



Camp Whitley Code of Conduct

Camp Whitley is dedicated to ensuring that the week every camper's experiences are enjoyable and safe. We, as a staff and Board of Directors, are committed to supporting the Developmental Assets of the Search Institute for Healthy Communities and Healthy Youth. The Boundaries and Expectations Asset, which includes Camp Boundaries, Adult Role Models, and High Expectations for Behavior, is important in ensuring we meet our goal of an enjoyable week for all. Listed below are the Camp Whitley Procedures and Rules that every camper is expected to follow while in attendance at Camp Whitley:

Respect for Staff Members

Possible Consequences: Failure to respect the staff by doing what has been asked or stop doing an inappropriate activity will result in a warning (for slight infraction) and may result in loss of Camp privileges (playing games, activities, etc.) Habitual or severe offenses may result in removal from Camp without a refund.

Respect for Other Campers

Possible Consequences: Failure to respect other campers by name calling, teasing, making fun of, or otherwise harassing, will result in a warning (for a first-time offense) and may result in loss of Camp privileges (playing games, activities, etc.) Habitual or severe offenses may result in removal from Camp without a refund.

Respect for Safety

Possible Consequences: Failure to respect the safety of others, and themselves, by choosing to become physically aggressive or by repeatedly not following safety directions and rules will result in a loss of Camp privileges (playing games, activities, loss of awards, etc.) and may result in removal from Camp without a refund.

Respect for Camp Whitley Property

Possible Consequences: Failure to respect Camp Property Including writing on beds or mattresses, or otherwise defacing Camp property - excluding walls of cabins) will result in loss of Camp privileges and may result in physical and/or monetary restitution and removal from Camp without a refund.

Respect for Other Campers' Property

Possible Consequences: Failure to respect other campers' property will result in a loss of Camp privileges and may result in physical and/or monetary restitution and removal from Camp without a refund.

As a camper, I understand that I am expected to abide by all Camp Whitley Policies and Rules, and if I choose not to follow them, I understand the consequences, including removal from Camp without a refund, at the discretion of the Camp Director.
