Placement Rate Methodology

Placement rates are determined by the placement of students that complete or graduate from a program and employed in the field or related field to the program studies, entered military or continued education.

Graduate and non-graduate completers

Graduate completer: those that have achieved the competencies required in that program and have been awarded the appropriate certificate diploma.

Non-Graduate completer: those that left the program without credentials or a certificate/diploma but have attained sufficient competencies in the program and a job in a related field.

Graduation Rate= Graduate completers (numerator) divided by Cumulative enrollment minus(-) ending enrollment (denominator)

Total Completion Rate = Total Completers (numerator) divided by cumulative enrollment minus (-) ending enrollment (denominator)

Graduation Placement Rate= Graduate completers placed in related field (numerator) divided by Total Graduate completers minus (-) those who were unavailable for or refused employment (denominator).

Total Placement Rate= Graduate & Non-Graduate Completers (numerator) divided by Total completers minus (-) those who were unavailable for or refused employment (denominator).

Definition of Placement

Employed in field or related field for which trained, entered military or continuing education.
