The Nicholas County Airport Authority in conjunction with the Nicholas County Commission is accepting sealed BID proposals on a few jobs at the Summersville Airport.

For Hanger 1 - work will consist of replacing the metal roof, and metal siding on side walls and front to include insulation and, for the replacement of two (2) 36" metal entrance doors. Sandblast and paint the metal structure and install six (6) new LED high bay lights.

For Hanger II - work will consist of repair of leaks in the roof and install six (6) new LED high bay lights.

For Office - work will consist of repair of underpinning, installation of approx. 360sq.ft. of laminate flooring, and repair leak in the roof.

All proposals are due into the office of the Nicholas County Commission, Nicholas County Courthouse, 700 Main St., Ste. 1, Summersville, WV 26651 no later than Wednesday, October 4, 2023 at 1:00 p.m., at which time both the Authority and Commission will open said bids.

SCOPE OF WORK INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

A MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING will be held on **FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2023 AT 2:00 P.M.,** AT SUMMERSVILLE AIRPORT (AVIATION), 2506 SUMMERSVILLE AIRPORT RD., SUMMERSVILLE, WV 26651. ANY CONTRACTOR INTERESTED IN PLACING A BID MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING.

The successful contractor will, during the progress of the work, dispose of all waste material and debris at a qualified disposal

site, and, keep the premises clean.

The contractor will be responsible for control of pedestrian and vehicular traffic in the work area. The successful contractor will supervise and direct the work, using skillful labor and proper equipment for all tasks. Safety of the contractor's personnel and equipment is the responsibility of the contractor.

The successful contractor must be duly licensed in accordance with the State's statutory requirements to perform the work. The contractor will be responsible for determining and obtaining all permits necessary to perform its work.

The successful contractor will be responsible for taking corrective action in response to any notices of violations issued as a result of actions or operations during the performance of this contract. Corrections for any such violations will be at no additional cost to the county.

The successful contractor will provide proof of general liability, auto and workers' compensation insurance. The general liability and auto insurance will be no less than \$1 million per occurrence. Workers' compensation insurance will also be provided and will meet statutory minimum limits.

State of West Virginia Drug Free Workplace Conformance Affidavit shall be submitted with the bid in order to comply with WV Code §21-1D-5. Failure to include the Affidavit with the bid shall result in Disqualification of the Bid.
