President's Message

2024 is upon us! Last year was a memorable year for the club. We have grown and there has been more participation than ever at our events and the most people attended the banquet that I can remember. I need to thank Denise and Elaine Ige for spearheading the banquet activities but I also need to acknowledge all the help we received from club members. The Raffle was exceptional and David Ige needs to take a bow for his hard work. He and Elaine shared our Sportsperson of the Year award this year.

In the last newsletter I forgot to thank Randy Kroll as a member of the board and as the Whopper Board Chairman. I seem to forget that he has also stepped in for me as Charter master on more than one occasion these past few years. He has done an excellent job keeping the Whopper Board score which named David Schweickert III as Saltwater Angler of the Year and James Speck as our Freshwater Angler of the Year. A big congratulations to you both. It should be noted that a few categories went with no prize winner and some prizes were won by fish weighing in at ounces. This alone should give you motivation to be out there fishing. I hope for a lot of participation in the upcoming club events.

As always, I have to say I'm human and do make mistakes. I owe Tom Loy an apology because I put his money on a 2022 trip envelope and because of my bookkeeping system the funds were put in the wrong year. That will not happen in 2024 as all our charter trips are in this calendar and awards year. The award of Saltwater Angler of the Year and Freshwater Angler of the Year goes towards fish caught from November 1, 2023 to November 1, 2024. The last Endeavor trip of the Year will count for 2025, not 2024 because it falls after the Whopper Board deadline.

The saltwater schedule is out. I know there are some fishing Friday trips. This is because 1 ½ and 2 days trips to take advantage of the BFT and doubling your limits while not staying out 2 days has become more popular. 






<u>Printed date is the date you will be fishing</u>. Overnight trips load the night before. Full payment is required to reserve a spot. Prices subject to change if surcharge is charged to the Club. Make checks payable to William Davis. Expect to pay cash for your own food, tips and fish cleaning on the boats as always.

Departure times are tentative. They can change if everyone shows up.

I ask that younger more agile members and guests take the upper and lower bunks leaving the middle bunks to the more senior(age) members and guests.

Due to limited tackle box space, please consider bringing smaller or soft sided tackle box.

THE CHARTERMASTER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO OVERBOOK THE TRIPS BY ONE PERSON TO ENSURE THE CLUB DOES NOT LOSE MONEY.

Each trip stands alone. By that I mean each trip is a separate entity. You can write a check for multiple trips.

Bring your own bedding on trips. Do not show up sick.

All Club members and guests are expected to abide by the Department of Fish and Wildlife rules.

I will contact you prior to each trip. Each trip is best fishing available so don't call and ask.

2024 Saltwater Charter Reservation Rules:

- 1. All club charters are available for reservation immediately.
- 2. Full amount will be required to confirm your reservation for any trip.
- 4. No refunds until the Charter is full & the Club has been able to sell your reservation. The Club makes no guarantee that we will be able to fill your reservation once the Charter is full. Changes MUST go thru the Charter Master.
- 5. All charters are open to members and their invited guests.
- 6. If you need to cancel a charter reservation it must be done in <u>writing</u>, text or <u>email</u> to William Davis. Once you cancel you cannot change your mind and show up for the trip.

Policy for disabled members:

At the discretion of the Charter master, disabled individuals may be required to provide their own assistant for saltwater fishing events. The assistant will be counted as part of the full load, will be charged full fare, and must have a fishing license. As the purpose of the assistant is to assist the individual with a disability, the assistant may be allowed to fish when the individual with a disability is not fishing or has been deemed independent by the Charter master. If the assistant is not at the rail to assist, the disabled person may not fish. The disabled individual will provide their own gear/tackle or will be required to rent it. In the event that the assistant is not available at boarding time, the disabled person will not be allowed to board and they will not receive a refund unless the 2 spots are filled. If additional equipment is needed for accommodation, it must be cleared with the Charter master and boat before the reservation is accepted. For a free/reduced-fee California fishing license, Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to visit the Website https://wildlife.ca.gov/Licensing/Fishing#44521417-free--reduced-fee at least four months in advance of the trip to allow for processing time.
