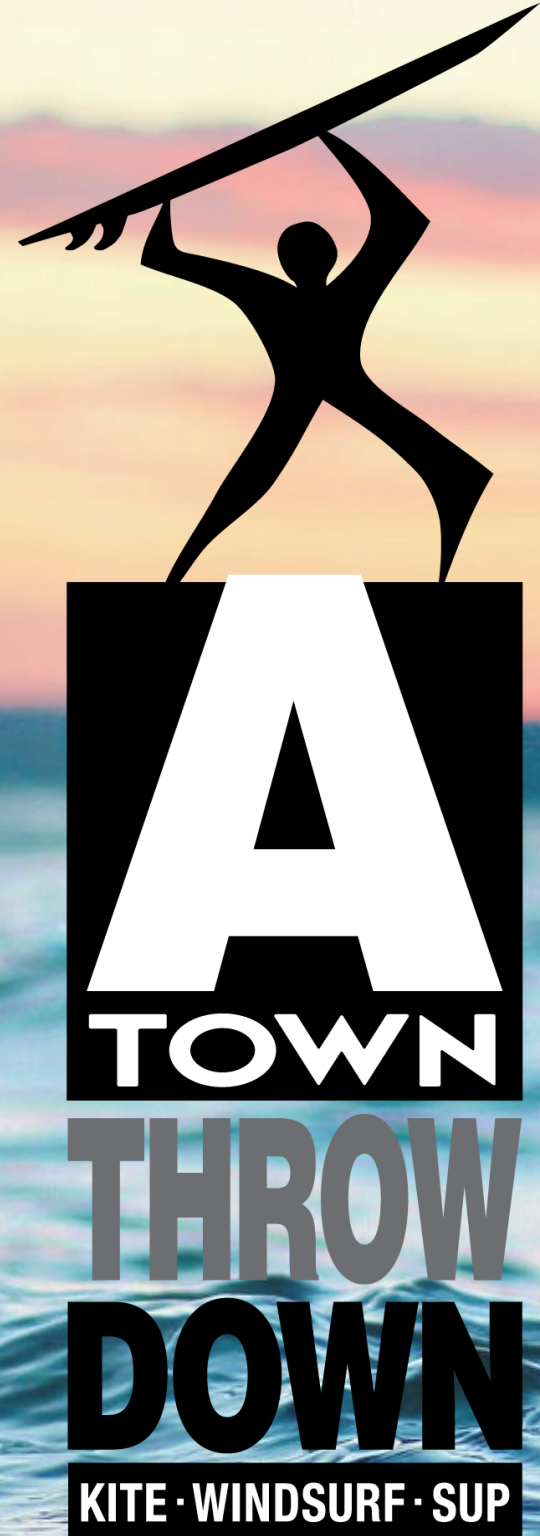

ABOUT A-TOWN THROWDOWN

The Silos of Arlington, Oregon is favored by many wind, kite surfers and stand up paddle boarders because of the strong winds and big waves created in this stretch of the Columbia River Gorge. Six straight miles of river with water depths exceeding 100 feet create double overhead waves at times. This stretch of the Columbia River is a mile wide, providing expansive and thrilling rides for the best wind, kite and SUP enthusiasts.

After many years of watching riders climbing over big boulders on the north slope of Island Park, the Port of Arlington decided it was time to build a better launch site. Taking advise from expert riders and designer, the Port built a superb launch site and on March 20, 2017 the long awaited project was completed*.

To celebrate the completion of the new launch site the Port of Arlington and a group of riders decided to host the “A-Town Throwdown” event on **June 16th** featuring freestyle windsurfing and big air kite competitions, 10-m SUP downwind race, live music, local food vendors and a beer garden. This fun filled event will officially kick off the summer wind season in the Columbia River Gorge!
