## ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85-7 RESTRICTING THE NUMBER OF HEADSTONES, FOOT PLAQUES AND BURIALS PER PLOT

WHEREAS, the Village of Chapin, Illinois, passed and approved Ordinance No. 85-7, entitled "Ordinance Regulating Headstones in the McKinney Addition to Chapin Cemetery", and said ordinance is currently in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Village amend Ordinance No. 85-7 to establish the maximum number of headstones, foot plaques and burials permitted on each plot.

NCW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Chapin, Morgan County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Ordinance No. 85-7 is hereby amended by adding Section 8 to said ordinance as follows:

Section 8. Maximum permitted burials, headstones and foot plaques.

- a. No more than one (1) non-cremated body and four (4) cremated bodies may be buried in any single plot. The non-cremated body must be buried in the lot prior to the burial of a cremated body. If, however, the family/owners of a plot pay all costs associated with the exhumation and reburial of all cremated bodies previously buried in the plot, then a non-cremated body may be buried in the plot subsequent thereto.
- b. No more than one (1) above-ground headstone and four (4) foot plaques are permitted on any single plot.

<u>Section 2</u>: All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, conflicting with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

<u>Section 4</u>: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions herein.
