Our staff has completed an extensive records retention project, reorganized supplies and updated our procedures manual while taking care of visiting Christian Science nursing and outpatient calls. We have upgraded our casita and attached bathroom for rest and study patrons and staff, and have purchased and installed three new nursing beds and three new comfortable lift chairs in the nursing rooms.

We have happily and humbly recognized that God, divine Love, is meeting our needs. We have received funds from various sources that covered staff wages for several months and allowed us to purchase the new furniture and implement the casita remodeling. Volunteers have donated their specialized skills out of love for Desert View, and some merchants have provided discounts. Branch churches and individuals have continued to donate in support of our activities.

The proverb reads, "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths" (Proverbs 3:5, 6), and a well-loved article by Milton Simon, "All The Way" shows us that God does not take us part way, but all the way.
