Comments on the 48th Annual Squirrel Shoot:

- Suggestion is to recognize the contributions of those who labored to make the Squirrel Shoot possible. This could be done at the Potluck Dinner on Saturday evening in hopes of saving time at the end of the shoot on Sunday.
- Suggestion is to form a committee that has the responsibility of organizing the Potluck Dinner event. This could include a budget that the BHS would provide to this committee to facilitate this social event and allow members and shooters to get to know one another.
- The management of the prize blanket was well received and suggested that the same procedure be used next year.
- The location where campers parked their trailers was also a good idea and should be continued.
- The sign for the shoot was not put up and some early arrivals were not sure how to get to the event. Need to be sure the sign is up at the entry gate just off of the highway.

Governance issues:

- Ron Ring has developed a chart where points will be assigned to members for participation in BHS events. Points will be awarded for:
 - Attendance (2 pts.)
 - Participation (3 pts.)
 - Running the shoot (6 pts)
 - Workday. An organized event that has been called. (10 pts.)
 - Special events, where members volunteer help for specific projects. (4 pts.)
 - Points can be earned by assisting with the CSMLA Shoot.
 - The Captain will tally points after each event.
