<b>Large print (s)</b> # of strips cut @ 11 ½" X WOF (1 print) (2 prints)	(4)(2 each)	(7)(4 each)	(10)(5 each)
subcut # of squares cut @ 11 ½" X 11 ½" (1 print) (2 prints)	(12)(6 each)	(20)(10 each)	(30)(15 each)
<b>**Optional Panel or T shirts squares cut at 11 ½" x 11 ½"</b> *may use smaller sizes, but sash them with fabrics to equal 11 ½" x 11 ½"	12	20	30
<b>#1 Surround Strip (black)</b> # of strips cut @ 12" X WOF (Subcut into 12" x 7" rectangles) # of rectangles cut @ 7"	2	4	6
<b>#2 Surround Strip (tan)</b> # of strips cut @ 12" X WOF (Subcut into 12" x 7" rectangles) # of rectangles cut @ 7"	12	20	30
<b>#3 Surround Strip (tan)</b> # of strips cut @ 12" X WOF (Subcut into 12" x 7" rectangles) # of rectangles cut @ 7"	2	4	6
<b>#3 Corner squares (red)</b> # of strips cut @ 6 ½" X WOF Subcut # of squares cut @ 6 ½"	12	20	30
<b>#3 Corner squares (red)</b> # of strips cut @ 6 ½" X WOF Subcut # of squares cut @ 6 ½"	1	2	2
<b>#4 Corner squares (gray)</b> # of strips cut @ 6 ½" X WOF Subcut # of squares cut @ 6 ½"	4	10	12
<b>#4 Corner squares (gray)</b> # of strips cut @ 6 ½" X WOF Subcut # of squares cut @ 6 ½"	2	2	3
<b>#4 Corner squares (gray)</b> # of strips cut @ 6 ½" X WOF Subcut # of squares cut @ 6 ½"	8	10	18

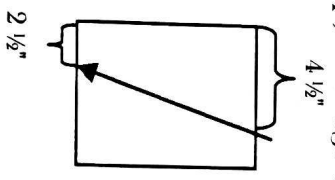

❖ **MAKING RECTANGLES**

**Step 1:** sewing with the Surround Prints #1 black and #2 tan

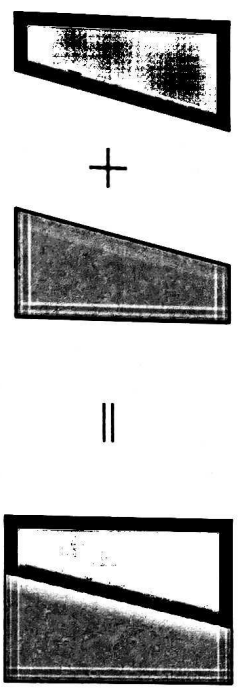
**Layer #1** black and #2 tan rectangles, with both #1 and #2 right sides up \*IMPORTANT

Measure from top, left edge of rectangle over 4 1/2", mark the measurement.



Measure from bottom, left edge of rectangle over 2 1/2", mark the measurement  
 Draw a line to connect the two measurements, then cut directly on the line.

**Step 2:** Sew a #1 black unit to a #2 tan unit to make a rectangle.



Press towards black, trim to 6 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangle.  
 Repeat steps 1 & 2 to make all rectangles needed for the size of the quilt you are making.
