<u>Fish & Wildlife Management</u> – Dave Lewis has been out to check for damage caused by beavers; no problems noted.

<u>Lake Improvement Report</u> – Meeting scheduled for 4.21.2025 at 3:00 PM. The ice went out 3.15.2025; Dave took spring phosphorus reading on 3.18.2025. The 2023 CLMP reports are on the website, but not 2024. MiCorps has 2024 results for Blue Lake and Round Lake. Dave will check with Rick Buteyn at Progressive about updating the website with 2024 results.

<u>Loon Report</u> – All loons are back. Dave will refurbish the Artificial Nesting Island and re-locate to the southeast corner of Round Lake.

<u>Dam</u> – In consultation with Karla Miller, Drain Commissioner, Dave lowered all boards on 4.5.2025 due to low water levels. <u>Public Landing/Friends of the Lake</u> – Myle suggested reposting the Friends of the Lake information on Facebook and website. <u>Membership</u> - 274 current members; 118 memberships expire 7.31.2025 (12 without email addresses). Mike has sent reminders to all of those with expiring memberships. Discussion about continuing with the auto-renew feature, as many times the credit card information is not valid after one or more years. Mike has worked with Alex to allow multiple years to be purchased without having to use auto-renew. Mike emailed a list of all expiring memberships prior to the April meeting so each Board member can reach out to friends and neighbors. Karen noted that she is receiving 2 Riparian magazines.
