TBLA Board of Directors – The Board met on January 18 and approved a \$300 Donation to support the Sabine 4H Shooting Team and approved a \$2000 grant to fund materials for Litter Education for all third and fifth graders in Sabine Parish. The Board also approved funding for a Florida Bass Fingerling Release in 2022. Details and dates for the release are being finalized and we will pass them along as we have a final date. We also have been asked by LA Wildlife and Fisheries to furnish up to twenty volunteers to support their Sabine Parish Fifth Grade Fishing Education Program which will be held in May at Cypress Bend. We will be signing up volunteers as soon as the dates for the event are confirmed. We have supported this event for many years and it is one of the most impactful things that we do with the youth in our area.

<u>The Glynn Carver Memorial Scholarship</u> —Applications for the Scholarship are due to us by February 1 and the Scholarship Committee will begin the application review and selection process after the due date. <u>Lake Level</u> – The Lake level is important to those with an interest in Toledo Bend. Real time information on the matter can be found online at https://waterdata.usgs.gov/monitoring-location/08025350/. This information is updated every fifteen minutes. The Sabine River Authority's guidelines for opening and closing the spillway gates appears in their *Operating Guide Rule Curve* document. The lake is currently 168.66. The recent rains have raised the lake level approximately a foot and the cold weather has dropped the temps into the low 50's. Winter has finally arrived. Be careful if you are boating on the lake. Hypothermia is a real threat if you go in the water due to an accident. Please wear your PFD and respect the danger of cold water.
