NOVFA Virtual Fire CEU's

The first of our on-line training classes will take place on April 13 starting at 6:30 pm. The class will be for 2 hours. Fire Instructor Mark Briggs will be presenting a class on Fire Ground Fundamentals / The Key to Firefighter Safety. This CE session will cover fire ground practices to include:

Structure size-up from the bottom up and why it is important.

Recognizing outside clues to give you a head start on interior floor plans.

Standardized radio report to get everyone on scene on the same page.

Review of building construction.

When to reevaluate crew safety.

The importance of establishing a safety office at every working fire.
