2022-23 West Region Tournament Notes

Feb. 16-18, Pepsi Rink at MAYSA, Minot, N.D.



This year's postseason got underway with two play-in contests at home sites on Monday, Feb. 13. (7) Bismarck High defeated (10) Hazen-Beulah (9) Bottineau-Rugby upended (8) Willis-

Four quarterfinals are on Thursday, Feb. 16. Loser-out and semifinals will be held on Feb. 17 with two state qualifiers and the championship to be played on Feb. 18.

2021-22 Rewind: Last year's tournament offered a few items of note. Jamestown captured its second W. Region Tournament title, and first since 1994-95. Legacy, competing in its first year, reached the tournament title game. And for the first time since the tournament began in 1995, the finals did not have Bismarck High, Century or Minot High in the game.

Is this the year for Minot?

Minot High enters the tournament as the top seed and has won or shared the past four conference regular season titles. Unfortunately, winning the West Region Tournament has been elusive for the Magi. The last time the program did capture the title was 2005-06. It has been to the title game eight times since then.

Who will emerge champion this weekend?

Top seed Minot High is perhaps the slight favorite. The squad has victories over every team. No. 2 seed Legacy has been arguably the most consistent team all season and boasts the longest win streak of any team in the field (10 games). No 3 Century started slow, but found its stride when the calendar flipped to 2023 and has OT wins over Minot High and Legacy. Century knows how to win at this time of year, evident by its four-straight titles between 2017-21.

And a couple teams not to overlook will be No. 4 Jamestown and No. 5 Mandan. They meet in the quarterfinal round

Jamestown is the defending champion, and although it lost several dynamic players to graduate or leaving early for junior hockey, the Blue Jays have looked strong against quality opponents. They have wins over Minot High and Century and others in the field. Mandan is also a team that has shown it can compete against the top programs. It has one-goal wins over Legacy and Century. Goaltending has been a source of strength all season for the Braves.

Nail-biter hockey: Twenty-two WDA regular season games were decided by a goal, showcasing the parity in the conference again this season. Ten of those games went to overtime or a

The Braves entered the postseason having won just six games. but won a road play-in game at Dickinson and then won a pair of region tournament games (vs. Williston and Bottineau-Rugby) to advance to the state tournament. The Braves also won a consolation game (vs. Legacy). Not bad for a team that finished ninth in the conference.

Some new faces going to state: Before the 2020-21 season, you could usually pencil in Bismarck High, Minot High and Century as qualifying for the ND state tournament with the rest of the conference teams battling for the fourth, and final tournament berth. But in the past few years we have seen several different teams make the state tournament field while some traditional attendees not qualify. In 2020-21, Williston and Bottineau-Rugby made the field. In 2021-22, Jamestown, Legacy and Mandan were qualifiers. The only team that has been to the state tournament in each of the past two seasons has been Minot
