BHPCNS Supplemental programming (Breakfast with Bradley Bear, Lunch Bunch, and Stay & Play) will begin **September 23, 2024**.

Breakfast with Bradley Bear for All Ages: 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. Children may be dropped off at school as early as 8:00 a.m. A school-provided, light breakfast will be provided. To register please visit this link: https://tinyurl.com/4pwceef7

Lunch Bunch for Children in Our Two-Year-Old Programs: 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Children may stay for lunch (parent provided) and enjoy free play.

Stay & Play: For all ages, 12:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Stay and Play programming is divided into 2 programs.

- **Two-year-olds*** participate in our Twos Rule Stay and Play programming. This engaging program provides opportunities for our youngest cubs to strengthen friendship skills during a relaxed afternoon of playing, singing, crafting, and resting. **Offered Monday through Fridays.**
 - *Children do not need to be potty trained to attend Twos' Rule!

- Three-year-old and Pre-K classes** engage in afternoon enrichment activities which are themed by the day of the week.

<u>Mondays - Sports and Games</u>: The week kicks off with our cubs participating in a spirited afternoon full of fun and games while learning the basics of several sports and playing traditional childhood games. No special equipment required, except sneakers and socks and a willingness to have a ball!

<u>Tuesdays - Wigglin' Wizards</u>: Our little curious wizards explore the world of science with plenty of hands-on experiments, forming hypotheses, and discovering their outcomes, creative crafts, and amazing scientific inquiries.

<u>Tuesdays and Wednesdays - In the Kitchen with Bradley Bear</u>: We'll be cooking up a storm, learning about ingredients, following directions and doing a lot of "sciencing" as we measure, mix, and pour. Oh, we'll also be doing a lot of yummy eating!

<u>Wednesdays - Bradley Bear's Creative Dance Company</u>: This semester class is offered in partnership with the <u>Bethesda Conservatory of Dance</u>. Our dancing bear cubs will learn the basics of modern dance, ballet, jazz, hip hop, and more as they get ready to entertain us at their winter and spring recitals (Jan. 29 & May 14, respectively). Children enrolled in Tuesday/Thursday programming may participate in the Wednesday dance program.

<u>Thursdays - Where in the World is Bradley Bear?</u>: You never know where Bradley Bear will land, but you know he and his cubs will have fun in this geography-based program exploring different countries, their cultures, unique attributes, and foods.

<u>Fridays - Yogi Bears</u>: Yoga postures, practiced breathing, games, and relaxation will help our little Yogis recharge from their long school week and get them ready to start their weekend.

**Children must be fully potty-trained, as defined from the Parent Handbook, to attend the above classes.

Supplemental Programming Tuition Rates

The **first payment is due September 23, 2024**** and may be included with your regular tuition payment. Subsequent payments are due by the first of each month. If fees are not paid by the 15th of the month, a 10% late fee will be added to your child's account. Once enrolled, your child is considered enrolled for the school year. You may withdraw your child from the program by giving the office written notification. No refunds are given for school closings or absences.

Children must be fully acclimated to their regular morning program before adding any additional programs. BHPCNS reserves the right to withdraw a child from Supplemental programming if, after consulting with parents, it is determined that the program is a hardship for the child.

Terms of Admission

- 1. Payment for supplemental programming, with the exception of the semester dance program, is due the first of each month. If not paid by the 15th of the month a 10% late fee will be added to your child's account. Tuition for the semester dance class is due September 23, 2024 and again on February 3, 2025.
- 2. Once accepted, students are enrolled for the school year. Written notification must be given to withdraw a child from the program. BHPCNS reserves the right to withdraw a child from the program if, after consulting with parents, it is determined that the program is a hardship for the child.
- 3. Switching of days and/or classes may only be done on a monthly basis.
- 4. Tuition refunds are not given due to school closings or absences and there are no make-up classes or swapping of classes due to absences. Refunds are not given for semester-run classes after the first month of attendance.
- 5. A late fee (as described in the Parent Handbook) will be assessed to the account of any child picked up late.
- 6. BHPCNS reserves the right to cancel the program due to low enrollment at any time. Parents will be notified in advance of any cancellation.
