## La Luz Early Childhood Center Travel Policy UPDATED AS OF 2-23-2022

For **DOMESTIC** travel, we will require you, staff and children (does **not include** household members-only those individuals coming in and staying in La Luz ECC), **REGARDLESS** of vaccination status, to test the day you return from your trip and then again, 2 days following your return. A rapid, at home test is sufficient. With each negative test, absent of <u>ANY</u> symptoms, you may return to work/school. For example, if you return Sunday night from a trip, test Sunday night and again on Tuesday night; can return to school on Monday with that first negative test result. Keep reading for more exclusions.

For **INTERNATIONAL** travel, we will require you, staff and children (does not include household members-only those individuals coming in and staying in La Luz ECC), **REGARDLESS** of vaccination status, to quarantine for 2 days, and then take two tests as above (for domestic travel). For example, you return from Europe on a Saturday night, you must quarantine for 2 days then test (can be rapid absent of ANY symptoms) on Monday night. With a negative test, you may return on Tuesday. YOU <u>PO</u> NEED TO TEST AGAIN on Wednesday night and can keep coming to school so long as it is negative, and you are absent of ANY symptoms. Again, THIS ONLY APPLIES TO THE PERSON ACTUALLY STAYING AT LA LUZ FOR THE DAY, i.e. staff member or enrolled child. Keep reading for more exclusions.

Should you have **ANY** symptoms during your trip or upon your return or if they develop at any time in the 10 days following your return, we will require a PCR test (unless the rapid test shows a positive), even with a negative, rapid test. If you choose not to submit a PCR test, you must treat it as a positive test and remain out for 10 days or can return after 5, so long as down to 1 or no symptoms, for 48 hours, **WITH** a KN95 mask on for another 5 days. Should the 1 symptom, after the 5-day exclusion, be either a fever, vomiting or diarrhea, then you can return 48 hours, in addition to the 5 day exclusion, after that 1 symptom has subsided without the aid of medication.

This effectively does away with any exclusions for **domestic** travel only, with a 2-test regimen (taken 48 hours apart with the 1<sup>st</sup> test taken the day the person who stays at La Luz for the day, who traveled-excludes household members who travel-returns) and a modified 2-day quarantine for international travel.
