

UNION COUNTY COMMISSIONERS – JANUARY 17, 2017

PRESENT: Paul Wiwi, David Woeste, Alan Alcorn, Pam Tharp, Daniel Taylor, Jim Crouch, Caleb Greene, Dale Dishmond, Shaun Tudor, and Gene Sanford

Wiwi called the meeting to order and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance. Woeste moved to approve the minutes of the January 3 meeting. Alcorn seconded the motion and it carried 3-0.

HEALTH DEPT: Diane Timberman appeared with a list of 3 names for possible appointment to two vacancies on the Health Board. Appointments are divided into certain subdivisions and after some discussion, Alcorn moved to reappoint Hank Fallat to the Health Board for a 4 year term. Woeste seconded the motion and it carried 3-0. Discussion followed on what subdivision the other appointment should fall under and no further action was taken.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT: Melissa Browning reported that she had sent out the Community Readiness Survey to about 30 community members as part of the reorganization for the Eastern Indiana Regional Planning Commission. Commissioners were part of the survey and she encouraged them to complete it. She also stated that Purdue will be doing a housing study as part of the survey.

AMBULANCE REPORT: Wiwi reported that he, the Sheriff, 911 dispatch and the town had met with Nathan St. Clair and discussed staffing for the ambulance. St. Clair stated that 2 ambulances would be staffed at all times and he would let dispatch know who is covering the county if both ambulances are out.

HIGHWAY: The Auditor reported that the \$536,000 INDOT Community Crossings grant had been received and the striping bill for Dunlapville Road has been paid.

SHERIFF: Sheriff Dale Dishmond reported that there are 18 prisoners housed locally and 3 out of county. He also stated that the new cameras should be installed the next day and the new vehicle should be here soon.

MISC: Alcorn reviewed an air quality report for the Transfer Station which indicated that it was within acceptable limits. The Commissioners signed Conflict of Interest Statements for Diane Baker, Chris Rosenberger and Linda Rosenberger.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
