Ordinance 2017-16

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS
IN CERTAIN VILLAGE BUILDINGS AND ON VILLAGE PROPERTY
BY VALID OHIO CONCEALED CARRY PERMITHOLDERS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, consistent with Ohio Revised Section 2923.126, Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio (the "Village") seeks to allow all valid Ohio concealed carry permit holders to carry their legally permitted concealed weapons in all Village buildings and on all Village property except in the Amelia Village Police Department building and anywhere the Amelia Village Mayor's Court is being conducted during court hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that;

SECTION I. The Council of Amelia Village finds that all valid Ohio concealed carry permit holders shall be permitted to carry their legally permitted concealed weapons in all Village buildings and on all Village property except in the Amelia Village Police Department building and anywhere the Amelia Village Mayor's Court is being conducted during court hours, or any other location prohibited by Ohio law.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to ensure the safety of residents of Amelia. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


SECTION III. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this legislation were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

D. Campbell moved for the adoption of the Ordinance.
