Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and West District Commissioner, Kyle White welcomed those in attendance with Kyle Carroll leading the group in prayer.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. All in favor. Motion carried. The BRO project was discussed and when the project would be completed.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman and Chief Deputy Tracy Neill met with the Commission to give update the Commission on events in the County.

Superintendents from the area met with the Commission to discuss CARES ACT Funds and their requests. In attendance were Michael Stephenson, Stewartsville, Rick Goin, Osborn, Chris Heslinga, Maysville and Rick Calloway of Union Star. The Superintendents discussed their respective school districts and how COVID was affecting them and the procedures they have in place at this time. The Commission told them all how much they have appreciated them keeping them updated. The Commission also advised after approval of requests today the Commission will table any new requests until the County sees how much an audit of these funds will cost.

Box culverts, brush, tubes and work around the county were discussed with Road & Bridge Supervisor Bill Gray. Bill also advised that tires were needed and put on equipment this past week.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to send Tri-County Health \$75,000 from Cares Act Funds due to the amount of cases in DeKalb County. Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee made the motion to approve ½ of the amount requested from Maysville School District, pay all of The YMCA's request, pay ½ of what The City of Cameron requested with Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.
