From The Pastor's Desk:

Although this year the time between the Christmas season and the Lenten season is longer than usual, Lent is rapidly approaching.

Here's something interesting about Lent that you might not know:

Pretzels and Lent: Did you know that pretzels have a special connection to Lent? The pretzel is said to have originated in the early Christian era, and it was traditionally made with a simple recipe of flour, water, and salt—no dairy, eggs, or fats, which were forbidden during Lent. The shape of the pretzel, with its twisted form, was meant to resemble arms crossed in prayer. So, next time you enjoy a pretzel, remember its roots as a Lenten food!

Lent is a season of reflection and preparation in the Christian tradition, leading up to Easter. It lasts for 40 days (excluding Sundays), beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending on Holy Saturday. The 40 days symbolize the period Jesus spent fasting in the desert, enduring temptation from Satan.

The true meaning of Lent includes several key aspects:

- 1. Repentance: It's a time for Christians to repent for their sins and seek spiritual renewal.
- 2. Fasting: Many Christians practice fasting or giving up certain luxuries as a form of self-discipline and spiritual focus.
- 3. Prayer: Increased prayer and meditation are central to the Lenten journey.
- **4.** Almsgiving: Acts of charity and helping those in need are emphasized as a way to live out one's faith.
- 5. Reflection: Lent is a period for deep personal reflection and seeking a closer relationship with God.

It is a time to prepare one's heart and mind for the celebration of Jesus' resurrection on Easter Sunday.

As we move into the Lenten Season, I encourage you to participate in the mid-week Lenten luncheon services shared with our other Leesport churches. LCHT hosts the first Lenten luncheon on March 12 at noon. You will find the full schedule elsewhere in the bulletin.



REDNER'S REGISTER TAPES

Did you know that Redner's Warehouse Markets gives 1% of purchases back to the Women of the ELCA? This one percent can really add up! And the monies goes to good things like the Mission Trip, VFW, Berk's Women in Crisis, just to name a few.

In order for Redner's to count the receipt (a.k.a. register tape), it has to be the ENTIRE receipt, and it has to have a "save-a-tape" number on it. How do you insure this? Well, you must use your pump perks card or save-a-tape card at the checkout. Then, just drop the ENTIRE receipt in the box at the ushers station in the narthex. DO NOT cut the bottom off. We only get credit for COMPLETE tapes! Also, please be sure to turn your tapes in in a timely manner, as Redner's will not accept any over three years old.

Veterans Making a Difference is an ongoing project through WELCA and Pastoral Care.
