

Things you and your pet sitter will need to discuss

- How will we have access into their home?
- Will Spoil 'em Rotten keep a key on file for future visits?
- Will you be setting your alarm? You can create a code specifically for your sitter to use during pet sitting visits.
- What is the location of food, treats, cleaning supplies in case of accidents, leashes, hidden keys just in case, litter boxes, bags and trash cans for waste. (Recycle bins for cans)
- Will you want your dogs walked? Are there any issues about your animals we should know? How well are your dogs on leashes? Will they react negatively to other dogs? Do you have specific commands that you prefer the sitter to use during visits?
- Are your animals on medication? How well do they take it? What method do you use to administer the medication?
- Who is your vet, where are they located and will they know you are out of town in case we have to make an emergency visit?
- Will you have a cell phone with you at all times? If not, will we be able to reach you in case of an emergency? If not, you will need to provide emergency numbers of family or friends that we may contact near your home.
- Where are your animals' favorite hiding places? Cats especially can be aloof at times. We want to make sure we at least get a peek at your animals during every visit!

Spoil 'em Rotten will spend time in your home during that initial visit to get to know you and your pets. Sometimes, animals can be aggressive out of fear. Should the sitter feel threatened in any way, he/she will have to decline the opportunity to be your sitter due to the chance of getting bitten and the liability that ensues. Please consider your animals' personalities before deciding on a sitter.
