

AN ORDINANCE

REGULATING THE KEEPING OF WEEDS CUT ON REAL ESTATE IN THE TOWN
OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA.

Section One

It is hereby declared to be a nuisance for the owner or occupant of real estate in the town of Cloverdale, Indiana, to allow or permit weeds to grow on said real estate and not cut the same.

Section Two

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to the expense of having said weeds cut and the charge for the same placed against his real estate as provided by law.

Section Three

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and legal advertisement.
