



## *Fees for International Students 2017-2018*

Please keep this information for your records

### 1. Introduction

This publication is written specifically to assist parents in understanding the cost of an international student attending Arizona Lutheran Academy. This publication deals with student expenses and the payment of tuition and fees.

### 2. International Student Expenses

Application Fee:	\$ 100 (non-refundable, one time fee)
Enrollment Fee:	\$ 2,000 (non-refundable, yearly fee; holds place in enrollment)
Tuition:	\$20,200
Fees:	\$ 600*
Homestay:	<u>\$ 6,500**</u>
TOTAL :	\$29,400

### 3. Payment Procedures

The \$100 non-refundable application fee must be included with the admission application form. Upon receiving the acceptance letter by email, the family must pay the \$2,000 enrollment fee to hold the student's place in the program. The balance must be paid in full by August 1. Payment is to be made in U.S. currency in the form of a bank draft or a wire transfer. Wire transfer information will be included with acceptance papers. (Credit card payments may be made, but will be assessed a 5% administrative fee.)

In the event that the student visa is denied, any tuition or residence fees already paid will be refunded. The application fee and enrollment fee are non-refundable. (Exception: Enrollment fee will be refunded with proper evidence showing proof of visa denial.)

Students who enroll in Arizona Lutheran Academy are committed to attending school here for a minimum of one academic year. Students who withdraw or transfer before this time will not be granted any refund of fees. If a student is asked by the Administration to withdraw from Arizona Lutheran Academy, all tuition fees for the current semester are non-refundable, and all boarding fees for the entire year are non-refundable.

### 4. \*Fees include the following:

- Class dues
- Sports fees
- International student activities
- AP class fees (European trip costs for AP European History class are extra.)
- Art class expenses
- ACT testing (PSAT and SAT are optional and are not included in the cost.)
- Yearbook

### 4. \*\*Homestay

#### Housing includes the following:

- Meals: Three meals per day and snacks
- Furnished bedroom: Bed, mattress, linens, towels, laundry basket, trash can, clothes closet
- Laundry: Use of washing machine and dryer, laundry detergent
- Phone: Phone service will be available for local calls. Students may arrange mobile phone service or Skype on their own.
- Computers: Internet access will be available for personal laptop computers (if the student chooses to bring one).
- Transportation: Transportation to and from school and extra-curricular activities is provided by the host family as well as transportation to occasional social and cultural events, malls, shopping, etc.
