The Town Board held their regular meeting, limiting it to under 10 people. We are waiting a while longer to make a final decision on use of Lawrence Park for the summer, the pool will definitely not be open this year.

Abundant Solar made an initial introduction for a community solar project in our town. The Planning Board is currently working on a solar law for the Town.

The Town Board passed a motion to repeal the amendment To Local Law #4 of 2019 Amending Zoning Law #2 of 2006 to Regulate Windmills and Windmill Facilities, allowing for an increase in height to 650 feet. A public hearing will be scheduled.

Volunteers are still needed for the Zoning Board of Appeals.
