This IS the rider's meeting for RMX Series. Please read the information and become familiar with it.

There will be no verbal rider's meeting before motos begin.

1. SPECTATORS/MECHANICS

All spectators, parents, mechanics, etc. must remain behind the fence line or in the designated mechanics/spectator areas at all times. The safety crew will be on the track to assist all riders.

There is no tolerance for those not following this safety rule. Penalties and/or disqualifications may be enforced.

2. VERIFY YOUR INFORMATION: A complete list of registered riders will be posted on the information board prior to Moto 1. It the rider's responsible to make sure you are entered correctly before racing begins. We may also post messages if we have a question or an issue with your registration

- 3. REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given after practice begins.
- 4. MACHINE ELIGIBILITY: It is your responsibility verify your machine is eligible in each class you register
- **5.** BIKE #'s: <u>LEGIBLE BIKE NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL 3 NUMBER PLATES</u> (front and 2 sides). If this requirement is not met it may result in an incorrect score.
- 6. OFFICIAL FLAGS:

Green – Start of Race

Yellow – Danger on Track. **Use Caution** between yellow flag and problem or danger area. Rider may jump & pass between the yellow flag and the incident but must show caution.

Red Cross – Danger on Track. Use **EXTREME CAUTION**. Slow down, maintain position, do not gain an advantage. Wheels of the motorcycle must not leave the ground between the flag and the incident.

White – Courtesy Flag: One lap remaining

Black – Disqualification of rider – rider must immediately leave the track and report to an official.

Red – Stopping of race for any emergency, may require restart of race.

Black & White Checkered – Finish, end of race.

7. SCORING: Scoring concerns should be addressed with the race office within 30 minutes of results being posted.

8. PROTESTS: Protests or concerns should be submitted in writing through the race office. Verbal protests will not be accepted. Written protests are required to be submitted within 30 min of results being posted.

10. RACE AWARDS: Top 33% in amateur classes.

Note: All 50cc participants that do not finish in the top 33% will receive a participant award.

11. PRO PAY/BACK: See race office or RMXSERIES.com for pay-out
