Husband wins, wife shocked

Drudging through medical appointments turned into a “dream” for one Buckeye State couple. A Carrollton, Ohio, man, who has not been publicly named, finished taking his wife for a series of appointments as part of her cancer treatment and decided to stop by a convenience store on the way home, according to state lottery officials. The husband picked up a couple of \$5 scratch-off tickets and found one last Best of 7’s scratch-off in a bin, the officials said. When he got home, he was amazed to find the ticket was a top prize winner, worth \$500,000. He’ll take home about \$360,000. “I still can’t believe it,” the man said. “I still think it’s a dream!” He rushed to share the good news with his wife, who initially didn’t believe him. “She looked at me funny and said, ‘Did you fall?’ I said, ‘No I’m in shock! I think I won half a million dollars!’” The woman was finally convinced after her husband scanned the ticket on the Ohio Lottery app and proved it to her. The man said his particular ticket selection strategy had paid off: “I like the end of the roll, I’ll buy in the middle too, but always liked the end of the roll best.” The man told lottery officials that his prize is a blessing, noting their family

has been facing rising medical bills amid his wife’s cancer, which can now be paid for with some of the money. When she recovers, he’s hoping to plan something they’ll enjoy together.

Mom of six hits on new ticket

Trena Nicholson, a resident of Hamlet, North Carolina, recently bought a new scratch-off game ticket from a local Speedway, according to the North Carolina Education Lottery. The new game, Ruby Red 7’s, had only recently debuted in the state. The game has three \$2 million top prizes and nine \$100,000 prizes — and Nicholson couldn’t believe her luck when she saw all those zeroes were hers. “I was jumping up and down screaming,” Nicholson said. “I had to look at it again to make sure I was seeing it right.” The first thing she did was call her six children. Despite Nicholson telling them for years that she’d win the lottery one day, the news came as a shock to the whole family. Nicholson opted to receive the prize in a lump sum of \$1.2 million, rather than annuity payments of \$100,000 over the next 20 years. After mandatory tax withholdings, she brought home \$861,006, which she plans to pay bills with and share with her family.

Gaming News

History’s greatest cheat

An excellent animated YouTube video tells the 26-minute story of how Tommy Glen Carmichael, a locksmith and TV repairman from Tulsa, Oklahoma, turned himself into the most successful slot machine cheater in history. For 16 years, he engineered a series of homemade devices so powerful they fooled casinos in Las Vegas, Reno, Atlantic City, and cruise ships, earning him more than \$16 million—before the FBI finally caught up. It was the longest running (known) casino heist ever. After his arrest, Tommy became a paid consultant, hired by the casinos he once robbed, to help them stop cheaters like him.

WSOP 2026 schedule

The 57th annual World Series of Poker dates are set: May 26-July 15, with the Main Event July 2-9. There will be 100 live bracelet events of all varieties, with a focus on mixed-game and mid-stakes tournaments, and the final table for the Main Event will be delayed, though for how long will be announced later (could it be a return of the November Nine?). A free livestream on the WSOP YouTube channel will run through the start of the Main Event, providing much more exposure than usual for the players and games.

Poker Palace reopens

The CEO of Truckee Gaming told the Nevada Gaming Control Board yesterday that the former Poker

Casino Q&A

Q: Is it true that casinos are going to introduce slot machines that accept credit cards and debit cards?

A: In most traditional casinos, a slot machine cannot directly accept a debit card into its main bill validator or card reader to start playing. However, modern cashless gaming systems and online platforms have changed how you can use your card.

Physical Casinos

While you usually cannot slide a debit card directly into a slot machine like a credit card at a gas pump, there are several ways casinos facilitate card use:

- **Cashless Wallets & Apps:** Many modern casinos (such as PENN Entertainment) allow you to link a debit card to a digital wallet app on your phone. You can then transfer funds from your bank to the app and tap or scan a QR code at the slot machine to load credits.

- **Wagering Accounts:** Some casinos allow you to deposit funds into a Cashless Wagering Account at the Cashier’s Cage. Once funded, you can use your player loyalty card and a PIN at the machine to pull those funds directly onto the game.

- **Voucher Kiosks:** In many jurisdictions, players can use their debit cards at a nearby kiosk to purchase a ticket-in, ticket-out (TITO) voucher, which is then inserted into the slot machine like cash.

- **On-Site ATMs:** This remains the most common method. Players withdraw cash from an ATM on the casino floor—often for a high fee.

Online Casinos

Online slot casinos almost universally accept debit cards for direct deposits. Once the deposit is confirmed, the funds are immediately available.

Why the Restrictions?

Regulators often prohibit direct card-to-machine transactions as a responsible gambling safeguard.

Palace, which the company bought in October, will reopen no later than mid-April. It will be renamed Club Fortune North, to brand it with Club Fortune (South), a Truckee Gaming property in Henderson. “If Circus Circus and Excalibur had a baby, that was Poker Palace,” said Truckee Gaming’s Ferenc Szony. He elaborated that Poker Palace received a “total gut job” and is being rebuilt from the floor up. The Control Board forwarded its recommendation to the Gaming Commission that the company receive its gaming license for the North Las Vegas property, along with approval for a Boomer’s sports book to accompany the reopening; Boomer’s will also have a race book, but unlike Poker Palace, no table games.

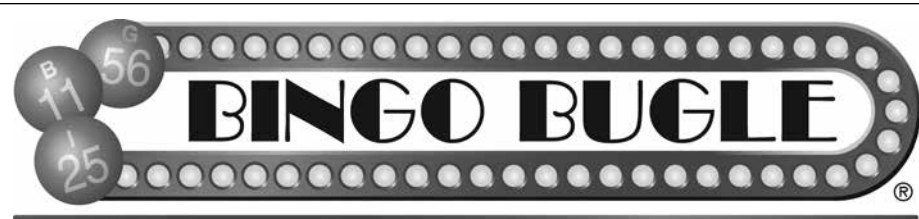

Bingo to the rescue

More than 100 people packed Silver Moon Brewing on a recent Sunday morning in Bend, Oregon for a sold-out round of Not’Cho Grandma’s Bingo, raising money for survivors of human trafficking in Central Oregon. Hosted by The YOUNI Movement, the event featured music, prizes and a lively crowd, with proceeds benefiting the Anti-Trafficking Project, a program of J Bar J Youth Services. Based in Bend since 2018, the Anti-Trafficking Project serves Deschutes, Jefferson and Crook counties, offering crisis support, housing assistance and case management for survivors. “Anti-trafficking is such a heavy topic to talk about. Events like this, where we can just have a good time and talk about our program a little bit, but just get people out, get people supporting and raise awareness, it’s huge,” said Amy Glover, outreach coordinator for the Anti-Trafficking Project. Jasmine Rodriguez, an advocate and task force coordinator with the program, said the work is personal. “What we’re doing goes deeper than just a job. For me, it goes deeper than just helping people. That’s really healing a part of me that I never, ever thought would heal. As a survivor, I didn’t think I would see days where I’m here doing this kind of work for other people,” she said. Organizers said the event showed how the community can come together for a serious cause in a welcoming, high-energy space. (Reporting by Central Oregon Daily News.)

Barks & Bingo

On the lighter side, Mount Pleasant Towne Centre recently held a new event series kicking off the spring season: Barks & Bingo, an interactive yappy hour for owners and their furry friends, benefitting Charleston Animal Society. The first installment of this dog-friendly event was held in March at Burtons Grill & Bar. Participants enjoyed multiple rounds of bingo for the chance to win prizes that they and their pups could enjoy, dined on food and drinks from Burtons’ full menu, and took home a party favor from Hairy Winston Pet Boutique.

The “Goal Bingo” social trend

Goal Bingo was trending at press time on platforms like TikTok and Pinterest. In Goal Bingo people are creating

5x5 bingo cards filled with personal goals (e.g., read 10 books or visit a new city). Participants then mark off squares throughout the year as they complete the goals, aiming for a bingo or a full blackout by December 31.

Bingo Biz highlights

Bingo continues its evolution from local halls to national television and digital platforms. In addition to the Bingo Blitz TV Show hosted by Valerie Bertinelli on the Game Show Network, live bingo is being rebranded for younger audiences, incorporating “chaos and charisma” into high-energy events that feel more like parties than traditional gambling. And innovative gameplay variants keep popping up, including new mechanics to keep the format fresh. One of these variants is Bingo Roulette, where a roulette wheel replaces the traditional ball draw, adding a strategic betting layer. And popular apps have added Plinko-style mini-games within their bingo interface to award extra prizes.

Finding the perfect place to retire

Dear Savvy Senior,

What resources can you recommend for researching good places to retire in the U.S.? My husband and I are interested in relocating to a warmer climate when we retire next year. —
Looking to Relocate

Dear Looking,

It's exciting to think about relocating in retirement! Whether you're considering seasonal escapes or a permanent change, there are a wide variety of digital resources that can help you find and research new locations. Here are some tips and tools to help you get started.

Where to Retire?

Deciding where to relocate when you retire is a big decision. There are many factors to think about to ensure the move supports your lifestyle, financial goals, and overall well-being. To help you identify some good retirement locations you need to consider things like cost of living, climate, taxes, health care, housing, crime, access to social and recreational activities, access to transportation and proximity to family and friends.

If you're at the beginning of your search, a good starting point is [Best-](#)

[Places.net](#). This site compiles demographic data from numerous reliable sources, updates it regularly and lets you easily compare cities using different criteria, such as housing cost, climate, crime, religious practice, voting patterns and education level. They even offer a 10-question "Where is the best place for me to live?" quiz, which may suggest some locations you may never have thought of.

There are also news and financial publications like U.S. News & World Report, Forbes, WalletHub, Bankrate and The Motley Fool that publish "best places to retire" ranking lists on their websites each year. These can give you an idea of popular retirement locations based on different sets of criteria.

Once you identify a few good spots, here are some additional resources that can help you dig a little deeper.

Cost of living: Affordability is often the No. 1 factor when deciding where to relocate. To research and compare the cost of living from your current location to where you would like to move, use the previously mentioned BestPlaces.net, the Economic Policy Institute Family Budget Calculator and/or Bankrate's cost of living calculator. And, because housing is a big expense, you can take a deeper dive into these costs at Zillow.com and Realtor.com.

Taxes: Some states are more tax friendly than others. To investigate how states treat retirees when it comes to income, sales, property and other taxes, see Kiplinger tax guide Taxes on Retirees: A State-by-State Guide.

Crime rate: To evaluate how safe a community or area is, the FBI Crime Data Explorer allows you to explore crime statistics at the national, state, and local levels.

Climate: You can find U.S. climate/ weather information at National Centers for Environmental Information at [NCEI.noaa.gov](#). And to research climate change factors and the risks of extreme temperatures, wildfires, floods, hurricanes, severe storms, earthquakes and drought in different locations, use [ClimateCheck.com](#) and FEMA.

Health care: If you're enrolled or planning to enroll in original Medicare, check the coverage and availability of providers in your new location. Search by ZIP code for health care providers and facilities at [Medicare.gov/care-compare](#), and check star ratings for quality of care. If you're enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan and you move out of the coverage area, you'll need to find a new plan in your new area.

Transportation: If you plan to travel much, or expect frequent visits from your kids or grandkids, convenient access to an airport or train station is a big advantage.

Once you have narrowed down your choices, spend a couple weeks in each location at different times of the year so you can get a feel for the seasonal weather changes, and so you can carefully weigh the pros and cons of living there. You may find that you like the area more as a vacation spot than as a year-round residence. It's also a good idea to rent for a year before buying a home or making a commitment to a retirement community.

Thieves don't always do prison time

The reports from the VA's Office of Inspector General are mind-boggling outlines of just how low scammers will go to steal money. Not all of them, however, will do prison time.

A recent report indicates that one man was able to scam over \$1 billion by creating fake medical drug and device claims. This scheme used telemedicine as well as phone calls, the internet and junk mail to con vulnerable people into handing over their personally identifiable information. Armed with that information, the thieves were able to generate fake doctor orders and use their partner pharmacies, telemarketers and equipment suppliers to ship out unneeded medicine and medical items — and get paid for it all to the tune of \$1.45 billion.

The CEO of the medical software company behind all the fraud, is not likely to have time to enjoy the fruits of his ill-gotten cash because, at age 79, he's been sentenced to 15 years in prison and fined over \$452 million in restitution.

Then there is the guy who stole VA grants to the tune of \$1.3 million while pretending to run a nonprofit homeless veterans shelter. Not only did he spend some of that cash on himself, but he pretended to provide counseling services that the veterans never received.

While he could have received up to 10 years in federal prison, he was only sentenced to 42 months, followed by supervised release.

On the other hand, there is the pain doctor who is managing to not go to prison even after knowingly billing for multiple tests on the same patient on the same day. Instead, it's been called civil, not criminal, but he does have to pay \$13.6 million under the False Claims Act.

How is it the theft of that amount of money doesn't result in prison time?

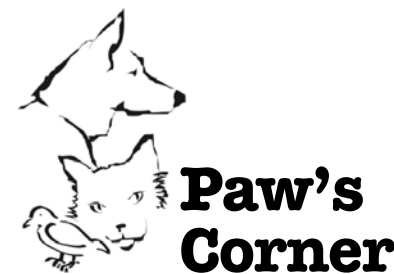

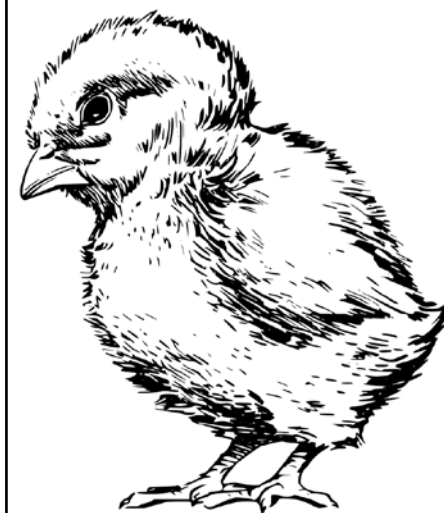
Albert's eating pattern is in line with a dental problem, but don't rule out a possible injury. Regardless, a call to the veterinarian is the best step to take at this point.

The vet will be able to take a closer look at Albert and perform blood, urine and stool tests to see if an infection is present or if something else is going on. If they suspect a tooth problem, Albert will undergo a dental cleaning and evaluation (under anesthesia) and the vet will design a treatment plan for him.

Ask Annie

Annie's apricot bread

Dear Annie,

My husband, Bill, loves any recipe with apricots. Have you ever made anything with apricots? Thank you! — *Barbara Ann from Spruce Pine, NC*

Dear Barbara Ann,

This is a very easy question. I am sure you and Bill will enjoy the Apricot Bread. — *Annie*

APRICOT BREAD

- 1 cup dried apricots, cut-up
- ½ cup hot water
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 3 cups flour
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 3 eggs, beaten
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 cup pecans, chopped

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Using a medium-size size bowl, soak the cut-up apricots in hot water. In a large bowl, mix all of the dry ingredients and the eggs. Mix well. Stir in the sour cream and pecans. Add the unstrained soaked apricots. Using 2 greased loaf pans, divide the mixture evenly. Bake for one hour or less. Do not overbake.

When using a generator: Keep safety in mind

Generators are pretty handy when the weather is bad but it's generally a good idea to follow a few simple safety rules about using one, advise the experts at the Outdoor Power Equipment Institute (OPEI).

- Never use it inside the house, garage or any other enclosed space.
- Install a working carbon monoxide detector.
- Use the right fuel, ideally E10 or less, and make sure it's fresh.

• Use an outdoor rated extension cord only and be sure it's long enough that you can set up the generator a safe distance from the house.

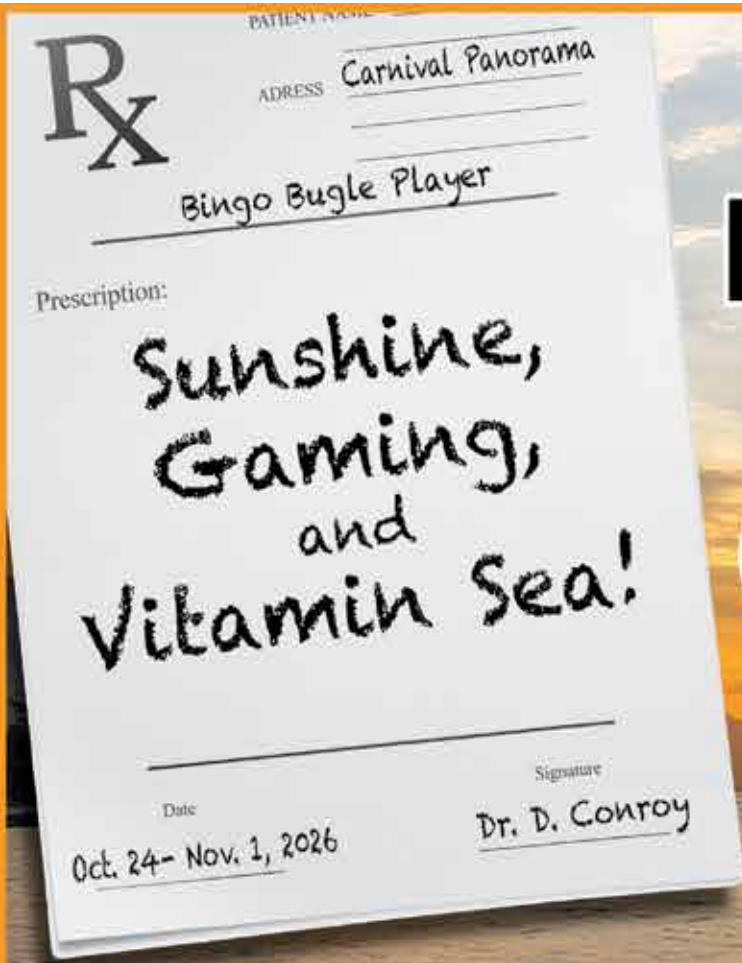

Don't be a pushover by making this mistake

When most recreational poker players face aggression, they fold all but their best hands. This is a huge leak that results in them never becoming winning players. The following hand illustrates that concept.

In a \$500 buy-in tournament with blinds at 300/600 with 25,000 effective stacks, the cutoff raised to 1,200 and our Hero reraised to 3,000 from the button with the JhJd. Only the cutoff called.

The flop came down Ks10s9c, the cutoff checked, and Hero bet 3,500 into the 7,500 pot.

While betting is fine, this is a decent spot to check behind with a clear marginal made hand that really does not want to get check-raised. If Hero bets the flop and either the turn or river, he will have a difficult time getting a significant amount of money in the pot when he has the best hand because most players typically only call two or three bets with strong made hands and premium draws.

This means that Hero's pocket jacks is good for one or possibly two streets of value. While checking behind on the flop may appear weak, Hero should not plan to fold too often

What's New in Nevada

Retro slots & Bingo

Circus Circus has opened a bingo hall, bringing the game back to the Strip for the first time since the Riviera's room closed in 2015 (the second-to-last bingo hall closed at the Frontier in 2007). Circus' room can accommodate 255 players per session and there are five sessions, starting at 3 p.m. Thursday to Sunday. In addition, coin-operated slots have been added to the slot floor, joining Slots A Fun as the only casinos on the Strip to offer the vintage games.

to turn and river bets because his hand will then be underrepresented.

The cutoff called, the turn was the 4h, and both players checked.

Once Hero bets the flop, both betting and checking the turn are fine, although betting small is usually ideal because he has so many other strong hands in his range to the point that he should rarely get raised. If Hero thinks his opponent will be inclined to either raise all-in or fold (and rarely call), then checking behind gains a lot of merit.

The river was the 6d and the cutoff bet 9,000 into the 14,500 pot. Hero gave it some thought and then folded.

This is Hero's major blunder. While he loses to all hands worthy of a value bet, since this is a somewhat small stakes event, many players will over-value worse made hands, such as A-10 and Q-10. Also, all of the flush and straight draws missed. While there should not be many of those in the opponent's range due to Hero's pre-flop reraise, there are enough of them to justify calling.

Hero only needs to win 28% of the time to break even in this situation (9,000)/(14,500 + 9,000 + 9,000). There are enough combinations of worse made hands and busted draws in the cutoff's range to justify calling. Do not fall into the habit of continuation betting the flop with a wide range, checking behind on the turn, and then folding most of that range to any river bet.

If you take this line on a regular basis, your opponents will quickly figure out your weak tendency and adjust to take advantage of you.
