

## FALL- WINTER -EARLY SPRING

### FROM NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH APRIL 30TH OF EACH YEAR

Placing potted flowers, plants, wreaths, flags, or baskets on burial sites is permitted; subject, however, to the provisions of paragraph 63. The digging of holes for any purpose is strictly prohibited.

Under no circumstances may glass vases be brought on cemetery grounds.

Artificial or fresh cut flowers may be placed in a metal or plastic vase and can be staked or sitting on the ground, however, they will be discarded, faded, broken or of a similar nature.

At no time are shepherd hooks, hanging decorative flags, solar lights, statues, or extended memorial gardens with fencing, bricks, mulch, stone, plantings etc. allowed.



No plantings of any kind are to be done. The Cemetery shall have sole responsibility in the maintenance of the Cemetery including the decision of when and how shrubbery and trees are trimmed or removed.

Groundskeepers reserve the right to reposition or remove objects that do not conform to the Cemetery Rules & Regulations or interfere with the performance of their duties.

The Cemetery reserves the right to remove all flowers, potted plants, wreaths or baskets of flowers when they become withered, or for any other reason, and the

Cemetery Manager is ordered to make such removals when, in his judgement, it is in the best interests of the Cemetery.

Seasonal flowers must be removed 15 days following a holiday.

All flags, that are faded and tattered will be removed & properly disposed of by our local American Legion Post.

Funeral service flowers may be removed by the cemetery employees after 5 days.

It is the owner's responsibility to have all items that are "inserted in or touching" the ground/grass removed by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Please be advised that owners of said removed items will not be notified nor have said removed items returned to them. The removal of these items is strictly for the safety of our groundskeepers and their equipment and is in no way a personal attack on you or your loved ones.
