DESCRIPTION: The Yukon is a great starter or youth bow. Performs well—like all Shakespeare models. Island Maple riser. Comfortable grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Maple tip overlays have been added for additional beauty is protection. Two professionally filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic on last page—they almost look like knots as the screw holes were filled with maple saw dust.). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in fair shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a nice flipper rest and a good string.
