From the President's Desk:

The August 27th work detail went very well. We had at least 24 people in attendance (I think a few more showed up late and did not sign in). We got the family picnic set up and some other much needed chores around the club as well. Please don't let this be an exception. Get involved and stay involved. We need your help.

Your 2023 dues will be the same as last year's and you can expect dues notices early this fall. We will be using the same system as last year. Each of you will have a contact person to mail your renewal form and payment to. This year there will be an option to pay your dues renewal electronically. Do not mail them to the chapter address and do not bring them to the meetings (it only delays and complicates things). Everyone who followed the directions we mailed with the dues notice received their card very quickly. We got a lot of positive feedback about that. Some people were not impressed with the late fee. The simple solution is to not mail your dues in late. It will be especially important to mail your dues in a timely manner this year. On December 31st your membership will expire if we haven't received your payment and you will not have access to the grounds, in addition to having to pay a \$25 late fee. The electronic gate will be active and without a valid code or active card you will not be able to get onto the grounds.

Each year we award scholarships to deserving youth who are majoring in environmental studies such as biology, forestry, and the like. The money for these scholarships comes from interest derived from an annuity the club has purchased. That investment should allow us to award such scholarships forever, and we are adding money to that principle whenever possible. There is a plaque in the clubhouse and when someone passes and memorial contributions are made in their name totaling over \$500, their name is added to the plaque. Several names have been added recently. I think memorial contributions to something lasting like this are so much better than flowers. Don't you? 
