

Also, upon the success of the com-

pany’s RIL rights issue (netted Rs. 53,124.20 crore) and back to back investment deals from global investors (RS. 1.16 lakh crore), the company raked up a massive sum, which has enabled the company to become net debt free ahead of March 2021 timeline. The company’s net debt as on March 31, 2020 stood at Rs. 1,61,035 crore.

“Today I am both delighted and humbled to announce that we have fulfilled our promise to the shareholders by making Reliance net debt-free much before our original schedule of 31st March 2021,” Ambani mentioned in a statement.

“We will induct leading global partners in these (consumer) businesses in the next few quarters, and move towards listing of both these companies within the next five years.....” Ambani said adding that “with these initiatives, I have no doubt



that your company will have one of the strongest balance sheets in the world.”

Also, in an address to its shareholders, he said that the company is in its ‘Golden Decade’ and will set even more ambitious growth goals, and achieve them.

The company plans listing its consumer businesses within the next five years.

Priyanka Chopra

Priyanka Chopra Jonas born 18 July 1982) is an Indian actress and singer. She was the winner of the Miss World 2000 pageant, and is one of India's highest-paid and most popular entertainers. Chopra has received numerous accolades, including a National Film Award and five Filmfare Awards. In 2016, the Government of India honoured her with the Padma Shri and Time named her one of the 100 most influential people in the world, and in the next two years Forbes listed her among the World's 100 Most Powerful Women.

Although Chopra initially aspired to study aeronautical engineering, she accepted offers to join the Indian film industry, which came as a result of her pageant wins, making her Bollywood debut in *The Hero: Love Story of a Spy* (2003). She played the leading lady in the box-office hits *Andaaz* (2003) and *Mujhse Shaadi Karogi* (2004) and received critical acclaim for her breakout role in the 2004 thriller *Aitraaz*. Chopra established herself with starring roles in the top-grossing productions *Krrish* and *Don* (both 2006), and she later reprised her role in their sequels. Following a brief setback, she garnered success in 2008 for playing a troubled model in the drama *Fashion*, which won her the National Film Award for Best Actress, and a glamorous journalist in *Dostana*. Chopra gained wider recognition for portraying a range of characters in the films *Kaminey* (2009), *7 Khoon Maaf* (2011), *Barfi!* (2012), *Mary Kom* (2014), and *Bajirao Mastani* (2015). From 2015 to 2018, she starred as Alex Parrish in the ABC thriller series *Quantico*. Chopra has since played supporting roles in the Hollywood comedies *Baywatch* (2017) and *Isn't It Romantic* (2019), and returned to Hindi cinema with a leading role in the biopic *The Sky Is Pink* (2019).

Chopra also promotes social causes such as environment and women's rights, and is vocal about gender equality, the gender pay gap, and feminism. She has worked with UNICEF since 2006 and was appointed as the national and global UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador for child rights in 2010 and 2016, respectively. Her namesake foundation for health and education works towards providing support to unprivileged Indian children. As a recording artist, Chopra has released three singles and provided vocals for a number of her film songs. She is also the founder of the production company Purple Pebble Pictures, under which she has produced several regional Indian films, including the acclaimed Marathi film *Ventilator* (2016). Despite maintaining privacy, Chopra's off-screen life, including her marriage to American singer and actor Nick Jonas, is the subject of substantial media coverage. Early life

Priyanka Chopra was born on 18 July 1982 in Jamshedpur, Bihar (present-day Jharkhand), to Ashok and Madhu Chopra, both physicians in the Indian Army. Her father was a Punjabi Hindu from Ambala. Her mother Madhu Chopra from Jharkhand, is the eldest daughter of Dr. Manohar Kishan Akhouri, a former Congress veteran and Madhu Jyotsna Akhouri (née Mary John), a former member of Bihar Legislative Assembly. Her late maternal grandmother, Mrs. Akhouri was a

Jacobite Syrian Christian originally named Mary John, belonging to the Kavalappara family of Kumarakom, Kottayam district, Kerala. Chopra has a brother, Siddharth, who is seven years her junior. Bollywood actresses Parineeti Chopra, Meera Chopra and Mannara Chopra are cousins. Due to her parents' professions as military physicians, the family was posted in a number of places in India, including Delhi, Chandigarh, Ambala, Ladakh, Lucknow, Bareilly, and Pune. Among the schools she attended were La Martiniere Girls' School in Lucknow and St. Maria Goretti College in Bareilly. In an interview published in *Daily News and Analysis*, Chopra said that she did not mind travelling regularly and changing schools; she welcomed it as a new experience and a way to discover India's multicultural society. Among the many places that she lived, Chopra has fond memories as a child of playing in the valleys of Leh, in the cold northwestern Indian desert region of Ladakh. She has said, "I think I was in Class 4 when I was in Leh. My brother was just born. My dad was in the army and was posted there. I stayed in Leh for a year and my memories of that place are tremendous. We were all army kids there. We weren't living in houses, we were in bunkers in the valley and there was a stupa right on top of a hill which used to overlook our valley. We used to race up to the top of the stupa" She now considers Bareilly her home town, and maintains strong connections there. At 13, Chopra moved to the United States to study, living with her aunt, and attending schools in Newton, Massachusetts, and Cedar Rapids, Iowa, after a stop in Queens, New York, as her aunt's family also moved frequently. While in Massachusetts, she participated in several theatre productions, and studied Western classical music, and choral singing. During her teenage years in the United States, Chopra sometimes faced racial issues and was bullied for being Indian by an African-American classmate. She has said, "I was a gawky kid, had low self-esteem, came from a modest middle-class background, had white marks on my legs. But I was damn hard working. Today, my legs sell 12 brands." After three years, Chopra returned to India, finishing the senior year of her high-school education at the Army Public School in Bareilly.

During this period, she won the local May Queen beauty pageant, after which she was pursued by admirers; her family equipped their home with bars for her protection. Her mother entered her in the *Femina Miss India* contest of 2000; she finished second, winning the *Femina Miss India* World title. Chopra next won the *Miss World* pageant, where she was crowned *Miss World 2000* and *Miss World Continental Queen of Beauty—Asia & Oceania* at the Millennium Dome in London on 30 November 2000. Chopra was the fifth Indian contestant to win *Miss World*, and the fourth to do so within seven years. She



had enrolled in college, but left after winning the *Miss World* pageant. Chopra said that the *Miss India* and *Miss World* titles brought her recognition, and she began receiving offers for film roles.

Chopra has maintained a strong relationship with her family, including her younger brother, Siddharth, and lives in an apartment on the same floor as her family. She was especially close to her father, who died in June 2013; in 2012, she got a tattoo reading "Daddy's lil girl" in his handwriting. Having not come from a film background, she describes herself as a self-made woman. Her mother, a well-established gynaecologist in Bareilly, gave up her practice to support Chopra as she embarked upon a film career. A practicing Hindu, Chopra performs a puja every morning at a small shrine consisting of various murtis of Hindu deities in her home, which she even travels with. Although she is known for her media-friendly attitude, Chopra is publicly reticent about her personal life. Chopra started dating American singer and actor, Nick Jonas in May 2018. Jonas proposed to her on 19 July 2018, a day after her birthday in Crete, Greece. Chopra and Jonas got engaged in August 2018 in a Punjabi Roka ceremony in Mumbai. In December 2018, the couple married at Umaid Bhawan Palace, Jodhpur in traditional Hindu and Christian ceremonies. Following the marriage, Chopra legally changed her last name to "Chopra Jonas".

In 2015, Chopra starred in Zoya Akhtar's *Dil Dhadakne Do*, an ensemble comedy-drama alongside Anil Kapoor, Shefali Shah, Ranveer Singh, Anushka Sharma and Farhan Akhtar. The film tells the story of a dysfunctional Punjabi family (the Mehras), who invite their family and friends on a cruise trip to celebrate the parents' 30th wedding anniversary. She portrayed the role of Ayesha Mehra, a successful entrepreneur and the eldest child. Pratim D. Gupta from *The Telegraph* wrote of Chopra, "From the propah body language to the measured speech shows the kind of depth she is able to bring to her lines and characters these days. Conversely, Shubhra Gupta of *The Indian Express* commented that it was time for her "to being a little messy: all these not-a-hair-out-place roles are making her constrained." The cast of *Dil Dhadakne Do* won the *Screen Award* for Best Ensemble Cast, and Chopra was nominated for a *Screen Award*, *IIFA Award*, and *Producers Guild Film Award* for Best Actress. Chopra signed a talent holding deal with ABC Studios and was later cast in the American thriller series *Quantico* as the character

Alex Parrish. The series premiered on 27 September 2015 on ABC, making Chopra the first South Asian to headline an American network drama series. The series received positive reviews from television critics and Chopra was praised for her performance. James Poniewozik of *The New York Times* described Chopra as the "strongest human asset" of the show, and added that "she is immediately charismatic and commanding." She received the *People's Choice Award* for Favourite Actress In A New TV Series for her role in *Quantico*, becoming the first South Asian actress to win a *People's Choice Award*. The following year, Chopra won a second *People's Choice Award* for Favorite Dramatic TV Actress. *Quantico* was cancelled after three seasons in 2018.

Chopra is one of the most high-profile and popular celebrities in India and she is described as a sex symbol and a style icon. Her figure, eyes, lips and exotic looks have been cited by the media as her distinctive physical features. Designers Falguni and Shane Peacock wrote, "She is comfortable in her own skin and looks ravishing in whatever she wears, be it a bikini, short or long dress or even a sari." She was named "India's Best-Dressed Woman of the Year" by *People India* in 2011. The actress ranks high on various listings of the most attractive, beautiful, and sexiest women in the world. The UK magazine *Eastern Eye* ranked her first on their list of "World's Sexiest Asian Women", a record five times (2006, 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2017). Chopra also topped the *Maxim India's Hot 100* list on four different occasions (2011, 2013, 2016 and 2018). In 2015, *Bud-TV* listed her as the Sexiest Woman on American Television. The following year, she was ranked fourth on *AskMen's Top 99 Women*, after having featured on the list in 2012. In 2017, *Buzznet* named her World's second "Most Beautiful Women", after Beyoncé. The same year, Chopra was named one of *People* magazine's Most Beautiful Women in the World. She was again featured in the list in 2019. Chopra was featured on *Verve's* list of most powerful Indian women in 2009, 2010, 2013, 2015 and 2016. Chopra was featured in *The Indian Express's* listing of the most powerful Indians in 2016 and 2017. *India Today* featured her among India's 50 most powerful people in 2017 and 2018, ranking highest among the actresses. After her transition from Bollywood to Hollywood, Chopra began appearing in such lists in United States as well, with *People* featuring her as one of the "Most Intriguing People of the Year". The following year, *Time* magazine named her one of the 100 Most Influential People in the World. *Forbes* listed her among the World's 100 Most Powerful Women in 2017 and 2018. Chopra was twice (2017 and 2018) named one of the 500 most influential business leaders by *Variety*. The market research firm *YouGov* named her the world's twelfth and fourteenth most admired woman in 2018 and 2019, respectively. *USA Today* featured her in their 2019 listing of 50 most powerful women in entertainment.

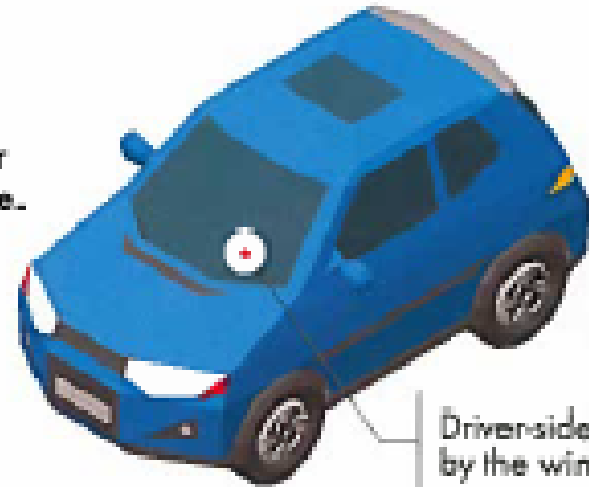

Pakistan: Renowned scholar Mufti Naeem dies at 62

Pakistan's renowned religious scholar Mufti Mohammad Naeem passed away in southern port city of Karachi on Saturday. He was 62.

Mufti Mohammad Nauman, his son, told journalists that his father, a chronic cardiac patient, suffered a heart attack, and breathed his last while on his way to hospital.

Born in 1958, Naeem was the founder, and the chancellor of the International Binoria Islamic University Karachi, which enrolls over 5,000 students, including hundreds from abroad.

Well-known for his moderate views about religion, Naeem espoused induction of modern subjects into the typical religious

education. Binoria University was one of the initial madrassahs or religious seminaries in Pakistan, which introduced computer science, English, and other modern subjects along with religious education.

Established in 1980, the seminary attracted hundreds of foreign students because of its unique curriculum -- a blend of traditional and modern education.

Currently, according to Nazeer Nasir, a spokesman for Binoria University, over 700 students from 54 different countries are enrolled with the school. Foreign diplomats are regularly invited to the university to interact with students.

Naeem was survived by his wife, three sons, two daughters.

Rahul Gandhi charges PM with 'surrendering' Indian territory to China

Gandhi has aggressively been questioning the government on Twitter on the ongoing LAC standoff.

A day after Prime Minister Narendra Modi told an all-party meeting that neither is anyone inside India's territory nor has any of its posts been captured, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi has once again attacked the Centre. This time, the former Congress president has hit back at the PM for allegedly "surrendering" Indian territory to Chinese aggression.

Tagging PM's remarks with his tweet, Gandhi said, "PM has surrendered Indian territory to Chinese aggression." "If the land was Chinese: 1. Why were our soldiers killed? 2. Where were they killed?" Gandhi said in a statement on the all-party meeting called by Modi on Friday to discuss the situation at the India-China border, the government said, "At the outset, prime minister clarified that neither is anyone inside our territory nor is any of our post captured."

The categorical statement by the prime minister came in the wake of reports that Chinese military has transgressed into the Indian side of the Line of Actual Control,

the de-facto border, in several areas of eastern Ladakh including Pangong Tso and Galwan Valley.

The prime minister's assertion came even as Congress president Sonia Gandhi, at the all-party meet, questioned the government's handling of the situation, asking if there was any intelligence failure, and seeking assurance that China will "revert" to its original position.

Gandhi has aggressively been questioning the government on Twitter on the ongoing LAC standoff, ever since 20 jawans of the Indian Army were killed by the Chinese in the Galwan Valley.

On Friday, he accused senior ministers in the government of "lying" to protect the prime minister and that the Centre was "fast asleep" while martyred jawans paid the price in Ladakh.

"It's now crystal clear that: The Chinese attack in Galwan was pre-planned. GOI was fast asleep and denied the problem. The price was paid by our martyred Jawans," he said on Twitter.

He tagged a report quoting minister of state for Defence Shripad Naik, saying the



attack was pre-planned by China and the Indian forces will give a befitting reply.

In another tweet, the Congress leader tagged a video interview of a military analyst and questioned the government over the soldiers being sent "unarmed to martyrdom" in Ladakh.

The former Congress chief also tagged a one-minute video of a jawan's father saying the Indian soldiers were unarmed when they were attacked by Chinese troops.

He also took on Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and Prime Minister Narendra Modi

for their long silence after the incident took place, and also questioned them for their delay in paying homage to the fallen soldiers.

Twenty Indian Army personnel, including a colonel, were killed in a clash with Chinese troops in the Galwan Valley in eastern Ladakh on Monday night, the biggest military confrontation in over five decades that has significantly escalated the already volatile border standoff in the region. An Internet miracle: Woman, 94, returns home forty years after disappearing

Bhopal: Thanks to the Internet, a 94-year-old woman from Maharashtra who had gone missing four decades ago has been reunited with her family.

Unfortunately, when Panchubai, the woman, reached her grandson's house in Nagpur three days ago, she could not meet her son. He had died three years ago.

Sometime in 1979-80, a truck driver spotted a woman, clueless and in a pitiable condition, walking along a road in Madhya Pradesh's Damoh district.

"She had been stung by honeybees and could not speak coherently," Israr Khan, the truck driver's son, told PTI.

Khan's father took the woman home and she began to live with his family. Israr himself was a baby then.

"We called her Achchhan Mausi. She was mentally unstable and used to mutter in Marathi which we could not understand," he said.

"I sometimes asked her about her family, but she could not tell anything," he said.

Khan also wrote about her on Face-

book, but it did not lead to anywhere.

"She used to talk about a place called 'Khanjma Nagar'. Google search of the name yielded no result. Then on May 4 this year, as we were at home amid lockdown, I again asked her about her hometown," he said.

"This time she spoke about a place called Parsapur. We googled it and found that there is one Parasapur in Maharashtra," Khan said.

On May 7, he contacted a man called Abhishek who runs a shop in Parasapur and told him about the woman.

Abhishek, who belongs to the Kirar community, told him that there is a village called Khanjma Nagar near the town.

"I sent him Mausi's video at 8:30 pm on May 7, which he shared on a WhatsApp group of the Kirar community. I received a phone call from Abhishek around midnight, saying the woman had been identified and her relatives traced," Khan said.

A video of the old woman was sent to Prithvi Bhaiyalal Shingane, Panchubai's grandson who lives in Nagpur. The



Shingane family was astounded. They were eager to bring her home, but the wait was not yet over as lockdown was in force.

Finally, on June 17, Shingane took his grandmother -- whose full name is Panchfulabai Tejpalsingh Shingane -- home.

"We are natives of Khanjma Nagar in Achalpur tehsil in Amravati district of Maharashtra, but the family shifted to Nagpur about five decades ago," he told PTI.

"In 1979, my father brought my grandmother to Nagpur for treatment of her mental ailment from Khanjma Nagar. The doctors were optimistic about

curing her. But one day she left home in the evening, telling neighbours that she was going to her father's place, and disappeared for ever," he said.

"My father searched for her for years without success. He died in 2017. It would have been so much better if I had found her three years ago," Shingane added.

"At the age of 94, my grandmother is still in good health thanks to the Khan family who looked after her for such a long time," he added. Deccan Chronicle

As you stand up tall, notice how the distance in between increases. Try to maintain this elongation as you walk.

Eyes up. If you're looking down at your feet, you're putting unnecessary stress on your upper back and neck. Bring your gaze out about 10 to 20 feet in front of you. You'll still be able to spy obstacles ahead and prevent upper-body tension.

Shoulders back, down, and relaxed. Roll your shoulders up, back, and then down. This is where your shoulders should be as you walk—not pulled up toward your ears. Think about keeping your shoulders away from your ears to reduce



upper-body tension and allow for a freer arm swing.

Swing from your shoulders. Let your arms swing freely from your shoulders, not your elbows. Swing your arms forward and back, like a pendulum. Don't bring them across your body or let them go higher than your chest.

Maintain a neutral pelvis. Keep your abs tight, but don't tuck your tailbone

under or stick your belly out and overarch your back.

Step lightly. You should be rolling from heel to toe as you stride, not landing flat-footed with a thud. And don't reach your leg far out in front of you. 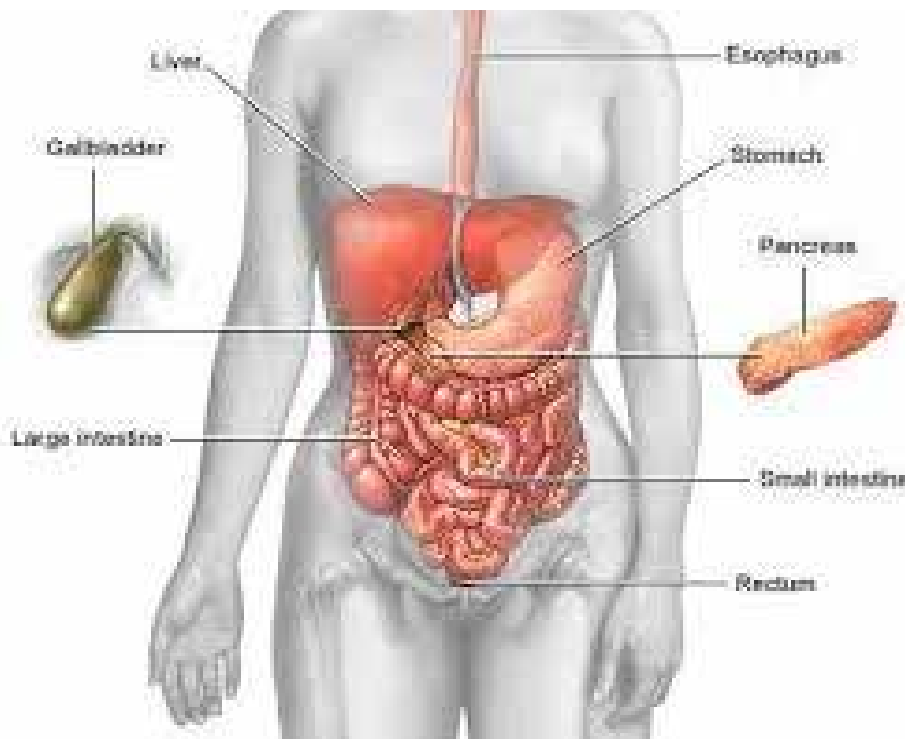

Emperor Aurangzeb(1618 - 1707)

Aurangzeb, kingly title Ālamgīr, original name Mu ī al-Dīn Mu ammad, (born November 3, 1618, Dhod, Malwa—died March 3, 1707), emperor of India from 1658 to 1707, the last of the great Mughal emperors. Under him the Mughal Empire reached its greatest extent.

Aurangzeb was the third son of the emperor Shah Jahān and Mumtaz Mahal. He grew up as a serious-minded and devout youth and free from the royal Mughal traits of sensuality and drunkenness. He showed signs of military and administrative ability early; these qualities, combined with a taste for power, brought him into rivalry with his eldest brother, Dara Shikoh, who was always favored by and designated by their father as his successor to the throne and was antagonistic to Aurangzeb from an early age. From 1636 Aurangzeb held a number of important appointments, in all of which he distinguished himself. He commanded troops against the Uzbeks and the Persians with distinction (1646–47) and, as viceroy of the Deccan province during two terms (1636–44, 1654–58), reduced the two Muslim Deccan kingdoms to near-subjection.

When Shah Jahān fell seriously ill with acute constipation in September 1657 in Delhi, the tension between Dara Shikoh and Aurangzeb made a war of succession seem inevitable. Rumours of his death spread and the scare was enough to send potential successors rushing to arms. Aurangzeb bided his time. But as governor of Bengal Prince Shuja, another brother, was quickly in the field after a hasty coronation. And in Gujrat the fourth brother, Murad Baksh, followed suit. These two, Shuja and Murad, would prove to be the outsiders. Shuja advance up the Ganga was halted by defeat near Varanasi at the hands of an imperial army under Raja Jai Singh. Meanwhile, Murad, the youngest and least effectual brother, rested his hopes on joint action with Aurangzeb. After plundering the port of Surat for funds he waited for Aurangzeb to move north from the Deccan. At this point, the front-runner was undoubtedly Dara Shikoh. As the eldest brother, Shah Jahan's favorite, his designated mouthpiece and heir, and the only Delhi-based contender with the reigns of imperial patronage and power at his disposal, he looked unbeatable. His one fault was that that, like Akbar, he inspired deep suspicion amongst orthodox Muslims and especially the ulema. He also consorted with Sufis, Hindus and Christians; he even translated the Upanishads into Persian. By the time of Shah Jahān's unexpected recovery, matters had gone too far for either son to retreat. In the struggle for power (1657–59), Aurangzeb showed tactical and strategic military skill, great powers of dissimulation, and ruthless determination. Decisively defeating Dārā at Samugarh in May 1658, he confined his father in his own palace at Agra. Dara became a fugitive, was hunted down and captured and eventually executed at Delhi. Murad was also executed later on and Shuja escaped to northern



Burma and was never heard of again.

Aurangzeb's reign falls into two almost equal parts. In the first, which lasted until about 1680, he was a capable monarch of a mixed Hindu-Muslim empire and as such was generally disliked for his ruthlessness but feared and respected for his vigor and skill. During this period he was much occupied with safeguarding the northwest from Persians and Central Asian Turks and less so with the Maratha chief Shivajii, who twice plundered the great port of Surat (1664, 1670). Aurangzeb applied his great-grandfather Akbar's recipe for conquest: defeat one's enemies, reconcile them, and place them in imperial service. Thus, Shivaji was defeated, called to Agra for reconciliation (1666), and given an imperial rank. The plan broke down, however; Shivaji fled to the Deccan and died, in 1680, as the ruler of an independent Maratha kingdom.

After about 1680, Aurangzeb's reign underwent a change of both attitude and policy. The first overt sign of change was the reimposition of the jizya, or poll tax, on non-Muslims in 1679 (a tax that had been abolished by Akbar). This in turn was followed by a Rajput revolt in 1680–81, supported by Aurangzeb's third son, Akbar. The Deccan kingdoms of Bijapur and Golconda were conquered in 1686–87, but the insecurity that followed precipitated a long-incipient economic crisis, which in turn was deepened by warfare with the Marathas. Shivaji's son Sambhaji was captured and executed in 1689 and his



kingdom broken up. The Marathas, however, then adopted guerrilla tactics, spreading all over southern India amid a sympathetic population. The rest of Aurangzeb's life was spent in laborious and fruitless sieges of forts in the Maratha hill country.

Where the emperor went, the entire imperial court and the army also went. The move to the south in 1681–82 meant that Delhi was partially vacated. Many of those who went to the south would never see Delhi again, including the emperor. Aurangzeb's absence in the south prevented him from maintaining his former firm hold on the north. The administration weakened, and the process was hastened by pressure on the

land by Mughal grantees who were paid by assignments on the land revenue.

Aurangzeb maintained the empire for nearly half a century and in fact extended it in the south as far as Tanjore (now Thanjavur) and Trichinopoly (now Tiruchchirappalli). Behind this imposing facade, however, were serious weaknesses. The Maratha campaign continually drained the imperial resources. The militancy of the Sikhs and the Jats boded ill for the empire in the north. The new Islamic policy alienated Hindu sentiment and undermined Rajput support. The financial pressure on the land strained the whole administrative framework.

On March 3, 1707, the 88-year-old Aurangzeb died in central India. His tomb is in Khuldabad, Aurangabad District in Maharashtra. He left an empire stretched to the breaking point and riddled with rebellions. Under his son Bahadur Shah I, the Mughal Dynasty began its long, slow decline into oblivion, which finally ended when the British sent the last emperor into exile in 1858 and established the British Raj in India.

14th Dalai Lama

Tenzin Gyatso

The 14th Dalai Lama (religious name: Tenzin Gyatso, shortened from Jetsun Jamphel Ngawang Lobsang Yeshe Tenzin Gyatso; born Lhamo Dhondup, 6 July 1935) is the current Dalai Lama. Dalai Lamas are important monks of the Gelug school, the newest school of Tibetan Buddhism, which was formally headed by the Ganden Tripas. From the time of the 5th Dalai Lama to 1959, the central government of Tibet, the Ganden Phodrang, invested the position of Dalai Lama with temporal duties. The 14th Dalai Lama was born in Taktser, Qinghai, Tibet. He was selected as the tulku of the 13th Dalai Lama in 1937 and formally recognized as the 14th Dalai Lama in a public declaration near the town of Bumchen in 1939. On 26 January 1940, the Regent Reting Rinpoche requested the Central Government to exempt Tenzin Gyatso from the lot-drawing process of the Golden Urn to become the 14th Dalai Lama. The request was approved by the Central Government. His enthronement ceremony as the Dalai Lama was held in Lhasa on 22 February 1940 and he eventually assumed full temporal (political) duties on 17 November 1950, at the age of 15, after the People's Republic of China's occupation of Tibet. The Gelug school's government administered an area roughly corresponding to the Tibet Autonomous Region, just as the nascent PRC wished to assert control over it.

During the 1959 Tibetan uprising, the Dalai Lama fled to India, where he currently lives as a refugee. He has traveled the world and has spoken about the welfare of Tibetans, environment, economics, women's rights, nonviolence, interfaith dialogue, physics, astronomy, Buddhism and science, cognitive neuroscience, reproductive health and sexuality, along with various topics of Mahayana and Vajrayana Buddhist teachings. A recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize in 1989 and the US Congressional Gold Medal in 2006, Time magazine named him one of the "Children of Mahatma Gandhi" and Gandhi's spiritual heir to nonviolence.

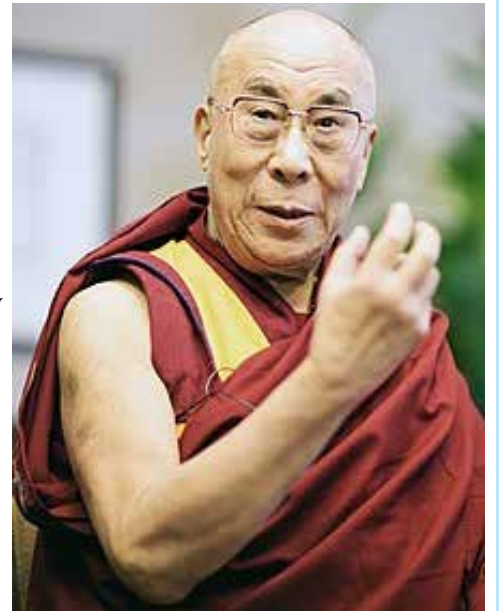
Early life and background

Lhamo Thondup was born on 6 July 1935 to a farming and horse trading family in the small hamlet of Taktser, or Chija Tagtser (Chinese: 塔克寺; pinyin: Hóngyá Cūn; lit.: 'Redcliff Village'), at the edge of the traditional Tibetan region of Amdo in Qinghai Province. His family was of Monguor extraction. He was one of seven siblings to survive childhood. The eldest was his sister Tsering Dolma, eighteen years his senior. His eldest brother, Thupten Jigme Norbu, had been recognised at the age of eight as the reincarnation of the high Lama Taktser Rinpoche. His sister, Jetsun Pema, spent most of her adult life on the Tibetan Children's Villages project. The Dalai Lama has said that his first language was "a broken Xining language which was (a dialect of) the Chinese language", a form of Central Plains Mandarin, and his family did not speak the Tibetan language. Following reported signs and visions, three search teams were sent out to the north-east, the east, and the south-east to locate the new incarnation when the boy who was to become the 14th Dalai Lama

was about two years old. Sir Basil Gould, British delegate to Lhasa in 1936, related his account of the north-eastern team to Sir Charles Alfred Bell, former British resident in Lhasa and friend of the 13th Dalai Lama. Amongst other omens, the head of the embalmed body of the thirteenth Dalai Lama, at first facing south-east, had turned to face the north-east, indicating, it was interpreted, the direction in which his successor would be found. The Regent, Reting Rinpoche, shortly afterwards had a vision at the sacred lake of Lhamo La-tso which he interpreted as Amdo being the region to search. This vision was also interpreted to refer to a large monastery with a gilded roof and turquoise tiles, and a twisting path from it to a hill to the east, opposite which stood a small house with distinctive eaves. The team, led by Kewtsang Rinpoche, went first to meet the Panchen Lama, who had been stuck in Jyekundo, in northern Kham. The Panchen Lama had been investigating births of unusual children in the area ever since the death of the 13th Dalai Lama. He gave Kewtsang the names of three boys whom he had discovered and identified as candidates. Within a year the Panchen Lama had died. Two of his three candidates were crossed off the list but the third, a "fearless" child, the most promising, was from Taktser village, which, as in the vision, was on a hill, at the end of a trail leading to Taktser from the great Kumbum Monastery with its gilded, turquoise roof. There they found a house, as interpreted from the vision—the house where Lhamo Dhondup lived.

The 14th Dalai Lama claims that at the time, the village of Taktser stood right on the "real border" between the region of Amdo and China. When the team visited, posing as pilgrims, its leader, a Sera Lama, pretended to be the servant and sat separately in the kitchen. He held an old mala that had belonged to the 13th Dalai Lama, and the boy Lhamo Dhondup, aged two, approached and asked for it. The monk said "if you know who I am, you can have it." The child said "Sera Lama, Sera Lama" and spoke with him in a Lhasa accent, in a dialect the boy's mother could not understand. The next time the party returned to the house, they revealed their real purpose and asked permission to subject the boy to certain tests. One test consisted of showing him various pairs of objects, one of which had belonged to the 13th Dalai Lama and one which had not. In every case, he chose the Dalai Lama's own objects and rejected the others. From 1936 the Hui 'Ma Clique' Muslim warlord Ma Bufang ruled Qinghai as its governor under the nominal authority of the Republic of China central government. According to an interview with the 14th Dalai Lama, in the 1930s, Ma Bufang had seized this north-east corner of Amdo in the name of Chiang Kai-shek's weak government and incorporated it into the Chinese province of Qinghai. Before going to Taktser, Kewtsang had gone to Ma Bufang to pay his respects. When Ma Bufang heard a candidate had been found in Taktser, he had the family brought to him in Xining. He first demanded proof that the boy was the Dalai Lama, but the Lhasa government, though

informed by Kewtsang that this was the one, told Kewtsang to say he had to go to Lhasa for further tests with other candidates. They knew that if he was declared to be the Dalai Lama, the Chinese government would insist on sending a large army escort with him, which would then stay in Lhasa and refuse to budge Ma Bufang, together with Kumbum Monastery, then refused to allow him to depart unless he was declared to be the Dalai Lama, but withdrew this demand in return for 100,000 Chinese dollars ransom in silver to be shared amongst them, to let them go to Lhasa. Kewtsang managed to raise this, but the family was only allowed to move from Xining to Kumbum when a further demand was made for another 330,000 dollars ransom: one hundred thousand each for government officials, the commander-in-chief, and the Kumbum Monastery; twenty thousand for the escort; and only ten thousand for Ma Bufang himself, he said. Two years of diplomatic wrangling followed before it was accepted by Lhasa that the ransom had to be paid to avoid the Chinese getting involved and escorting him to Lhasa with a large army. Meanwhile, the boy was kept at Kumbum where two of his brothers were already studying as monks and recognised incarnate lamas. The payment of 300,000 silver dollars was then advanced by Muslim traders en route to Mecca in a large caravan via Lhasa. They paid Ma Bufang on behalf of the Tibetan government against promissory notes to be redeemed, with interest, in Lhasa. The 20,000-dollar fee for an escort was dropped, since the Muslim merchants invited them to join their caravan for protection; Ma Bufang sent 20 of his soldiers with them and was paid from both sides since the Chinese government granted him another 50,000 dollars for the expenses of the journey. Furthermore, the Indian government helped the Tibetans raise the ransom funds by affording them import concessions. Released from Kumbum, on 21 July 1939 the party travelled across Tibet in an epic journey to Lhasa in the large Muslim caravan with Lhamo Thondup, now 4 years old, riding with his brother Lobsang in a special palanquin carried by two mules, two years after being discovered. As soon as they were out of Ma Bufang's area, he was officially declared to be the 14th Dalai Lama by the Central Government of Tibet, and after ten weeks of travel he arrived in Lhasa on 8 October 1939. The ordination (pabbajja) and giving of the monastic name of Tenzin Gyatso were handled by Reting Rinpoche. There was very limited Chinese involvement at this time. Tibetan Buddhists normally refer to him as Yishin Norbu (Wish-Fulfilling Gem), Kyabgon (Saviour), or just Kundun (Presence). His devotees, as well as much of the Western world, often call him His Holiness the Dalai Lama, the style employed on the Dalai Lama's website. According to the Dalai Lama, he had a succession of tutors in Tibet including Reting Rinpoche, Tathag Rinpoche, Ling Rinpoche and lastly Trijang Rinpoche, who became junior tutor when he was nineteen. At the age of 11 he met the Austrian mountaineer Heinrich Harrer,



who became his videographer and tutor about the world outside Lhasa. The two remained friends until Harrer's death in 2006. In 1959, at the age of 23, he took his final examination at Lhasa's Jokhang Temple during the annual Monlam or Prayer Festival. He passed with honours and was awarded the Lharampa degree, the highest-level geshe degree, roughly equivalent to a doctorate in Buddhist philosophy.

Exile to India

At the outset of the 1959 Tibetan uprising, fearing for his life, the Dalai Lama and his retinue fled Tibet with the help of the CIA's Special Activities Division, crossing into India on 30 March 1959, reaching Tezpur in Assam on 18 April. Some time later he set up the Government of Tibet in Exile in Dharamshala, India, which is often referred to as "Little Lhasa". After the founding of the government in exile he re-established the approximately 80,000 Tibetan refugees who followed him into exile in agricultural settlements. He created a Tibetan educational system in order to teach the Tibetan children the language, history, religion, and culture. The Tibetan Institute of Performing Arts was established in 1959 and the Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies became the primary university for Tibetans in India in 1967. He supported the re-founding of 200 monasteries and nunneries in an attempt to preserve Tibetan Buddhist teachings and the Tibetan way of life. The Dalai Lama appealed to the United Nations on the rights of Tibetans. This appeal resulted in three resolutions adopted by the General Assembly in 1959, 1961, and 1965 all before the People's Republic was allowed representation at the United Nations. The resolutions called on China to respect the human rights of Tibetans. In 1963, he promulgated a democratic constitution which is based upon the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, creating an elected parliament and an administration to champion his cause. In 1970, he opened the Library of Tibetan Works and Archives in Dharamshala which houses over 80,000 manuscripts and important knowledge resources related to Tibetan history, politics and culture. It is considered one of the most important institutions for Tibetology in the world. In 2016, there were demands from Indian citizens and politicians of different political parties to confer the Dalai Lama the prestigious Bharat Ratna, the highest civilian honour of India, which has only been awarded to a non-Indian citizen twice in its history.

The entire power is with only two companies and two people. They decide who should sing and who shouldn't."

Sonu, in the vlog, also shared how music companies got him to record a song and later got it dubbed because a certain actor had a collaboration with another singer. "In my case, I've known of this same actor, who's under scanner right now, telling not to give a particular song to me. He's done the same with Arijit Singh too. So many

of my songs got dubbed. I don't ask for work. Yet, they call me, get me to record a song and then dub it, that's funny. Now imagine, if they can do this with someone like me who's been a part of the music industry since 1989, what can they do with the new kids. Even directors and producers are not happy because they aren't allowed to make the music of their choice. I meet so many directors who say we don't want a particular song, but it is the music companies' demand."

Lastly, Sonu Nigam requested the music companies to become compassionate towards newcomers and not torture them.



"I've seen the frustration in the eyes and voice of the new talent. If they die, fingers will be raised at you... I'm done with this but please don't torture the younger ones, don't oppress them. This isn't a very good space. Try and step into their shoes. They need your help and kindness," he concluded.

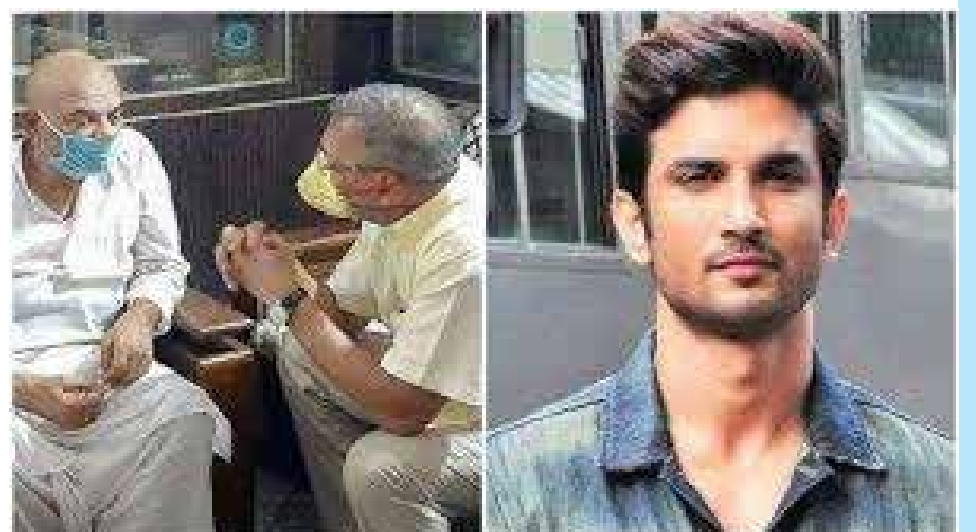

Chaman Bahar Movie Review: Jitendra Kumar Shines in This Slightly Uncomfortable Film

When a new girl comes to a school, college or town, the mystery around her makes many people swoon. This is a storyline we have watched many times in Hindi films. However, this time it is an unsuspecting minor school-girl and all the men in said town. Hence Chaman Bahar starts off as an extremely uncomfortable watch.

A film about an ambitious pan-seller, Billu who wants to be known by everyone in the town, finds out that the pan-shop he started with very high expectations now falls in a redundant area of town. He is now dejected because he left his inherited post as a forest guard for this, and hangs a calendar with the image of Goddess Laxmi, the Hindu Goddess of wealth in his shop, only to spot his real-life Laxmi moments later. A wealthy family moves in the house opposite his shop, and the daughter, Rinku catches his eye immediately.

Our hero looks at her in awe as she moves in slow motion, her straightened hair flying while she plays with her pet Pomeranian. She also, unfortunately, seems to catch the eye of all the young men in the town on while she rides to her school on a scooter. These men now begin getting their nicotine fix from our hero. Business booms, so does his problems.

When two of Billu's parasitic friends involve two rival political leaders, he realises the list of her "Aashiqs" is way too long. He then looks for various ways to get them out of the race. All of this without ever meeting her.

What I like about Chaman Bahar is that



even when it is very testosterone-y – there are two female characters, one gets a line to speak and no, that is not the lead – it is not a Kabir Singh. While it is a very authentic portrayal of male entitlement in small cities of India, there are consequences to ones actions.

Speaking of authenticity, the look and feel of the film is so on-point, the dialect is perfect, and the humour is "swaad-anusaar." Nobody looks like an actor, they look like they belong. The only person who looks out of place is Rinku, and that is because she is made to look that way. The men fall in love with her because she is an idolised and aspirational example of class and beauty for them. That is quite a genius move on the director's part.

Apurva Dhar Badgaiyann, who has also written the screenplay of the film, tries to put in various layers to this "love story." He talks about poverty, poor people being political pawns, cancer, police brutality and harassment. For you to actually get a taste of this amalgamation, you need to have patience. There are also quick sequences that might not mean much, but are really witty in hindsight. It is a film based on clever writing.

The best thing about the film is Jitendra Kumar. The man is a chameleon and can become any character he wants to. There are so many highs in this performance, some of which you will take away with you long after the film is over. Ritika Badiani is

full of potential, emoting well without dialogues. She becomes one-toned throughout the film, as her character is written strongly from the male gaze, but does get her redemption arc later in a penultimate sequence. Bhuvan Arora and Dhirendra Tiwari are a delight and stand out from Jitendra's passivity in the first half of the film. Alam Khan too, as a pan-chewing political heir steals the show.

Chaman Bahar is quite an entertaining watch if you want to watch something funny yet heartfelt. You cannot expect a lot of political correctness or female empowerment in it, but that is exactly how it is like to be a woman in India.

Recipe

Balti Chicken

Balti Chicken Recipe in English:

- 1/2 cup Oil
 - 1 Onion
 - 2 tbsp Ginger Garlic paste
 - 700g Chicken
 - 3 medium Tomatoes
 - Salt to taste
 - 1-2 tsp Red chili powder
 - 1/2 tsp Garam masala
 - 2-3 green chilies
 - 3/4 cup Yogurt
 - 1 tsp Black pepper
 - 1 tsp Roasted Crushed coriander
 - 1 tsp Roasted Crushed cumin
 - 1 tbsp Lemon juice
 - 2 tbsp Coriander leaves
- Direction:
- in a pan add oil and onion. Fry onion until golden brown.

- Now add ginger garlic paste and cook for a minute.
- Then add chicken and cook until it changes its color.
- Add tomatoes, cover the lid and cook for 4-5 minutes on medium flame.
- Then add salt, black pepper, turmeric, red chili, green chili and garam masala and mix all together well.
- Now add yogurt and cook for 2 minutes.
- Then add roasted crushed cumin, roasted crushed coriander and lemon juice, mix well.
- Now sprinkle coriander leaves and cover the lid. let it cook for 6-8 minutes on medium low flame.
- Serve with Naan.



Chicken Roulade With Dijonnaise Sauce

Chicken Roulade with Dijonnaise sauce

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup Mushroom
- 1 cup Spinach (boiled)
- 1 cube Chicken stock
- 2 tbsp Butter
- 1/2 tsp Black pepper
- 1/2 cup Cream
- 4-5 Chicken fillets
- 2 Eggs beaten (for coating)
- Bread crumbs (for coating)
- All-purpose flour (For coating)

Ingredients for Dijonnaise sauce:

- 2-3 tbsp Oil
- 1/2 cup Onion (chopped)
- 2-3 tbsp Mustard paste
- 1 cup Milk
- 1/2 tsp Oregano (dried)
- 1/2 cup Cream



- 1 tsp Chili flakes
- 1 cube Chicken stock
- 1 tsp Garlic (chopped)

Directions:

Take a pan heat butter, then add

- mushrooms and sauté a bit.
- Add spinach, white pepper, chicken stock, and mix it well.
- Then add cream and mix well until you get creamy texture.
- Take chicken fillets, ham until flatten

enough then add creamy spinach and roll it in cling sheet, giving it a toffee like shape.

Keep it in freezer for 5 to 6 hours. When you take them out first defrost. Then coat it in flour, egg, bread crumbs and fry on low medium heat until golden brown.

Directions for sauce:

In a pan heat oil, add garlic and sauté a bit. Then add onion and cook until translucent.

Add mustard paste, chili flakes, chicken stock, milk, cream and mix it well for 1 to 2 minutes.

Serve with any pasta or garlic rice and enjoy.

Preparation time: 15 minutes

Cooking time: 30-40 minutes

Serving: 2-3

Egg Custard Pudding

For Pudding:

- Eggs / Ande - 4
- Sugar / Shakar - 10 tbsp (standard measurements)
- Full Fat Warm Milk / Balai Wala Garam Doodh - 1 1/2 std cup
- Vanilla Flavored Custard Powder - 3 tbsp custard powder

For the Caramel:

- Water / Pani - 1 1/2 tbsp
- Sugar / Shakar - 5 tbsp

Procedure:

1. Break eggs in a bowl. Beat thoroughly and keep aside.
2. To another bowl add 10 tbsp sugar and 1 1/2 std cups full fat warm milk.
3. Mix well till sugar is dissolved in the milk completely.
4. Allow this milk to cool.
5. Add 3 tbsp vanilla flavored custard powder to this cold milk and beat well

- till no lumps are left. Remember to add custard powder to cold milk only.
6. Now add beaten eggs to milk and beat well. Keep aside.
7. To set the pudding, take a steel box with a lid.
8. I have made and set caramel in the box itself. You can make caramel in any other pan and then add to the box.
9. For the caramel, keep the steel box on the stove.
10. Add 1 1/2 tbsp water.
11. Add 5 tbsp sugar.
12. Keep on medium flame to prevent burning. Avoid stirring to prevent the crystallization of sugar. Swirl the box to prevent burning.
13. When the caramel sauce attains a thick consistency and when it attains a light brown or honey colour, switch off the flame.

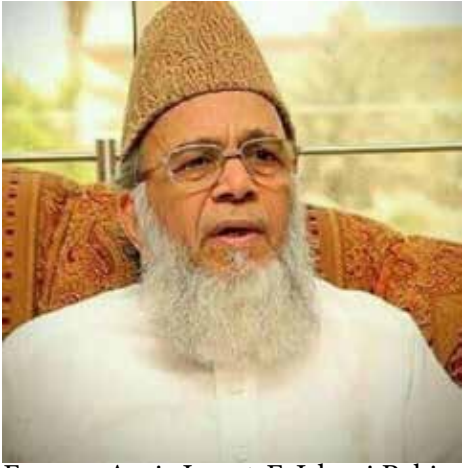
14. Be careful to attain that color without burning, therefore, immediately lift the box away from the stove.
15. Spread the caramel evenly by swirling the box while it is still very hot.
16. Leave this to cool for around 10 min.
17. When the caramel sauce hardens, pour the egg and milk mixture.
18. Close the lid of the box tightly.
19. Add 250 ml water to a pressure cooker.
20. Place this box in pressure cooker. Pressure cook on medium flame for exactly 12 min.
21. When the pressure settles, remove the box carefully and allow it to cool



- and then keep in the refrigerator for 2 hrs.
22. Run the knife along the sides of the box to facilitate the pudding to slide wholly.
23. Place a plate on the top of the box and turn it upside down so that the pudding slides down easily.
24. The delicious pudding is ready. Serve chilled for the perfect taste.

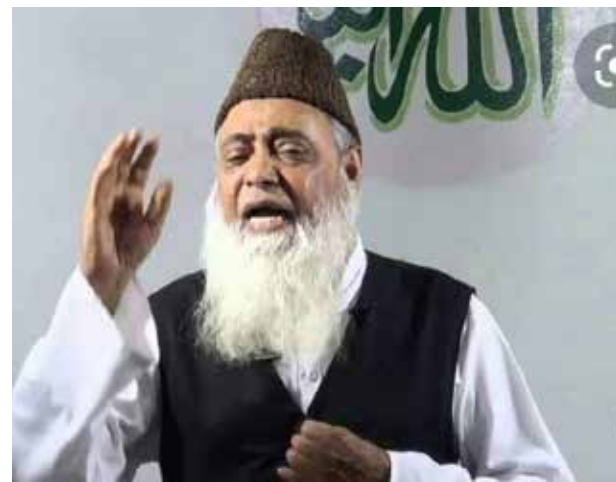

دانائے مشرق، بلبل شیراز، حضرت شیخ سعدی شیرازی رضی اللہ عنہ فارسی زبان کے عالمی شہرت یافتہ ادیب، شاعر، سیاح و دانشور گزرے ہیں۔ آپ کی پیدائش تقریباً آٹھ سو سال قبل سادات کے اک معزز گھرانے میں ہوئی جو برسوں پہلے مکہ سے ہجرت کر کے شیراز میں آسا تھا۔ خاندان میں دینداری کا بول بالا تھا اس لئے ابتدائی تعلیم گھر پر ہوئی اور چھوٹی سی عمر میں تمام ضروری دینی مسائل یاد ہو گئے جس کے ساتھ عبادت، شب بیداری اور تلاوت کلام پاک کا شوق پیدا ہو گیا۔ گیارہ سال کی عمر میں کلام مجید حفظ کر لیا۔ تفسیر، فقہ، حدیث اور صرف و نحو کی ابتدائی کتابیں پڑھیں اور سن بلوغ کو پہنچنے سے پہلے ہی نہایت اعلیٰ و ارفع اخلاق و کردار کے مالک بن گئے۔ ان کی سلیقہ مندی، زہد و تقویٰ، ذہانت و دانشمندی کا ہر طرف چرچا ہو جائے گا۔ نو عمری میں والدین کے ساتھ پہلا حج کیا اور اپنی زندگی میں چودہ حج پایادہ کئے۔ بغداد کے مدرسہ نظامیہ میں تقریباً تیس سال تک مشہور زمانہ علمائے کرام سے تحصیل علم و فیض صحت حاصل کر کے قرآن، حدیث، تفسیر، منطق، فلسفہ، ریاضی اور دیگر علوم پر عبور حاصل کیا۔ ساتھ ہی کئی اجنبی زبانوں میں بھی مہارت حاصل کر لی۔ تحصیل علم سے فارغ ہو کر حضرت سعدی شیرازی نے سیاحت پر کمر باندھ لی اور عمر کا بیشتر حصہ ایشیاء، آفریقہ اور دنیا کے دیگر ممالک کی سیرو سیاحت میں بسر کیا۔ کہا جاتا ہے کہ مشرقی سیاحوں میں ابن بطوطہ کے سوا شیخ سعدی سے بڑھ کر کوئی اور سیاح نہیں۔ انہوں نے سیاحت کے دوران بڑی صعوبتیں اٹھائیں اور بڑے تجربے حاصل کئے۔ ایک اندازے کے مطابق شیخ سعدی کی تصانیف تیس سے متجاوز اور ایک سے بڑھ کر ایک ہیں لیکن ان کی دو

ہی پکڑا دیا؛ یاد رہے بات قابلیت کی ہو رہی ہے، انسائیڈ ٹریڈنگ، بیکنگ، کاپنگ کے الزامات میں جیل جانے والوں کی نہیں!

مزے کی بات ہے پاکستان کے ہر شعبے کا بندہ باہر جا کر جھنڈے گاڑ دیتا ہے اور ”ہم کسی سے کم نہیں“ کا عملی ثبوت بن جاتا ہے سوائے ایک فیلڈ کے اور وہ ہے وکالت! امریکہ میں سترہ سال میں شاید ہی کوئی ایک وکیل دیکھا ہو جو یہاں آ کر پریکٹس کرے ورنہ 99.99% اسٹور یا ٹیکسی چلاتے ہیں کیونکہ آگے پڑھنے کی قابلیت ہی نہیں؛ یہی حال پاکستانی دکلا کا یورپ میں ہے! میرے کئی وکیل دوست تنقید پر ناراض ہو جاتے ہیں لیکن جس ملک کو بنایا ہی دو عظیم وکیوں نے ہو وہاں دکلا کی یہ حالت کیا قابل تشویش نہیں؟

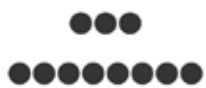

پر محنت شروع کی۔ مسجد میں کوئی تعلیم و تبلیغ کرنے نہیں دیتا تھا۔ انہوں نے مشغلہ بنایا کہ چائے خانہ میں جا کر بیٹھ جاتے، ذہین لڑکوں کو چائے پلاتے۔ ان پر محنت کرتے اور دین کی تعلیم کے لئے تیار کر لیتے۔ اسی کوشش میں ان کے ہاتھ ایک ہیرا لگا۔ ان کا یہ شاگرد ایک انجینئر تھا۔ یہ شاگرد پڑھنے لگا تو جرمنی سے اعلیٰ تعلیم حاصل کر لی۔ پھر ملک آیا تو ترکی کو ٹینک کے لئے ایسی موٹر تیار کر کے دی جو سخت ترین سردی میں بھی انجن کو گرم رکھتی تھی۔ سیاست میں قدم رکھا تو ملک کا وزیر اعظم بن گیا۔ اس شاگرد کا نام نجم الدین اربکان تھا۔ اربکان نے اپنی زندگی میں متعدد شاگرد تیار کیے۔ سیاسی شاگرد طیب اردگان کہلا یا، رفاہی میدان میں بلند یلدرم وغیرہ۔ ترکی میں ہم نے اصلاح احوال کی دو محنتیں دیکھی ہیں۔ ایک باقاعدہ اور دوسری بے قاعدہ۔ باقاعدہ محنتیں: حکمت و بصیرت: نجم الدین اربکان نے مختلف ناموں سے سیاسی جماعت بنائی مگر ہر بار سیکولر فوج نے کسی نہ کسی بہانے سے ان پر پابندی لگا دی۔ طیب اردگان یہ سارا تماشہ دیکھ رہے تھے کہ پہلے سعادت پارٹی پر پابندی، پھر فضیلت پارٹی پر پابندی، پھر ملت پارٹی بھی بین ہو گئی۔ طیب اردگان نے کہا ہم جتنے بھی نام رکھ لیں، ہر نام پر پابندی لگے گی۔ اردگان نے کہا کہ ہمیں کوئی بھی ایسا نام نہیں رکھنا چاہیے جس پر کوئی شک کر سکے۔ اس لئے انصاف اور ترقی پارٹی نام رکھنا چاہیے۔ استاد کے سامنے یہ تجویز پیش کی تو اربکان نے اپنے ہونہار شاگرد سے کہا: * * * تم یہ نام ضرور رکھو، مگر مجھ سے اور میری چھاپ سے الگ ہو جاؤ: * * * اس طرح بظاہر اردگان اور اربکان کے راستے جدا جدا ہو گئے مگر دونوں دراصل ایک ہی منزل کے مسافر تھے۔ اتفاق فی سبیل اللہ: ترکوں کی نمایاں ترین صفت اللہ کے راستے میں بے دریغ خرچ کرنا بھی ہے۔ پاکستان میں زلزلہ آیا تو سب سے پہلے وہ پنپے، میکسیکو میں تباہی ہوئی تو وہاں بھی ترک ہی سب سے پہلے پنپے۔ وہاں ہم نے محسوس کیا کہ ترک لوگ اپنی اضافی دولت خیرات کرتے ہیں۔ ان کا وژن ہے: ان فی مالک حقا سوا الزکوٰۃ۔ اسی طرح سلونک ماذا یُشفقون، قل العفو عوامی خدمت طلب اردگان نے 12 سال میں تمام قرض اتار دیے۔ بغیر قرض کے دنیا کے 3 بڑے منصوبے بنا رہے ہیں۔ دنیا کا سب سے بڑا ایئر پورٹ، دو سو سو روٹوں کو ملانے والی دنیا کی تیسری مصنوعی نہر "باسفورس کینال" اور خلیج باسفورس پر ایک اور بڑا پل۔ ہاسٹل: انہوں نے یونیورسٹیوں کے قریب ہاسٹل بنائے۔ وہاں پر انتہائی واجبی فیس کے عوض بہترین رہائش فراہم کی ہے۔ یہاں آنے والے بچوں پر کوئی پابندی نہیں۔ صرف ایک یہ پابندی کہ رات دس بجے کے بعد باہر نہیں جانا۔ دن میں دو بار: * * * کلیات النور: * * * سید الزمان نوری کی تعلیم سنیں۔ مولوی خانے: ایک اہم کام مولوی خانے کا بھی ہے۔ یہ کہنے کو
