### Life Legacy

Brady Rudd Hooper, 18 of Cabot died Sunday, April 3, 2005 at his home. He was born September 29, 1986 in Bowling Green, Kentucky to Greg and Sara Lu Rudd Hooper. Brady was a Senior at Cabot High School where he was an active member of the Air Force Jr. ROTC. Brady served as Rifle Team Commander and in 2004 he received the Distinguished Cadet Award. He was a member of Cabot First Baptist Church. Brady belonged to the Youth Group, First Student Ministries and Bulgarian Mission Team. He was also in the Delayed Entry Program (DEP) for the U.S. Marines Corp where he was scheduled to join the Corp. following graduation.
